# **Enlightenment**

When we are struggling with our faith, we might be tempted to think that as long as we are 'good people' that will suffice. But what sets those

who are simply 'good people' and 'Christians' apart?

The other disciples were really not so very different from Doubting Thomas. When they saw Jesus in their midst, they took some convincing that it really was Jesus and not a ghost that had come to visit them. The gospel outlines three pieces of proof that Jesus uses to convince them that he really has risen from the dead. He shows them the marks on his hands and feet, he invites them to touch and check that he is flesh and blood, and he shares a meal with them. But it is only when Jesus opens their minds to understanding the scriptures that they come to believe in him. By interpreting what has happened, the risen Christ draws the disciples out of their confusion. Amongst some of his famous last words to them, were words of encouragement to go and preach his message and a reminder of prophecies fulfilled and promises made.

Being a Christian today isn't easy, and simply accepting the Jesus we have grown up with sometimes isn't enough to sustain us. Perhaps we have given up believing and think that being a good person will be good enough. Understanding the difference between living life simply as a good person, and living life as a Christian comes of believing in the risen Jesus. As Christians we are continually striving to follow Christ's example. Today, through prayer, scripture debate, and putting faith into action, we continually work for the same enlightenment and understanding that Jesus gave his early disciples. To find that enlightenment we need to look to scripture as the disciples did. We need to look at the authors of the books within the Bible and understand who they were, something of the times they lived in, and who their audience was. There are commentaries to read and videos to watch, and of course, the Bible itself. We don't need to be great scholars. The original disciples weren't. All we need is the desire for enlightenment.







# Is it Jesus, or a Ghost?

I remember times when I was a youngster when I went on camping trips. One of the favourite activities on those trips was sitting around a campfire at night and telling ghost stories. Even though I kept telling myself, "There is no such thing as a ghost," that didn't keep some of those stories from scaring the daylights out of



me, and they often made it difficult for me to go to sleep that night.

Even in Bible times, some people believed in ghosts and were afraid of them. Today's Bible lesson is one example of that.

The story begins after two men had walked along a road to a place called Emmaus. They were discussing the crucifixion of Jesus and all of the events that had taken place in the past few days. They wondered what it all meant. As they walked, they were joined by a man on their walk. They did not recognize that the man was Jesus. There is much more to that part of the story, but it is enough for now that we know that Jesus revealed himself to them. Finally, they recognised that the man was Jesus. They were so excited to see that Jesus was alive that they jumped up and walked all the way back to Jerusalem.

The two men found Jesus' disciples and began telling them what they had seen. The Bible tells us that as they said these things, Jesus himself stood among them and said to them, "Peace be to you." Do you think the disciples felt peace? No! The Bible says that they were terrified and filled with fear, thinking that they had seen a ghost!

Once again Jesus spoke to his disciples. "Why are you troubled, and why do doubts arise in your hearts? Look at my hands. Look at my feet. You can see that it's really me. Touch me and make sure that I am not a ghost, because ghosts don't have bodies, as you see that I do."

Still the disciples stood in disbelief, so Jesus asked them, "Do you have anything here to eat?" They gave him a piece of fish, and he ate it as they watched. That was even further proof that they were not seeing a ghost. A ghost doesn't need food.

The disciples had seen Jesus die. They had seen him placed in a tomb. But now they saw Jesus alive. Not just this day, but for more than 40 days, they saw him and talked with him. They even watched him eat food. They were not seeing a ghost! Those same disciples went all over the world, telling the story of Jesus' crucifixion, his death, and his resurrection. They never stopped telling the story during their whole lives.



Our Father, we serve a risen Saviour. He is alive! Help us to be witnesses of what he has done in our lives. In Jesus' name we pray. Amen.

# LIVE SIMPLY. ... SHARE GENEROUSLY

Tommy Tiernan has inched ahead of Ryan Tubridy in the battle for RTÉ's weekend viewers after his most recent show clocked up 12,000 more audience members than the chat-show host. I really enjoy the show. Tommy is a remarkable listener, empathetic and his connection with people is most inspirational.


Fr. Peter McVerry SJ made quite an impact with his interview on The Tommy Tiernan Show on Saturday 10<sup>th</sup> April. In the course of a 15-minute conversation with the host, Peter described his relatively privileged upbringing, his attraction to the Priesthood, and his passion for a just social order, especially when it comes to the homeless and other people living on the margins. Although he received a good-quality private education, he said, his real education began in 1974 when he saw the appalling conditions of life in Dublin's inner city. It changed everything for him. He has dedicated his life since then to working for the homeless, living among them in a flat in Ballymun, Dublin. The lack of political will and the destructive neoliberal faith in the market to handle housing issues makes him deeply angry.

Specifically, Peter explained how his experience of poverty in Dublin led him to abandon the legalistic idea of God which he had held up to then. In a telling anecdote, he described how one young man in the inner city said to him, "The very thought that there might be a God depresses me". Peter understood this to mean that the man believed in a God of the law, a God who has laid down rules and laws that one had to live by. "And he had broken every one of them," Peter added with a laugh, so he imagined God looking down and seeing him as unlovable, as a bad person for breaking the rules. What Peter saw, however, was that the young man had suffered an abusive and violent childhood and extreme neglect. "If there is a God," he concluded, "this kid must have a special place in God's heart, because of what he has suffered." So gradually, Peter said, he came to reject the God of the law and to believe in a God of compassion.

In response to Tommy Tiernan's question about how ordinary people who have a reasonably comfortable existence, even if weighed down by mortgage payments and the like, should respond to the present situation, Fr. Peter commented that he was not looking for them to give away all their possessions but that they should try to live simply and share generously.

Tiernan opened the conversation saying "I have this feeling that you're one of the only people in public life that we can trust". Something of that same confidence in Peter's goodness and authority was evident from the social media response to the interview too. Michael O'Regan, a journalist with The Irish Times tweeted, "When will governments listen to Fr. Peter McVerry? Great interview with this great man who has dedicated his life to the marginalised." And Sean Kelly MEP remarked, "It was humbling and refreshing listening to the wonderful Fr. Peter McVerry".

"The thing about Peter McVerry is the fire never goes out. Never. Sometimes the rest of us feel the fire gone out and that's when we know we're struggling but with him never. Inspirational".


