
















PART THREE THE LITURGY OF THE EUCHARIST

WE COME TOGETHER TO SHARE IN CHRIST'S BODY AND BLOOD



Gifts of Bread and Wine

Jesus purposely chose bread and wine to be the signs of his Body and Blood. Bread is known as the staff of life; it is a basic food for life. Jesus is our Bread of Life.

Wine was used by Jesus at the Last Supper to represent his Blood, shed on behalf of many for the forgiveness of sins. It also alludes to the heavenly banquet in which we will share because of Christ's sacrifice.

Both bread and wine require our co-operation with the work of creation. Wheat and grapes; bread and wine. 'Fruit of the vine and work of human hands'. A powerful reminder to us that God always seeks our cooperation and participation in what God is doing for us and to us in love.

In Memory of Him ...

In this part of the Mass we join with Christ in doing what he asked us to do in memory of him. We share in the **meal** that he had with his disciples, his followers, in the upper room on Holy Thursday: The Last Supper.

Jesus saw in this meal a foreshadowing of his own sacrifice of love on the Cross. He knew that he would give his very life, his body and his blood, for the salvation of God's people. And he promised that, whenever this meal is shared, his act of love, his sacrifice, will not only be remembered but it will be present to us and for us.

In the Liturgy of the Eucharist, Christ is with us; reaching out to us in love once more. His once and for all sacrifice on Calvary is being poured out into our lives in this moment, for the forgiveness of all our sins; making each of us holy and bringing us God's healing and salvation.

Christ is present to us in a real and substantial way under the signs of bread and wine. Through the great prayer of thanksgiving, the Eucharistic Prayer, the bread and wine that we bring to the altar is transformed by God. Through consecration they are made sacred and holy. They become, as Jesus said himself, his Body and Blood. This is what we say Amen to when we receive Christ – The Body of Christ; the Blood of Christ.

The Four Actions of the Liturgy of the Eucharist

The shape of the Liturgy of the Eucharist follows closely the shape of the meal that Jesus had with his disciples at the Last Supper. It is very similar, also, to other meals that Jesus shared in his ministry on earth. For example, the feeding of the five thousand and the meal he shared with the two disciples on the road to Emmaus. (See Matthew 14:13-21 and Luke 24:28ff)

In all these meals we see a four-fold pattern that we can still recognise in our modern-day celebration of the Mass. These are the actions of *Taking – Blessing – Breaking – Sharing*. They each correspond to an element of the Liturgy of the Eucharist:

- Taking The Preparation of the Altar and the Presentation of Gifts
- + Blessing The Eucharistic Prayer
- Breaking The Lamb of God with its accompanying action (also known as the Fraction Rite)
- + Sharing The procession of the people with reception of Holy Communion



The Eucharist, although it is the fullness of sacramental life, is not a prize for the perfect but a powerful medicine and nourishment for the weak.

Taking: The Preparation of the Altar and Presentation of the Gifts

We sit for this simple action of setting the table of the altar for the sacred meal we are about to share. The gifts of bread and wine are presented by members of the congregation on all our behalf. We are very much part of this action.

Ideally, enough bread is brought forward to facilitate as many people as possible to receive Hosts consecrated at this Mass.

After prayers have been said over the gifts, they, as well as the Cross, ministers and people, may be incensed, underscoring the sacredness of this action.

As we present these gifts, we know in faith that God will make them holy (consecrate) and transform them into the Body and Blood of Christ.

Along with our gifts we are invited to present our very selves for God's blessing and transformation. We are invited to do this every time we gather to celebrate the Eucharist!

Sunday as a day of Charity During this time in the Mass, we also present monetary gifts. This has its roots in the earliest times of Christianity. On one hand, the parish belongs to us and we are responsible for its upkeep. On the other hand, as Christians each of us is called to care for the needs of the poor; this is why our Trócaire and other charitable collections are so important.

Blessing: The Eucharistic Prayer

We come to the core and centre of our Sunday Mass. We stand for the opening of this prayer as 'we lift up our hearts to the Lord'. There are a number of Eucharistic Prayers (EP) that can be used at Mass; they all have common elements that are essential to any EP. All of them are addressed to God the Father.

Next time you are at Mass listen and see if you can recognise the following elements of the EP.

After an Opening Dialogue between priest and people, the priest leads us in the Preface. This text changes for each celebration. In it we remember the good things God has done for us and we give thanks and praise to God (the meaning of 'Eucharist' is to give thanks).

This is followed by a (sung) acclamation by the congregation and priest, the 'Holy, Holy' or Sanctus. Here we join our prayer with that of the saints and angels in heaven. Then we kneel as we enter deeper into the prayer.

In every sacrament, at some point, we call upon God to send down the Holy Spirit. In the EP we ask God to send the Holy Spirit upon the bread and wine so that they will become the Body and Blood of Christ.


The words and actions of Jesus himself at the Last Supper are now repeated in the Institution Narrative and Consecration. These sacred words achieve what they promise and express. Jesus, and his sacrifice of love, is now present among us under the signs of bread and wine which are now his Body and Blood. This real and saving presence is what we are invited to receive in Holy Communion.

In response, we sing (or say) the Memorial Acclamation to Christ, recalling and confessing our belief in the central 'Mystery of our faith' - His death and resurrection.

We continue to recall Jesus' passion, resurrection and ascension into heaven and we offer to God this 'once and for all' sacrifice of Christ. In doing so we also join ourselves and our lives to this offering to God. The prayer goes on to pray a series of intercessions, deepening our bond with the saints, Mary, the local and the wider Church, as well as those gone before us. The EP concludes where it began, with a prayer of praise and glory to God, called the Doxology. We, the assembly, respond with our Amen, endorsing not just the Doxology but also all that we have prayed in the whole of the EP - our Great Prayer of Thanksgiving Breaking and sharing:

I am sure that most of you have read a book, seen a movie, or at least heard the story about "Aladdin and His Wonderful Lamp." In one version of the story, Aladdin worked in a shop that exchanged new lamps for old ones. Aladdin's job was to polish the lamps and make them look like new. One day, as he was polishing a lamp, a genie came out of the lamp and promised to grant Aladdin anything he wished for. With the help of the Genie, Aladdin gained great wealth and won the love of a beautiful princess.

Wouldn't it be wonderful to have your every wish come true? You might think so, but the truth is, sometimes the things we wish for are not good for us. That is what a young man discovered in today's Gospel. The Gospel today is about a young man who had three wishes.

- 1. He wished for a lot of money.
- 2. He wished to travel and see the world.
- 3. He wished he could be his own boss.

The young man got his wishes, but they were not granted to him by a genie. The young man went to his father and asked him to give him the inheritance that would be his when his father died. Even though the father was sad that his son wanted to leave, he gave him his share of the family fortune and the young man left home and travelled all around the world. He visited all of the places he had always wanted to visit and did whatever he wanted to do. He was happy that no one was telling him what to do. Since the young man had a lot of money, if he saw something he wanted, he bought it, and since he had a lot of money, he also had many friends.

This sounds like very happy story, doesn't it? Well, that isn't the end of the story. After a while, the young man ran out of money. When he ran out of money, his friends ran out on him. He was so desperate that he went to work for a man who sent him to feed his pigs. The young man was so hungry that he would gladly have eaten the food he was feeding to the pigs. As he looked at the filthy pig pen, he thought about the mess he had made of his life. He thought about his father and the home he had left behind.

"Even a servant in my father's house lives better than this," the young man said to himself. "I will return to my father and tell him that I am sorry for the way I have behaved and ask him to give me a job as one of his servants."

Do you think the father was willing to take him back? Yes, but not as a servant. He welcomed him back home as a son. He called his servants together and told them, "Let's have a feast and celebrate. For this son of mine was lost, but now is found."

Well, the story had a happy ending after all, didn't it? This story that Jesus told is really a story about you and me and the way we sometimes behave.

Sometimes you and I make bad choices just like the young man in our story. We sometimes wish for things that are not good for us. We sometimes don't want to listen to God and obey what the Gospel tells us we should do. When we act that way, we really make a mess of our life, Well, I have good news for you! Just like the father in our story, God, our Heavenly Father, is always willing to take us back if we will admit that we were wrong and return to Him.

TIME TO THINK!

A MOTHER'S LOVE IS A BLESSING

Sure I love the dear silver that shines in your hair. Does anyone recognise that song? An old Irish favourite, Mother Machree! I remember my father singing it to us and the words have been flowing through my head this week as I wondered how to prepare a homily for Mothers' Day. Of course, this is the ideal song for mothers - even if it was written with an older woman in mind. Age is irrelevant when it comes to love and care and being there for another.

Hear the words:

Sure, I love the dear silver that shines in your hair And the brow that's all furrowed and wrinkled with care I kiss the dear fingers so toil worn for me


O God bless you and keep you, Mother Machree.

Something that makes the song especially relevant for us today is the name Machree. It's made up of two Gaelic words, ma / chroi which carry the meaning from the heart. Isn't that precisely why we honour mothers? They serve from the heart. And when we honour someone, that honour comes from our hearts, from our memories of love given and shared. It's from the heart that truth and goodness shine; from the heart mistakes are forgiven and forgotten. Regrettably, it's also from the heart that other memories come: memories of going without, memories of absence, pain, neglect! But that's when Mothers' Day can become a time of healing, a time of letting go the hurt that a struggling, anxious, or abandoned mother may have inflicted on those in her care. To be generous in forgiveness is possibly the best kind of honouring.

Jesus honours his disciples in this way when he greets them with Peace be with you, following their betrayal and cowardice. His forgiveness overflowed and swamped their sense of unworthiness and in today's gospel we see this forgiveness in the Father's love for his sons. He is calling us to this same love, to love without limits and consequences.

Jesus' love is a forgiving love. He understands our weaknesses; he knows the efforts we make and the pressures we can find ourselves under. He knew Peter would not be able to hold his nerve and would deny his friend; he knew the others would panic and run. He saw them as little children, not yet able to take responsibility for themselves or their actions. We are children of God, privileged way beyond our understanding, but destined for greatness if we can just learn to think more of others than ourselves.

Love one another as I have loved you - could also be the legacy of a mother to her children.



A mother's love models the most unselfish love and it is richly laced with forgiveness. A two year old is into all the low-lying cupboards and before long there's a breaking sound as a dish shatters. At that moment, the real mother's concern is for the child, not the loss of property. Her love pours out, overwhelming any feeling of annoyance or disappointment. She reacts from the heart: the good of the child is primary.

In their way of loving, mothers can show their children what God's love is like, and with Jesus they can say to them, love one another as I have loved you.

A contemporary song thanks a mother in these words: In my heart you bring the sunshine on my stormy days. To my soul you bring the fire that brightens up my way. The greatest gift that love can bring is your presence in my life. But I still cherish the song my Dad used to sing - and I sing it for every mother among us, and for those who have died: Sure I love the dear silver that shines...

A Prayer in Gratitude for Our Mothers

Good and Gentle God, we pray in gratitude for our mothers and for all the women of history who have joined with you in the wonder of bringing forth new life. You who became human through a woman, grant to all mothers the courage they need to face the uncertain

future that life with children always brings. Give them the strength to live and to be loved in

return, not perfectly, but humanly.

Give them the faithful support of a loving partner, family and friends as they care for the physical and spiritual growth of their children.

Give them joy and delight in their children to sustain them through the trials of motherhood.

Most of all, give them the wisdom to turn to you for help when they need it most.


