# Over To Us

The disciples who for weeks had hidden away for fear of the Jews suddenly started behaving in an astonishing way. They came out of hiding and started teaching in many languages. What had got

into them? Quite simply, the Holy Spirit had got into them as Jesus had promised. Those previously terrified people were suddenly filled with courage, energy, inspiration, purpose and conviction.

What is truly exciting about the Pentecost story is that we too have been given that very same Spirit in our baptism. So if we have received the same Spirit as was breathed into those first disciples, why can't we rush round doing amazing things too? One answer might be that we haven't really tried yet. One answer might be that to date we haven't really been tested? Another answer perhaps is that we can't quite place our faith in it. How sad though if the Pentecost story is simply a story contained by the past. How sad if we don't believe the men and women of our own time whose inspirational lives and huge courage point to the work of the Holy Spirit ... men and women who far from being super human were born just the same as the rest of us.

The Holy Spirit is given to all of us, and with it comes the power to transform the world ... the first disciples knew it ... now it's our turn.

# **Happy Birthday Church**

The Feast of Pentecost is often referred to as the birthday of the Church? It's called that because Pentecost is when the apostles went out among the people and PENTECOST began spreading Jesus' message, thus establishing the beginning of



the Church. On this day we are asked to pray for the Church and her continued growth.

Pentecost, Greek for 50th day, is celebrated by Christians fifty days after Easter. Originally it was a Jewish feast that concluded the fifty days of Passover.

In Britain, Pentecost is also called Whitsun, because on this day new Christians used to be baptised. Often they wore white, so Pentecost was known as White Sunday. White Sunday was then shortened to Whitsun.

To celebrate Pentecost, read the Acts of the Apostles. Find out what happened to the Church following the events of Pentecost.





# **Laois Volunteers are Superheroes**

# Laois Volunteer Centre launched in Portlaoise during National Volunteering Week

Volunteers from a range of organisations in Laois gathered last week to help launch the new Laois Volunteer Centre. Award-winning volunteers were among those who gathered at Fitzmaurice Place in Portlaoise's Old Fort Quarter with Laois County Council Cathaoirleach Catherine Fitzgerald to help get the new service off the ground.



The launch of the independent service took place during National Volunteering Week, May 18-23. The Laois Volunteer Centre, fronted by Laois woman, Caitriona Ryan from Ballyfin, will help people who want to volunteer in their community to find suitable volunteer roles and will help local non-profit organisations to recruit volunteers. Ms Ryan was recently appointed as the new manager of Laois Volunteer Centre

and is looking forward to the Centre becoming a 'one-stop-shop' for volunteerism in Laois. Ms Ryan said that work to get the Centre, which has charitable status, fully operational has been delayed by Covid-19 restrictions but significant progress is now being made. She said a Laois Volunteer Centre office will open and additional staff are being recruited to place volunteers with local organisations. She added that the Centre will in time provide advice, training, and consultancy to local organisations on a range of issues relating to best practice in volunteer management and delivers a Garda Vetting service for local non-profits.

### The aims of Laois Volunteer Centre are:

- To promote the value of volunteering and civic responsibility and to increase the range and quality of volunteering.
- To increase access to volunteering by offering a support service to the public and volunteering involving organisations (VIOs).
- To carry on these charitable purposes for the benefit of the inhabitants of Co. Laois and its environs.

# A volunteer application portal and database for Laois known as 'I-Vol' has now been established and therefore provides the following services to organisations;

- Advertisement of organisations volunteering vacancies on Laois Volunteer Centre's database (I-Vol) of volunteering roles.
- 2. Free volunteer referral service.
- 3. Training to organisations on issues such as volunteer management.
- Consultancy and advice around policy issues and governance in relation to your volunteer programmes.
- Garda Vetting service for organisations.

The Laois centre is one of seven being set up this year, joining a network of 30 Volunteer Centres located across the country which fulfil a critical role in the community - promoting and enhancing volunteering and invigorating communities by building connections between volunteers and local organisations that involve volunteers across the county.

# The Power and Light

Do you know what day today is? Today is a very special day. This is Pentecost Sunday. It's the time when were remember that before Jesus returned to heaven, he promised that his Father would send a helper — the Holy Spirit — to live inside of those who follow him. He promised that the Holy Spirit would give them the power to do great and mighty things.



It happened just as Jesus said it would. On the day which is called Pentecost, the disciples were all together in one place. The Gospel tells us that there was a sound from heaven like a mighty rushing wind and it filled the place where the disciples were gathered. Then, there were flames of fire that appeared and rested upon each of them. When these things happened, the disciples were filled with power and began to preach and teach about Jesus. They were able to do things that they had never done before because of the power of the Holy Spirit in them.

If you imagine having a torch at home and using it, this will help us understand just how important the Holy Spirit is. A torch is not very large, but it sure puts out a bright light, doesn't it? If the electricity goes off and it is dark, a torch help me find my way around the house. They provide an emergency lighting system.

What do you think gives a torch the power to light up a room? Of course, the torch has a battery inside that gives it power. Without that power inside, the torch just doesn't work. That reminds me of the way the Holy Spirit works in our life. In his Sermon on the Mount, Jesus said, "Let your light shine before others, that they may see your good deeds and glorify your Father in heaven." Our Scripture today tells us that on the day of Pentecost people were filled with the Holy Spirit so that they could do mighty things as the Spirit

gave them the ability. It is the same power of the Holy Spirit that enables you and me to let our light shine in the world. Just as a torch must have batteries to give it power, the Holy Spirit is our source of power to live for Jesus.

# A Prayer for Students during this Pandemic

As we move through the month of May thousands of 'Holy Spirit, send your power, help me to remember all students prepare for exams. Young people have been that I have learnt, inspire me with the gift of Knowledge' particularly affected by this pandemic. Third level students Amen! have been engaged on line for over a year. Think of the social isolation and emotional consequences they have gone through. Online learning for secondary students has also been extremely challenging. Exam-time brings with it many mixed emotions and feelings. Soon Leaving Certificate and Third Level exams take place. Exams can be stressful occasions when young people can feel pressure and anxiety. The Leaving Certificate is an important milestone in the lives of our young people, the vast majority sits this state exam, which in many ways itself, is a rite of passage, into a more adult and responsible life. Perhaps a positive despite the pandemic is that the Department of Education has had to reflect on how best to assess students' academic performance. This is a time of great opportunity for the Class of 2021. There are many pathways that can bring us to our chosen college places. There are many noble careers where vocational training is another option. For all students, you cannot be defined by the number of points you will receive. Gifts and talents, character and personality will never be simply measured by a points system. These days candle shrines burn brightly in many of our churches, representing the prayers offered by parents and students at this time.

St Paul once said:

"With God on our side who can be against us?"

Essentially being open to the love of God in all our lives is surely a great gift. The life that this young generation now enter more fully is a vibrant one, full of energy and yet very challenging. I don't think it is easy to be a young person in the present culture we find ourselves in. All of these young students will now experience the competitive environment that is the point's race, finding the right college course and career path in a volatile global economy where so often only the fittest and leanest survive. The 'burden of youth' at times can be tragic, manifesting in addiction, anxiety and mental health issues. However, the enthusiasm, resilience and sense of hopeful optimism that is so real for young people, will carry them through the difficult weeks ahead.

I believe faith in the living God is a great source of strength and love for our young friends. Yes, there will always be difficulty and disappointment in life, but faith gives us a confidence and inner peace, that allows us all to live life to the full. God invites us to manifest our hopes and dreams into the realities of our day to day lives. Faith is grounded, in the knowledge that our God abundantly loves us for who we are, not for who we may like to present ourselves as. Faith allows us to hope even in the face of adversity and human struggle.

Essentially faith informs us that we are not alone. Our God resides in depth of our human experience, even in the stress of getting ready for the Leaving Certificate or Third Level exams. # Consider It Cakes!

'Consider It Cakes' is looking to brighten up residents' days with a simple but generous gesture; baked goods. The Laois branch was just set up and are now looking for volunteers.

# Background

Since the project was set up last summer, over 500 cakes and other baked goods for various occasions have been delivered to people living in direct provision with over 300 people currently volunteering to bake and deliver cakes to centres across the country. As well as giving people a boost with a special delivery, organisers also hope it will let residents know there are people in the wider community who care for them - especially amid the COVID-19 pandemic. The reactions are priceless and since we started this initiative it has brought so much joy into our lives because we feel like we can really make a change.

### How it works

- 1) Anyone who is homeless, asylum-seeking or simply cannot afford a cake because of their current situation is eligible to request a cake (whatever the occasion) for a child, partner or friend. All flavours of cakes are available, and people can choose a theme/favourite toppings etc. which they otherwise might not be able to afford.
- 2) The order is then passed on to a volunteer simply someone who likes to bake.
- 3) That volunteer then sets aside some of their free time to make and deliver the cake. Children also get a little wrapped present for their birthday, such as a stuffed animal or a book. We also like to celebrate events with special "treat days", for example, Christmas, World Mental Health Day, International Women's Day and so on.
