A Sign of Our Times

A 'bag lady' gets on the bus ranting and swaying. We spread ourselves out on the seat hoping against hope that she chooses to sit somewhere



else. An old man stumbles in the high street and doesn't get up again. We suspect he's had too much to drink and hurry on. Perhaps someone else better qualified will lend a helping hand. We respond with fear and discrimination. It's a good job that although many of us choose to close our eyes and ears, there are equally as many people who want to help. We only have to look at the number of aid agencies, charity campaigns and caring individuals to see signs of Jesus in our midst.

This is the significance of today's gospel story. What at first seems to be a straightforward account of the healing of a deaf man turns out to be much more. The story points to the miracle as a sign that Jesus was the Messiah the Jews had been expecting. It was prophesied that the ears of the deaf would be unsealed and that the tongues of the dumb would sing for joy. The curing of the deaf man was exactly the sort of miracle the Jews would have been expecting of the awaited Messiah. What seems like a straightforward account of a miracle takes us a step further. The deaf man happened to be a Gentile. In biblical times, orthodox Jews would have considered a Gentile unclean. By choosing a Gentile as the subject of his miracle, Jesus is telling us that there is no discrimination when it comes to God's salvation.

Today we ask God to help us see and hear the needs of others. There has never been a better time to show the world that Jesus is at the heart of our teaching. The migrant crisis that is on our news on a daily basis, shows some countries acting with empathy and others with inflammatory language and high barbed fences. We are reacting with the fear and discrimination that Jesus fought against. We cannot turn a deaf ear or a blind eye; we have to act like Christians in the way we speak, in the way we give, in the way we campaign and in our prayers.

Nativity of the Blessed Virgin Mary 8th September

The Church has celebrated Mary's birth since at least the sixth century. A September birth was chosen because the Eastern Church begins its Church year with



September. The September 8 date helped determine the date for the feast of the Immaculate Conception on December 8 (nine months earlier). Scripture does not give an account of Mary's birth....the apocryphal Protoevangelium of James fills in the gap. This work has no historical value, but it does reflect the development of Christian piety. According to this account, Anna and Joachim are infertile but pray for a child. They receive the promise of a child that will advance God's plan of salvation for the world. Such a story (like many biblical counterparts) stresses the special presence of God in Mary's life from the beginning.





JESUS HEALS A DEAF MAN

Can you imagine what it would be like to be deaf? Just imagine all of the things you would miss. You wouldn't be able to hear the voices of your mother, your father, your brothers and sisters, your friends, the barking of a dog or the meowing of a kitten. You might be able to feel the vibrations, but you wouldn't be able to hear the sound of music.

Many people who are deaf or hearing impaired are able to communicate with others through the use of sign language, but it is not perfect

because everyone you meet does not know sign language. The deaf can enjoy going to the movies if they have subtitles or watch television if it has captions, but those are not perfect. If a person is not totally deaf, hearing aids can help, but they aren't perfect either. I guess the best solution for a deaf person would be a total cure for deafness. That is what Jesus did for a deaf man in our Gospel today.

One day, Jesus was in an area of the Sea of Galilee called the Decapolis. (That means Ten Towns.) A man who was deaf and could hardly talk was brought to Jesus by some of his friends. They begged Jesus to lay his hands on the man and heal him.

Jesus led the man away from the crowd so they could be alone. He put his fingers into the man's ears. Then he spit on his own fingers and touched the man's tongue. He looked up to heaven and said, "Ephphatha," which means, "Be Opened!" What do you think happened? Immediately, the man could hear perfectly, and he could speak plainly!

The people who had brought the man to Jesus were totally amazed. They said, "Everything he does is wonderful. He even makes the deaf to hear and gives speech to those who cannot speak." Then Jesus did something unusual, he told the people not to tell anyone what they had seen him do. Do you think they followed Jesus' instructions? No! They told everyone about this man who did everything well.

These friends cared for the man so much that they wanted him to see Jesus. We, too, can help our friends to know Jesus.



THE CENTENARY OF THE LEGION OF MARY


One hundred years ago, on the 7th of September 1921, at a meeting in Myra House, Francis Street in Dublin, Frank Duff founded the Legion of Mary. Frank Duff guided the worldwide extension of the Legion with heroic dedication and the Legion is now one of the largest lay-catholic organisations in the world. It is in every continent in over 170 countries and has over 3 million active members. The Legion looks to Our Blessed mother Mary and seeks to serve her in this world of ours which is much in need of our Blessed Mothers help and guidance. Each week in parishes all over the world, small groups of likeminded people come together to pray and to do apostolic work for Our Lady. The prayer includes the Rosary and also the Magnificat, that great prayer spoken by Our Lady when she was pregnant with baby Jesus and had gone to visit her cousin Elizabeth.

One of the works of the Legion of Mary is to visit people in their own homes to encourage people to have devotion to Our Lady, to pray the Rosary and to go to Mass and confession. Another important work of the Legion is to visit people who live in nursing homes and also people who are lonely or isolated in their own homes. Many people will recall the Legion visiting their home and distributing the Miraculous Medal. Now, in Covid times, is a good time to take out that Miraculous medal that challenges us to look at life again and accept the protection and encouragement offered by the Mother of God. Each day pray the prayer that is on the medal – "O Mary conceived without sin prayer for us who have recourse to thee".

The spirit of the Legion of Mary is that of Mary herself. Legionaries are called to serve under the guidance of and in total dependence on Mother Mary. In all whom they serve they are to see the person of Jesus Christ himself. "Truly I tell you, just as you did it to one of the least of these who are members of my family, you did it to me" (MT 25:40). The legion is open to all practising Catholics and is a beautiful way to thank Jesus and his mother for all they have done for us. As one legionary put it — "The Legion has changed my life. It has helped me to live my faith and to put God first in my life. It has helped me to enjoy life, it has given me purpose in life."

Ordinary Irish people have always honoured Mary. It is in our genes, our DNA. Look at Ireland today, we need Gods help. Many of our own families have drifted from the Church and from the Sacraments.

In former times St Patrick brought the faith to Ireland but now it is our turn. Pope Francis has spoken many times on the role of each person in evangelisation. Each one of us can make a difference. We have an opportunity in the Legion of Mary to share our faith through the work of the Legion. The Legion reaches out to individuals on a one to one bases and aims to



spread the Gospel by example.

The Legion encourages people to open the door to Jesus and our Lady does the rest. Mother Mary continues to bring Christ to people just like she brought Christ into this world at Bethlehem.

The Cause for Beatification has been introduced for three legionaries: The Servant of God, Frank Duff (1889-1980), Founder of the Legion, who attended the Second Vatican Council as a Lay Observer; Venerable Edel Quinn (1907-1944), Legion Envoy to East Africa; and the Servant of God, Alfie Lambe (1932-1959), Legion Envoy to South America.

You inspired your servant Frank Duff with a profound insight into the mystery of your Church, the Body of Christ, and of the place of Mary the Mother of Jesus in this mystery. In his immense desire to share this insight with others and in filial dependence on Mary he formed her Legion to be a sign of her maternal love for the world and a means of enlisting all her children in the Church's evangelizing work. We thank you Father for the graces conferred on him and for the benefits accruing to the Church from his courageous and shining faith. With confidence we beg you that through his intercession you grant the petition we lay before you. We ask too that if it be in accordance with your will, the holiness of his life may be acknowledged by the Church for the glory of your Name, through Christ Our Lord, Amen.
