

Accepting Our Crosses

Jesus began to show his disciples that he must go to Jerusalem and undergo great suffering and death at the hands of the

elders, chief priests and scribes. Peter took Jesus aside, "This must never happen to you," he said. Surely Peter only had Jesus' best interests at heart. Imagine how mortified he must have felt to hear Jesus reply, "Get behind me Satan! You are a stumbling block to me; for you are setting your mind not on divine things but on human things."

What kind of deal is it to get everything you want in life but lose your soul? So often when we finally get what we want in life, the euphoria is short lived. We might feel elated for a few days at achieving one of our closest held ambitions, but then we are left with that hollow, 'what next?' kind of feeling. 












Coronavirus COVID-19 **OUR CLINIC POLICY**

HOW DO WE SUPPORT OUR PARISH INTO THE FUTURE?

Since lockdown in March of this year due to Covid-19 we have had to adapt to a whole new way of living and being Parish. We appreciate now the freedom we used to have to gather without being overly concerned about health and safety. It is difficult to get used to the new regulations and restrictions as we gather now in smaller numbers and observe 'social distance' from each other - the very antithesis of worship a few months ago! There is of course no obligation on anyone to attend Mass on Sundays or Holydays during this time of pandemic and we ask anyone with underlying conditions which makes them vulnerable, to be particularly aware of this at this time. We know many are nervous and you shouldn't be worried about missing Mass. But make no mistake about it we do miss you and you are constantly in our prayers. You are still a cherished member of our Parish. Many join us via our Parish Radio (106.5am) or Webcam, Facebook Live or ShalomWorld.org (who transmit our 10am Mass each day including Sunday). Many from outside the Parish join us also and we receive quite a number of requests for inclusion in prayer from all over the World.

All of this has had a huge impact on our funding. We had been used to a very generous response every weekend to our collections - Our Offertory collection which effectively ran the Parish and our Development fund which enabled the considerable development in the Parish over the past number of years. We will not be returning to passing the 'blue bags' or the 'baskets' anytime soon - maybe never. We know we still have a generous and supportive cohort of parishioners. Many have found ways of supporting the Parish at this time, many have continued to use the Parish envelopes and deposited them in one of the boxes available in the Churches or to the Parish Centre, some have made contribution by cheque or cash, some have found the 'donate facility' on our website (some have signed up to a regular subscription via this method), some are using the envelopes placed near the new donation boxes in our Churches. We have also recently installed a 'cashless payment' gadget at the back of the Church and it is being used. We are very grateful to all who have contributed in whatever way - thank you. While we are grateful for all that generosity, all in all, our donations have been down close to 50% over the past 5 months. We have to get used to a new way of supporting our Parish and the Priests collections. We need your support and ask you to find a way of supporting the Parish that suits your circumstances.

VARIOUS WAYS TO SUPPORT OUR COLLECTIONS




The traditional 'box of envelopes'. These are distributed to those who wish to use them each year in February. There has been a decline over the past few years of those using

this method to contribute to the Parish, about 100 at present. That is understandable against the backdrop of two collections at our Sunday Masses. But in these changed circumstances we hope there might be a renewed uptake of the 'boxes' when we come to distribute them next year. In the meantime there are envelopes available adjacent to the donation boxes in our Churches and at the Parish Centre.

TIME TO THINK!

LORD INCREASE OUR FAITH

You don't just wake up one morning, light streaming in from the window, birds fluttering about, and jump from your bed with exuberance declaring "I have a faith!" No, it's more like a slow crawl from your bed as you try to slam on the snooze button one last time.

Getting faith isn't easy, even though people put the phrase "have faith!" on repeat like it's no big deal. It's a slow, sometimes agonizing process that many people give up on, but in truth, it's worth the wait. Having faith puts that pep in your step when you feel like you've busted a kneecap. It gets you to try one more time towards your righteous desires and keeps you smiling when all you want to do is crawl back into bed. Faith is the end result of a long journey, but makes the trip bearable.

But sometimes it can be hard to see the road to faith, or at least the end of the road. If you've found yourself in this spot, Martin Luther King Jr. has some wise words.

"Take the first step in faith. You don't have to see the whole staircase, just take the first step."

So what is the first step? Honestly, it's different for everyone. But if you're having a hard time viewing that staircase, here are a few steps to get you started.

Identify the Doubt

What's causing you anxiety right now? What's making you worry? What's filling you with doubt? Pinpoint an area of your life that's weighing you down and take some time to ponder why it's so hard. If you need to, find a quiet space to meditate or pray about the things that are bothering you, and ask yourself why these things are having an impact on your life.

Why are we doing this? Because in order to identify a solution, we need to identify the problem.

Find Your Mantra

Having a little saying you can repeat to yourself in times of trouble is a great way to dispel fear. Faith is a concept that's been around since the beginning of mankind, and you can find motivating quotes across the religious or spiritual spectrum. Take some time to search them out and find a phrase or quote that speaks to you. Put this quote somewhere you can see it often, like your phone. Then when you feel that fear or anxiety begin to rise, just take a deep breath, and repeat after them:

"Having faith does not mean having no difficulties, but having the strength to face them, knowing we are not alone." - Pope Francis

"If it can be solved, there's no need to worry, and if it can't be solved, worry is of no use." -Dalai Lama

"For with God, nothing shall be impossible." - Luke 1:37

Take Action

Now that we've identified the problem and have a mantra to keep us focused, let's work on that solution. Write your problem down and start brainstorming ways to fix it, even the hard ones. What are the obvious ways you can fix it? The not-so obvious? Make bullet points until you have a solid list, then go through and find the solution that would be the most effective.



And now you'll take action. You might be afraid, but that's okay. Faith isn't about not having fear, it's about acting anyway. So take that solution and run with it, not looking back.

Faith isn't a one-step process, and it's also not a one-stop shop. In order to find and keep faith, you'll need to practice over and over again. But that's okay! With each step you'll become stronger and stronger until faith is your first reaction to challenges, not fear
