



Does Prayer Work?

Have you ever prayed really really hard for something and not had that prayer granted? Have you ever looked back in life at a prayer you once made and thought thank goodness God didn't grant it? This week's gospel reading is a lesson in prayer, but more importantly, it's a lesson in having faith that God is a parent who will not let us down.



Let's face it, we pray hardest to God when we want something. We pray hardest when something seems beyond our human means and we need some kind of miracle, this often leads us to make inappropriate prayers. How many of us pray that the love of our life will notice us in the launderette? How many of us pray to win the lottery and make secret deals with God that we will donate half the winning to charity in return? How many of us pray to God for our football team to score a winning goal in the closing minutes of a match? Worse... we lose faith when such prayers aren't answered! We find it difficult to believe that unanswered prayers might mean that God knows better, or has a different purpose for us.

Perhaps Jesus' disciples shared some of our frustration when they say, "Lord teach us to pray." In response Jesus gives us a model by which to pray. It's important to recognise it as a model and not a prayer as such. Reciting a prayer is not the same as praying. The model prayer Jesus gives us, 'The Lord's prayer', invites us to pray to God as our Father, acknowledging his holiness and praying with the shared commitment to have his will done on earth. We are invited to pray for our 'daily bread', in other words, for the things we genuinely need. Pray for forgiveness, and promise to forgive others. Pray with persistence. Payer is about building a relationship with God, speaking to him often throughout the day. Lastly, and most importantly we should approach God with the faith we approach a loving parent. "What father," reasons Jesus, "would hand his son a snake when he asks for a fish?" or hand him a scorpion when he asks for an egg?" Even parents with very average parenting skills know how to give children what they need. "How much more," says Jesus, "will the Father in heaven give the Holy Spirit to those who ask him?"

Teach us, good Lord, to serve you as you deserve; to give, and not to count the cost, to fight, and not to heed the wounds, to toil, and not to seek for rest, to labour, and not to ask for reward, except that of knowing that we are doing your will.

TEACH US TO PRAY

I'm sure you've heard of a "Knock, Knock" joke. I have some to tell you today. Are you ready?

Knock, knock. (Who's there?) Canoe. (Canoe who?) Canoe come out and play? Knock, knock. (Who's there?) Tank. (Tank who?) You're welcome!

Knock, Knock. (Who's there?) Orange. (Orange Who?) Orange you glad this is my last knock, knock joke?

LORD. Teach Us To Pray

The Gospel tells us about a time Jesus was talking about knock, knock, knocking.

One day, Jesus was teaching His friends, the disciples, how to pray. He said, "Let's

say you went to a friend's house late at night..." "You said to your friend, 'I need to borrow some bread. I have a friend visiting and I have nothing to feed him."

"What if the friend answers, 'I can't help you right now. It's late and we're already in bed.' But what if you keep knocking on the door? Jesus said, "If you knock so long that you wake everyone in the neighbourhood, your friend will get up and give you some bread."

Jesus used this story to tell His friends and us to knock on God's door by asking for what you need. He says, "Everyone who asks will get what he asks for. Everyone who looks will find what he is looking for. Everyone who knocks will have the door opened to him."

Jesus said prayer is a way to ask, seek, and knock. Jesus even taught His disciples a way to pray. We call this prayer the Lord's prayer. Why don't you say this prayer now.

"Our Father who art in heaven, Hallowed be thy name. Thy kingdom come. Thy will be done, on earth as it is in heaven. Give us day our daily bread. And forgive us our trespasses; as we forgive those who trespass against us. And lead us not

"Our Father ..." into temptation; but deliver us from evil."

That is a beautiful prayer, isn't it? It isn't a very long prayer, but there are three things in this short prayer that every prayer should include. First of all, it praises God, our heavenly Father. Second, it asks God to provide for what we need for each day. Finally, it asks for God's forgiveness for the times that we fall short of what he expects of us.



After 2000 years, we still pray the way that Jesus taught us.



Dear Jesus, Help us to remember that it is most important to talk to you. Don't let us get so busy to forget to pray before we sleep and when we wake in the morning. Amen.

Time and Seasons come and go, so far 2025 seems to have moved very quickly, it's hard to believe, this week we begin the month of August. Traditionally August is associated with harvest and Thanksgiving. The ancient Celtic festival of lunasa was a celebration for all what had been gathered. People were grateful, to their creator God, who had provided enough sustenance for them to face the more vulnerable months of the year with confidence. I pray as this harvest season begins for a prolonged period of fine weather.

Lúnasa (or Lughnasadh), the traditional Celtic festival marking the start of the harvest season around August 1, has deep roots in Ireland's agricultural and spiritual history. Named after the Celtic god Lugh, it historically involved feasting, athletic contests, and rituals celebrating the first fruits of the harvest, such as grain and bilberries. Over time, as Christianity spread across Ireland, many of Lúnasa's customs were adapted into Christian practices, creating a rich blend of cultural and religious traditions that invite reflection from a Christian perspective. The Christianization of Lúnasa is evident in festivals like Lammas ("loaf mass"), where the first sheaf of grain was baked into bread and blessed in church, symbolizing gratitude to God for His provision. This practice resonates with biblical themes of offering first fruits to God (e.g., Leviticus 23:10-14, Deuteronomy 26:1-11), where the Israelites were commanded to present the first produce of the land as an act of thanksgiving and trust in God's sustenance. In Ireland, Lúnasa traditions like climbing Croagh Patrick on Reek Sunday (the last Sunday in July) became Christian pilgrimages, blending the Celtic hilltop gatherings with devotion to St. Patrick, who is said to have fasted there for 40 days.

From a Christian viewpoint, Lúnasa's focus on harvest aligns with the biblical call to give thanks for God's provision. The festival's communal gatherings feasting, sharing food, and celebrating together-echo the early Christian practice of breaking bread in fellowship. Harvest Thanksgiving masses and services, continue to be celebrated in many parishes, often feature decorated churches with fruits, vegetables, and wheat sheaves, reflecting gratitude for God's creation and provision. These services emphasize not only physical harvest but also spiritual fruitfulness, encouraging believers to share their blessings with others, as seen in Isaiah 58:7-8, which calls for sharing bread with the hungry.

Imagine that you had to employ a gardener. You ask around among your friends and neighbours, and eventually you hear of two gardeners who are available. From people who have employed them, you are able to draw up the following profiles of the two.

The first gardener plants a variety of vegetables and flowers. Periodically he comes along and inspects them. Whenever he sees a plant or a flower that is not doing well, he pulls it up and throws it on the compost heap or into the bin. He has planted plenty of seeds and plants, so this practice does not greatly affect the yield or the appearance of the garden. Small, stunted and yellow cabbage plants, wallflowers that slugs have had a feed on, frost-bitten blossoms, all of these go out. There are a lot of advantages in this approach. The appearance of the garden is always pretty and healthy. And diseased plants do not get a chance to infect other plants.

The second gardener also plants a variety of vegetables and flowers and periodically inspects them. But his approach is different. He is on the lookout for plants that are not doing well to see what he can do to make them healthier. If a cabbage is looking vellow, he gives it more feed. If a flower is attacked by slugs he puts down extra slug-killer. If some of the blossoms are frost-bitten, he puts a glass cloche over them to protect them and give them a chance to recover. He hates to see any plant or flower dying. His gardens are not as pretty as those looked after by the first gardener, as some of the plants are clearly ailing.

If you wanted to employ a gardener, you would almost certainly

choose the first. The first strikes us as an efficient, practical, nononsense gardener. The second gardener seems soft-hearted, and is plant-centered rather than garden-centered. Except in the case of very rare plants, few of us would want to pay good money so that sickly specimens would be nursed, and perhaps the overall condition of the garden neglected.

One of the great benefits, of cultivating a personal relationship with Jesus Christ is his unending life giving, grace- filled presence. In a world and culture, where so much emphasis is on perfection, achievement, excellence, it's a great blessing that in faith, our God, loves us as we are. All our gardens like our lives, have both flowers

Saint Paul, once acknowledged, "When I am weak then I am strong". As we give thanks for the gift of harvest, let us be fuelled with a spirit of gratitude. May this new month of September be a blessed one for us all. Be mindful that each one of us produces rich fruits, often as a result of patience, endurance, resilience and courage. May we celebrate that the rich diversity, that is the garden of life, there is room for everyone, as the melody sings...All God's creatures have a place in the choir.

Perhaps this harvest time is an opportunity for us all, to acknowledge the fruits that we all have in the depth of our being. Fruits that take a lot of time to grow and mature into the beautiful personality and unique qualities that are particular to all our stories. The gift of Grandparents who embody the story of every harvest. Parents who respond so generously to the needs of their children. Parenting I'm sure in many ways could be likened to tending the needs of the vineyard, it is constant, demanding, most challenging and in many ways totally dependent on the unconditional generosity and reservoir of love, that provides for the needs of family life. I am often truly inspired by the time and indeed sacrifices that so many wonderful parents, so often make for their children, in order to allow them to grow and realize the best possible harvest for their family. No fruit or talent can realize its potential without effort and work. May the Lord bless all our lives with health of body and peace of mind. The following prayer to St. Francis of Assisi is most appropriate for this time.

For a harvest shared by all

St Francis of Assisi, your whole life sang in harmony with God, nature and others.

With you, we praise God for Brother Sun, full of beauty and splendour, warming the earth, summoning shoots from darkness into daylight.

We praise God for Sister Water, so useful and humble, precious and pure, greening arid ground, growing life in desert places.

Pray for us Francis, that, like you, we may care for all that exists, until Brother Sun and Sister Water produce a harvest shared by all, in love and solidarity, justice and peace.
