This weekend concludes our celebrations with St. Francis, Kolbe and Educate Together. We hope they will have a lovely day.



# Cornerstone

What happens when we forget that our lives are a gift from God? What happens when we forget that human-kind God's creation? What happens when we forget that the planet we live on belongs to God? Today's parable describes a land owner who leaves tenants in charge of his vineyard. But



at harvest time the tenants refuse to pay their rent, failing to recognise the landowner's authority and killing the servants and even the son who are sent for the rent. The tenants appear to have forgotten that the vineyard belongs to the landowner. The tenants had come to believe that they could make up their own rules. They had forgotten that they were accountable. They had forgotten that they had been responsibilities and entrusted with stewardship.

God is still master of the 'vineyard', and we are the new tenants to whom the welfare of the vineyard has been passed on. The parable was originally targeted at the Pharisees, but for us too, the parable demands some degree of self-examination. We might think of ourselves as good people, but like the first tenants, do we constantly fight shy of accountability? Over the years we each develop our own individual code of conduct. Perhaps we begin to feel that as long as we are living by some kind of moral code we no longer need to be accountable. We begin to imagine that accountable', is just for those who go round getting things wrong. Living by self-made standards is all well and good, but if we do this are we in danger of forgetting about the very high standards that God has set for us.

What happens when we forget that Christ is our cornerstone? When we make up our own rules with little thought for Jesus' teachings, the chances are we will fall a long way short of what God expects. Today's invitation is to raise the bar, step up to the mark, and recognise Christ as our cornerstone.





# Parable of the Tenants

The Gospel today is about one of Jesus' parables. It is a story about a man who owned some land. He planted some grapes on the land and then rented it to some other farmers who were to work in the vineyard and take care of it for him. Part of the agreement he had with these farmers was that they would give him a share of the crops.



When it came time to harvest the grapes, the landowner sent his servants to collect his share of the harvest. The farmers who had leased the land beat the servants and even killed one of them. They refused to give the landowner what was owed to him.

A second time the landowner sent servants, more than the first time, but again the farmers treated them in the same way.

Finally, he sent his own son, thinking, "Surely they will respect my son."

But when they saw the son coming, they said, "This is the landowner's son, let's kill him and take his inheritance."

Jesus asked the men listening to his story, "What do you think the landowner will do to those men?"

"He will destroy those wicked men, and rent his land to someone else, who will give him his share of the fruit at harvest time" answered his listeners.

In this story that Jesus told, the landowner represents God. God first sent men such as Noah, Moses, David, the prophet Isaiah, and others to tell people of his love for them and to call them to turn away from their wicked ways, but many would not listen. Finally, he sent His own Son, Jesus. You know what they did to him, don't you? That's right, they crucified him. God gave them a chance. He even gave them a second chance—and a third. But when they rejected His Son, that was their last chance. He is our last chance too—our only chance to have eternal life in heaven with him.



# St. Francis - An Iconic Saint

Upon his election in March 2013, Pope Francis said: sexual abuse that has so damaged the church's 'Some people want to know why I wished to be called credibility and its ability to evangelise. Francis. For me, Francis of Assisi is the man of poverty, the man of peace, the man who loves and protects pleading with nations and world leaders to protect the creation."

Since then, the Pope's Franciscan "accent" has become increasingly evident. His manner of living is both faithful to the teachings of Jesus and illuminated by the spirit of the "poor little man" from Assisi. The title of Pope Francis' encyclical on the environment Laudato si is taken from the first line of St. Francis' Canticle of the Creatures which is one of the best insights into the saint's vision for life. It is crucial to grasping how St. Francis understood the message of the gospel and may offer a glimpse into Pope Francis' own vision for the world.

After his election as pope, it was revealed that Pope Francis had been the runner-up in the previous conclave in 2005 that elected Pope Benedict. But in 2013 it was generally thought that Jorge Bergoglio was too old to be considered again, and he must of thought so himself, because he bought a round-trip ticket from Buenos Aires to Rome for the election.

Yet, as the conclave proceeded, Bergoglio had to think again what being pope could mean, and what name he would choose if he were elected. By becoming Pope Francis, he managed to express in that name much of what he hoped to accomplish during his papacy. St. Francis of Assisi was synonymous with themes Pope Francis quickly made his own: He was devoted to the poor, he preached God's mercy, he sought to reform the church and he was passionate about caring for Creation.

The annual feast of St. Francis invites us to reflect on the life of the saint and to ask if his namesake has succeeded in advancing his vision for the Church. Within hours of his election, Pope Francis quoted Pope John XXIII's wish to bring the global church closer to the poor and to its original mission expressed by Jesus when he began his ministry in Nazareth quoting the prophet Isaiah, saying he was "anointed to bring good news to the poor."

Pope Francis has worked steadily to address the needs of the poor by challenging income inequality, the exploitation of workers, by pleading for migrants displaced by war, changing weather, industrial pollution, dumping and the indiscriminate and unequal consumption of natural resources. He proclaimed a Year of Mercy to promote God's unconditional love and to focus on reconciliation within the church as the face of God's mercy to sinners.

Jesus told St. Francis to "repair my church," and Pope Francis has been tireless in seeking to reform governance and internal structures, financial accountability and by addressing the scandal of child

Perhaps Pope Francis' most urgent task has been planet, "our common home," as the one goal and challenge that will determine all other changes needed to avert disaster now and for future generations.

St. Francis modelled simplicity and evangelical poverty as the antidote to a medieval church losing its identity because of wealth and corruption. His community of friars grew rapidly as young people found a way to live purposely and free of material greed and preoccupation with status and power. St. Francis imitated the poor Jesus and his passionate love for the poor.

Pope Francis has not shied away from sounding the alarm and probing the consciences of our age about what history will say of those who knew what was coming but did nothing.

St. Francis, who died at age 44, exhausted by his efforts to repair God's church and protect the planet and God's poor, now speaks again to us on his feast and through his beloved and courageous brother, Pope Francis.

#### **FAREWELL TO FR. MICHAEL KELLY**



Raheen Parish Pastoral Council, on behalf of all the parishioners of Raheen Parish, extend their very best wishes to Fr. Michael Kelly who left our Parish during the week.

Fr. Michael came to Raheen parish in July 2016 on his appointment as Parish Priest and he continued in that role until his retirement in July 2019. Since then he continued his priestly ministry in Raheen parish and he also assisted in

both Abbeyleix and Ballinakill parishes from time to time.

In Raheen parish Fr. Michael has left a huge legacy of work well done such as the painting of Shanahoe church, inside and outside, the electrification of the Shanahoe church bell, the double-glazing of the church windows in Shanahoe with the aid of a generous grant that he single-handedly secured from the Albert Gubay Foundation amounting to almost €25,000, and the clearing of a loan of approximately €70,000 for the roof restoration project in Raheen church - achieved in large part by Fr. Michael's pursuit of tax refunds from the Revenue Commissioners which generated substantial income for the parish, as well as from the donations of generous parishioners.

While serving as Parish Priest Fr. Michael established a new Parish Pastoral Council and a separate Finance Committee soon after his arrival. Under his leadership, new teams of Eucharistic Ministers were formed in Raheen and Shanahoe churches, new Baptism Teams were put in place, rotas were organised for readers groups and a Liturgy Committee was set up. Through all of this work, Fr. Michael's skills as an able administrator shone through. More importantly, Fr. Michael played a key and active pastoral role in the parish not only in terms of celebrating Sunday Masses, officiating at baptisms, weddings and funerals but also in his pastoral care for the housebound, the sick, the dying and the bereaved.

Many parishioners have been touched by Fr. Michael's compassion in their time of great need over the past four years and they will miss him for the pastoral support and care he has given to them. We thank Fr. Michael very sincerely for the enormous contribution he has made to our parish over the past four years and for the energy and dedication with which he applied himself to his ministry here. He will be greatly missed. As he now begins the next chapter of his life in his native Co. Tipperary we wish him good luck, good health and God's blessings on him for many years of happiness and fulfilment.
