

We welcomed Fr. Theo Tomasik a member of the Society of Divine Word (SVD). He looks forward to a time of ministering here in Portlaoise without the restrictions of Covid which have dominated his first months. He is very welcome.

What should have been one of the highlights of the year, the reopening of the Church of the Assumption, the Heath after extensive work and renovation, had to be celebrated in a quiet and restricted manner. Nevertheless it has been greatly appreciated, beautiful, comfortable and protected to survive another century.

In spite of the pandemic we have enjoyed great support from our parishioners as usual this year. My thanks to all those who support the parish and those who are active in ministry, readers, Eucharistic ministers and new ministries of cleaners and stewards. While our choirs are at rest we have enjoyed wonderful music from a very talented and generous group who enriched our Liturgies during this pandemic. To help us experience something of the peace and joy of this time I recommend whole heartedly our 'Virtual Carol Service' available on our website as a wonderful way to bring the story and spirit of Christmas into your home. Play it, pray it, and sing along! One feature of this year has been the addition of a 'virtual congregation' joining us via parish radio, webcam, facebooklive and ShalomWorld. We are very conscious and grateful for the presence in that way, of not only many parishioners but 'new parishioners' from all over the World who have made St. Peter & Paul's, Portlaoise, their parish Church during this pandemic.

### TIME TO THINK!

#### LIGHT BRIGHTER THAN ANY DARKNESS

2020 has been a tough year. For months on end we have been listening out for the figures: how many new cases today? How many in ICU? How many deaths? Every one of those figures stands for lives frustrated, threatened, perhaps changed definitively.

As we approach Christmas we pray for those who have died in the past year and our hearts go out to the bereaved. One of the ancient philosophers wrote: 'be kind with everyone you meet today; you do not know what battles they are fighting'. So many of us are dealing with heightened levels of anxiety stemming from loneliness or other hardships made worse by the effects of lockdown. There are those among us whose livelihoods have been seriously threatened by the pandemic. Family gatherings will be different this Christmas and many people will be missing loved ones from the celebration. This year is especially hard for those who can't come home for Christmas.

Even as we acknowledge all of this sadness we Christians remember that the heart of Christmas is Emmanuel, God with us. God is with us. Before he was born in her body, the Christ was born in Mary's heart. He can be, he will be and he is born again in the heart of every Christian even in the midst of sadness and sorrow. That is the heart of Christmas. No matter what, our God is with us and that is the source of our joy.

For generations, Irish families have put a light in the window to invite Jesus, Mary and Joseph into their homes for Christmas. I invite everybody to bring Christ into their home with family prayer. Light a candle near your crib and gather round it for a moment of prayer. Somebody could read the Gospel from Luke chapter 2 and sing a carol or you could simply say the Hail Mary together asking God's blessing on everyone in the house and for those who feel isolated, vulnerable or particularly impacted by the pandemic.

Gathering around the dinner table this Christmas I encourage you to remember all the people who have ensured that throughout this pandemic, we have had access to food; the farmers, food producers, delivery drivers and the staff who have worked in all of our local shops and stores.

When God first appeared in human form it was as part of a family who were out of home, at least temporarily. They were on the brink of being driven from their homeland by political persecution and forced to seek refuge in a foreign country. In the Christmas story we meet a Jesus, Mary and Joseph who were homeless, refugees and asylum seekers. It was not by accident that God identified with the marginalised. At the end of all our lives he will remind



us of this when he will say to us: 'in so far as you did it to one of the least of these, my brothers and sisters you did it to me.'

One of the blessings of the Covid times has been that we've seen so many people step forward and give of their time and energy to help the community, neighbours and strangers alike. And now with Christmas coming so many people are thinking of others more than themselves; people are planning to cook dinners for their neighbours and are seeking ways to be with people who are alone. St Vincent de Paul and other community groups are working very hard to reach out to people in need. Trócaire, as well as many other agencies supported by you, are reaching out to help people in regions still ravaged by war and famine. In this past year their fundraising campaigns have been frustrated by the Covid pandemic. It is important that we remember them, if we can, at Christmas.

This Christmas take time to notice the acts of generosity and kindness in your community. There are a multitude of people engaged in this generosity – they are the messengers of hope and like the host of heavenly angels on the first Christmas night they proclaim that Christ is among us. When the Word became flesh two thousand years ago, it was God's outrageous effort to be born among us and in our hearts. Jesus longs to be a light in the heart of each one of us. He knows about our darkness and wants to shine in our lives. My prayer is that we will let him into our hearts in a new way this Christmas. When we do he will shine in our own darkness and be a light for the world around us.

It is with a sense of great hope that we welcome the vaccines that over the coming months will bring an end to these dark days of pandemic. In a real way, with patience and prudence, may we stay safe and keep each other healthy and well. We also welcome the new light, that slowly will manifest to much brighter days ahead. May we all be blessed with great hope and health throughout 2021.

When Mary and Joseph found out that they were going to have a baby, they didn't have to go to the library and get a book to choose his name. In fact, they didn't choose his name at all. God


sent an angel to tell Mary and Joseph,

#### The First Crib

The Christmas story has a powerful hold on the imagination.

In the midwinter a child is born among us, a child that will save mankind.

One of the most popular places in Italy is the town of Assisi because of its association with *il poverello*, namely St. Francis of Assisi.

One Christmas in 1223, Francis went to Grecco in the valley of Riati. Francis asked that a shed be set up on the hillside, which depicted Mary and Joseph and the Child, surrounded by the shepherds and one or two animals, and he invited the people of Grecco to come and celebrate Christmas with him. They came together and walked with their lamps and stood in front of the first Crib.

St. Francis spoke to them and preached of the mystery of God's coming to us in Jesus.

The people were set alight by the simplicity and the power of his words, because those people were poor and humble and perhaps above all, wanted to experience and receive into their own hearts, the Word of God, Jesus, to bring hope and forgiveness and consolation to their lives.

They were fascinated not only by the words of St. Francis but by entering into the spirit of the first Christmas and contemplating the crib.

From such humble and simple beginnings, I wonder how many cribs are there today in the homes and Churches of the World?



'It is a joy to have friends coming to visit you from afar' so wrote Confucius expressing a truth that is still celebrated by millions of people around the world. Nowadays the connection can be made via the internet link or video - call. But the tradition of needing to connect and come together face to face and celebrate relationship is a deep longing within us. Christmas celebrated God meeting us face to face in a Bethlehem Child: 'I bring you news of great joy, a joy to be shared by the whole people. Today, a saviour has been born to you; he is Christ the Lord' (Luke2:10)

The Christmas story is about our search for find our way home. The home that was lost and which was searched for in the wilderness of exile as the bible tells us. Today we find that home—not in a stable in Bethlehem, not in a carpenter's workshop in Nazareth, not in a temple in Jerusalem, not among the boats on the Sea of Galilee and not in an upper room with locked doors. The home we longed for, the place of encounter with God is to be found within each one of us.

The house of God is not built of stones — but is built of us — all of us. We are the Body of Christ. He is the One who calls us home and makes his home in us. Home is not ultimately a place, not Portlaoise, London, America or China. The old saying is in fact true: 'home is where the heart is.' Our home is where Christ is and where we meet Christ in one another.

This Christmas let us bring into the home of our hearts families who have known unbearable tragedy and loss. Let us entrust all who have known tragic loss especially due to Covid-19 to the One who could count love before the cost and who in keyless rooms, can open doors. The One who is the reason we gather in Church at Christmas. The One from whom we learn to love, to emulate, to imitate, to follow and 'in whom we live and move and have our being' (Acts 17:28)

#### Feast of the Holy Innocents 28th December

The feast of the Holy Innocents recalls the boys aged under two whom Herod killed in order to try and remove Jesus from the scene. This is very much a feast of our time. On this day we



also remember those innocent and defenceless children who still suffer today. The 4000 Irish children without a place to call home this Christmas, children who suffer neglect, and abuse. We remember children who suffer from hunger, poverty and poor health. We remember children who are forced to fight or to work long hours for little or no money in hazardous conditions. On this day we remember that every child has a right to love, security, and basic needs.
