Pope Francis kissed the tattoo of an Auschwitz survivor during an emotional meeting at the Vatican this week. Lidia Maksymowicz, a Polish citizen who was deported to Auschwitz from her native Belarus before the age of three, showed the pope the number tattooed on her arm by the Nazis, and Francis leaned over and kissed it.

Maksymowicz, 81, says she did not exchange words with the pope. "We understood each other with a glance," she said.

Pass It On

We read an inspirational book or see a great film. We visit a new restaurant or discover a new fitness regime. We are eager to share our findings with friends and family. We land a new job, or embark on a new course. Our children start new schools and pass exams. Immediately we are texting our loved ones. In every walk of life we are keen to share our experiences until it comes to religion. There's something politically incorrect about sharing our religious experiences. Perhaps we are afraid of being labelled 'Bible Bashers'. Far better to live and let live we decide. In any case, who's to say it's us that have got things right and everyone else that is misguided. Could it be that the idea of evangelisation is out of fashion? After all, at one time people were prepared to die for their faith. Nowadays Christians face no greater commitment than how best to juggle Mass with Sunday morning football. A lot has changed. Should religion be a very private and personal affair? Who wants to go around notching up conversions like a politician on the run up to an election? We live in a world where information is at everyone's finger tips; surely it's up to the individual to acquaint themselves with Jesus. Finally, the biggest stumbling block of all. How do we go about evangelising if we ourselves have doubts?

The fact remains that Jesus has left us with a great commission. "To go and make disciples of all nations, baptising them in the name of the Father and of the Son and of the Holy Spirit." It is equally clear that the commission didn't start and finish with those early disciples. It has to be the job of us all.

Perhaps Jesus knew from the outset what our objections would be. We are reminded that even amongst the first disciples there were those who suffered doubts. Perhaps they struggled with what to believe. Perhaps they doubted in themselves and their ability to carry out the great commission. But whatever our doubts, and however much times have changed, two things remain constant. God's love and God's presence. "Remember," Jesus tells us, "I am with you always to the end of the age."

We can take on the great commission at any time.... the sooner the better. The biggest piece of advice we are given today is to "Go!" We are not invited to sit round theorising. There is no need to ponder or agonise. We are invited to get on with the job. We don't need to be hugely clever or to have any special gifts. It doesn't matter that we might harbour doubts. It doesn't matter about our views on political correctness. All we need to do is pass on Jesus' special brand of selfless love and keep passing it on until it has reached all nations in the name the Father who made us, the Son who taught us and the Holy Spirit that enables us.





WHAT IS PEACE OF MIND?

Peace of mind, is a feeling of being safe or protected, it is the absence of worry. It's achieving a calm state of mind regardless of your situation and circumstances. The most important step to achieving peace is to acknowledge the fact that you have control over your mind, including your thoughts and how you respond to others. If you refuse to take responsibility for your reactions to others then you will never live in peace. However, when you accept that you are in control of how you respond to people and situations you can begin to make progress in this area instead of living controlled by things that are happening around you.

1. Nourish your Spirituality

A nourished spirituality allows you to push out the worrying and nagging thoughts that creep into your mind. It helps you to take control of anxiety and stress. This allows you to experience peace even if things in life aren't perfect, and the physical benefits are

2. Limit your use of Social Media

There are things that are good about social media, but there are also lots of studies that show the ways that it can be harmful to the mental health of its users. The use of social media tends to cause us to compare the good, the bad, and the ugly of our lives with the highlight reel that friends and family are sharing. The messy parts of your life are never going to compare with the highlights that other people are sharing. Therefore, if you are struggling with peace and constantly find yourself comparing yourself to others on social media it can be best to stay off the platforms. Social media is also a distraction. It feeds our FOMO (fear of missing out) craving. With access to social media on our phones, it's easy to be tempted into stopping what you are trying to work on or think about in order to "check" what's going on with friends and family.

3. Let go of the Past

Getting hung up on the things that have happened in the past make it difficult to stay focused on the present and the future. Focusing our attention on things that we cannot change makes it difficult to maintain peace of mind. If there is something from the past that you can correct, then do it. Otherwise, it's time to forgive others, forgive yourself, and move on.

4. Don't be easily offended

It is much easier to maintain peace of mind when you let things roll off your back. If you take offense at every little thing that other people do and say, you will remain in a constant state of frustration. Your thoughts will feel out of control and you will quickly lose your peace. However, if you focus on believing the best in others you are shifting your thoughts which will make finding peace much easier.

5. Choose your battles carefully

If you make it your personal mission to correct everyone who is doing something you don't agree with you are going to live in a constant state of strife. And it will be near impossible to keep your mind focused on what you want to focus on. Just like parents are taught to choose their battles with their children, you want to do the same thing with the people and situations you face daily. For example, you might not agree with a conversation that is happening between your co-worker and your boss, but if you are not part of the conversation it's best to stay out of it. 7. Incorporate times of Silence and Solitude into your Schedule

Constantly being in the hustle and bustle of life is a sure-fire way to lose peace of mind and focus. This doesn't mean that you should avoid people at all costs, however, taking time to get away from everyone else and be in total silence can help you to reconnect with yourself. If you find that you have lost all peace, you might need to take a solitude retreat. You could get away for a weekend alone or simply an afternoon. Find a quiet place to retreat to. Allow yourself to think about the thoughts that have been rolling around in your head. Then, decide how to deal with those thoughts. Allow yourself to recharge during this time. 

I'm Praying for You



Today, many churches celebrate a special day called Pentecost. It was on the day of Pentecost that God sent his Holy Spirit to the church. The Bible tells us that the apostles were all gathered together in one place when suddenly there was a sound like a mighty, rushing wind. They saw what looked like tongues of fire that came to rest on each of them and all of them were filled with the Holy Spirit.

CLONKEEN CHURCH AND GRAVEYARD

Calling on the people from Abbeyleix and the Ballinakill area, or indeed any other interested people to come together as a community and try and save a Medieval Church and graveyard from deteriorating further and possibly collapsing altogether.

Clonkeen Church and graveyard in the parish of Abbeyleix is possibly one of the only graveyards in the Country that does not have a committee in place to look after its best interests. This Church is steeped in history, founded in the year 600AD and re-founded again in the 1400s. Search for Abbeyleix Clonkeen on You-Tube for its history recently posted. We have an Archaeological report on the proposed conservation project, Catherine Casey Heritage Officer from Laois County Council visited the site on the 18/05/2021. Her observations of the Church are in line with the Archaeologist in that it's critically important that work needs



to commence A.S.A.P. before a storm or a heavy fall of would undoubtedly collapse the walls of the Church. Both gable ends of the Church are top heavy with ivy growing along side them threatening their stability. The people in the parish of Abbeyleix, and the Ballinakill area cannot allow this to happen. The past needs to be preserved for the future.


