#### If Forgiveness Was Infectious

"Forgive us our sins as we forgive those who have sinned against us." Just imagine what sort of world we would live in if this simple statement could become a reality. Imagine feeling the relief of being forgiven for our sins and in turn, forgiving those who had

sinned against us. Imagine the same people forgiving those who had sinned against them and so on and so on until the world's screaming grievances grew gradually quieter and finally disappeared altogether. What a wonderful world that would be. Is it any wonder Jesus talks so much of repentance, forgiveness and reconciliation?

So how can we make forgiveness more of a reality? How can we make forgiveness globally 'infectious'? Firstly we need to look inwards. What do we each need to be forgiven for? Who might we be hurting, perhaps unintentionally? Might we have made someone feel small or stupid with a careless or overly sharp remark? Might we have spoilt someone else's relationship by indulging in an affair? Have we neglected a lonely or vulnerable family member? Might we have bullied someone, gossiped behind someone's back, lied, cheated or taken something that didn't belong? Have we contributed to keeping someone else in poverty or denied a helping hand when it was desperately needed? Only when we can admit our own sins and unburden our own guilt can we really appreciate the value of forgiveness in the lives of others.

Offering forgiveness is just as hard as asking for it. How often do we hear someone say, "I will never forgive that person for what they have done!" Behind the statement is a deep rooted need to avenge the offender, either by hurting them back, or by withholding forgiveness. One person not forgiving another person is bad enough, but when entire nations are unable to forgive, then mankind is in big trouble! Sometimes the sins of others are so great that we wonder how we can begin to forgive. Sometimes a crime is so great and the culprit so devoid of remorse that we wonder whether we should really be expected to forgive, yet Jesus tells us, "I do not tell you to forgive seven times but seventy seven."

It is clear that we need a few helpful strategies in place to move us from feelings of vengeance and violence to a more peaceful place. The first and probably the easiest strategy is to search for some level of understanding and empathy. Understanding why someone has done something is a strong platform for forgiveness. However, where empathy totally eludes us, it is important for us to entrust the mechanics of justice to others who are less angry and less prejudiced than ourselves. Another 'must' is to set aside any notion of forgiveness turning us into doormats or naïve and deluded 'do-gooders'. The strategy that Jesus teaches us today is that we can become more compassionate as individuals by remembering how often we have been forgiven ourselves.... perhaps more times than we can remember.







## World Suicide Prevention Day

#### 10<sup>th</sup> September 2020







World Suicide Prevention Day which took place on September 10<sup>th</sup>, highlighted the opportunity for all of us to play our part in preventing suicide. We can all make a difference, as a member of society, as a parent, as a friend, as a colleague or as a neighbour. There are many things that we can do, on a daily basis to prevent suicidal behaviour. These include raising awareness about the issue, educating ourselves and others about the causes and the warning signs for suicide, showing compassion and care for those who are in distress in our communities, questioning the stigma associated with suicide, suicidal behaviour and mental health problems and also by sharing our own experiences.

The HSE Resource Office for Suicide Prevention offers training programmes that prepare participants to recognise, engage with and support persons who may be having thoughts of suicide. Start is a one and half hour online programme which advises a four-step model and includes impactful simulations and practices. It can be accessed by contacting your local Resource Officer; Josephine Rigney (Laois/Offaly), e-mail: josephine.rigney@hse.ie or phone 086-8157850.

How can we change the stigma associated with suicide?

- Challenge common myths about or attitudes toward suicide. This will encourage society to look at suicide from a different
  perspective one founded in openness, understanding and compassion for others.
- Use trusted sources to educate yourself on mental health difficulties and on suicide. Learn to use informed, appropriate, sensitive and non-judgemental language and try not to make assumptions. Don't identify a person solely by his or her mental health difficulty and never use 'suicide' as a noun to describe a person.
- Recognise the contribution of people who have mental health difficulties, have attempted suicide and recovered, or who
  have been bereaved by suicide. This will give you an invaluable insight into lived experience and will also be very empowering
  and healing for others.
- Start a conversation with someone you care about. When doing so, you don't have to be an expert or have all the answers –
  just listening with compassion, empathy and a lack of judgement can help restore hope.

Reflection Ceremonies: This year the theme of World Suicide Prevention Day is 'Working Together to Prevent Suicide' and to mark this, 'Reflection Ceremonies' have been organised by Midlands Living Links to be held at the locations of the 'Trees of Hope' in the various towns in the Midland counties. In Portlaoise details are as follows;

Sunday 20<sup>th</sup> September at 11.30am - Tree of Hope, Memorial Garden, Ridge Road, Portlaoise, followed by Blessing at 12.15pm, Sensory Gardens, Rockview Walkways R427.

#### TIME TO THINK!

#### THE PLAGUE OF GOSSIP

A woman, pushing on in years, boasted to her broken relationship, a serious mistake. And for pastor that she did not have an enemy in the many of us we do not believe that there is world. He was very impressed. What a wonderful another chance much less a seven times seventy thing to be able to say after all those years! And chances. This is not the teaching of Jesus. God then she added:- 'I have outlived them all'. I does not just give us another chance, but every suppose if we live long enough we will also be time we close a door he opens another one for us. able to make the same statement.

We have all been hurt in some way or other in the damaging mistakes, but he also tells us that our journey of life, made fun of in school by a teacher, not invited to the wedding, didn't get the job I thought I should have got, or at a more serious that nothing is irrevocable. Nothing can separate level, betrayed by someone you trusted, abused us from the love of God.. physically or emotionally and so on.

Sheila Cassidy, who was herself tortured in South America, had this to say:- 'I would never say to someone 'you must forgive'. I would not dare. Who am I to tell a woman whose father abused her or a mother whose daughter has been raped that she must forgive? I can only say: 'However much we have been wronged, however justified our hatred, if we cherish it, it will poison us. We must pray for the power to forgive, for it is in forgiving that we are healed'. Nelson Mandela continually reminded his fellow prisoners in South Africa that unless they let go of their hurts they would remain in the grip of their abusers.

By failing to forgive, we hurt ourselves more than anyone else. Surely this is what Jesus had in mind when he told how the merciless servant was cast into prison when he refused to forgive his fellow servant. I don't think he was suggesting that God would cancel his mercy. He is simply saying that an unforgiving spirit creates a prison of its own. It builds up walls of bitterness and resentment and there is no escape until we come to forgive.

Forgiving and letting go is not easy, especially when the wound is very deep. This is why I call forgiveness the 'F' word, because it's not to be used lightly. Forgiveness is a choice and often involves a three stage process: (1) I will never forgive that person (2) I can't forgive (forgiveness seen as a good thing, but the hurt is too great) (3) I want to forgive and let go with God's help.

Also we must learn to forgive ourselves. Imagine you are responsible for something very serious. You are driving a car with drink. There is an accident and a young person is killed. That life cannot be brought back. For more and more people there is something in the background, some skeleton in the closet - a broken marriage, a

Pope Francis has said "gossiping is a worse plague" than the coronavirus, claiming it can be used to divide the Roman Catholic Church.

It is the not the first time Francis has brought up the subject of gossiping. In 2016, he urged priests and nuns to avoid spreading stories within their community to prevent the "terrorism of gossip".

The heart of the Gospel is one of healing and forgiveness. May we all go in the grace to be able to let go, so we can begin again.

There is a large and very competent staff and they pull very well together - there are no tensions. There's an army of volunteers in teaching, singing, and other areas, too many to mention. So these factors contribute so much to a pleasant Christian atmosphere.

The living Faith is very strong, manifested in the large numbers who come to Sunday Masses and to weekday Masses. The Heath and Ratheniska have their own vibrant communities. I have to record the beautiful churches and the amazing Parish Centre. Also, you'll generally find people praying in the churches and lighting candles during the day when the churches are open. The people of the parish contribute very generously to the Offertory collections and the Development Fund and this makes possible the work of running the Parish. The horses have to be fed.

Then there are the various special apostolates: to the sick in the hospital, the nursing homes and those sick at home, to the huge number of people in schools, to refugees and to those in need.

If you 're reading this you're probably saying to yourself, - "Sure I know all that" - but it's good to record all the goodness and the Good News and to say Thanks to God and to all in the parish for my seven joyful years as a member of the parish. I really miss being there. (The pandemic has turned everything upside down but the story of the Flood and Noah is a parable of total destruction and then recovery.)




