#### THE Wreath

Today we light the first of our Advent candles. The traditional use of

Advent candles originated in eastern Germany prior to the Reformation. There are three purple candles and one pink candle. Purple for the royalty of the coming **King** .... the pink candle is the third candle to be lit on what is call **Gaudate Sunday** and represents 'joy'. The gradual lighting of the four candles symbolises the coming **Light** into the world. The wreath itself is also symbolic. The circle of evergreen in which the candles are placed represent everlasting life.

#### **ABOUT ADVENT**

The word Advent means "coming" or "arrival." The focus of the season is the celebration of the birth of Jesus the Christ in his First Advent, and the anticipation of the return of Christ the King in his Second Advent. Advent is far more than simply marking a 2,000 year old event in history. It is celebrating a truth about God, the revelation of God in Christ whereby all of creation might be reconciled to God.

#### Saint Andrew the Apostle November 30th

According to tradition, a part of the remains of St. Andrew were taken to Scotland, and he was chosen as the Protector of the Scotlish people. The Cross of St. Andrew also adorns the British flag where it was placed after the union of Scotland and England.









#### Jesus is coming again!



#### TIME TO THINK!

#### ADVENT - A COUNTER-CULTURAL SEASON

Christmas seems to arrive now by the start of November and ends on Christmas day. In a secular culture the season of Advent, a time of waiting is certainly countercultural. This week we begin Advent. This is the period when we prepare to celebrate the coming of the Christ among us two millennia ago, but we also believe that He is coming among us now and so we have to be prepared to receive him, and we know that he will come again at the end of time and we have to prepare the world for his coming. Advent is a hope-filled few weeks, when we prepare to welcome, yet again, the light and peace that is felt at the Lords birth. Jesus is the reason for the season. One of the images that Pope Francis often uses is that of the door. He is calling on us to keep the doors of the Church open. He means that literally; closed doors invite no one in. He is using the image of the door also as a symbol, the Church doors must be open in welcome. The Church must be welcoming especially to those who living in anxiety and hopelessness, to those who are seeking the answers to what life is about. If we dig down a little deeper the Pope is also asking us questions about why so many young people do not find the Church a welcoming Church, while we possess one of the great secrets about the meaning of life which young people are seeking: the message of Jesus Christ and how he reveals that our God is a God of love.

And he takes the image of the Church door one step further. The Church doors must be open so that we go out through them into the world around us to live and witness to the love of God, especially to those who are on the margins of Church life and those who are trapped in the margins of society. There is no point in having our church doors open if we remain happily inside as a closed comfort zone for ourselves and the like-minded. There is no point in creating a Church which is locked within itself and within its own history. The Advent message is that the Christian life is always a future-looking one. The Advent wreath is an image of the Church. Week by week we light another candle as our lives move forward step by step in expectation. Our mission as Christians in the world is, as we look forward to Christ's coming, to anticipate that fullness of Christ's teaching through the way we live as individuals and as society, and to ensure that our world does not deviate from God's design for his creation.

How does the message of Advent help us focus better on the fundamental thrust we should be giving to our lives? How does Advent help us to witness in our society to what Christ's coming means? Advent, is a period of waiting, of longing, of anticipation and preparation and of rejoicing that "the Lord is coming", that "the Lord is near"; it encourages us to look to the future as a future of hope and there is no doubt that we need hope today, as individuals, as families, as communities and indeed as a nation. We should learn to think like the Old Testament prophets as they looked forward to the coming of the Saviour. They were sensitive to the experience of injustice and sin under which they lived and looked forward in hope to the coming of "the anointed one", as one who's coming will bring the newness of peace, justice and righteousness. It was such a hope that enabled the Prophet Isaiah to dream the dream, with those beautiful words: "One nation shall not raise the sword against another, nor shall they train for war again. They shall beat their swords into ploughshares and their spears into pruning hooks".



Advent reminds us that it is possible to change our world, starting out from where we are concretely within all the ambiguities and compromises of life, and move towards the realisation of the ideal of truth, justice and love. The Christian of every generation is called particularly to be awake and attentive to where society is slipping into wrong ways and to cry out like the prophet to return to the ways of God. In our days, sadly, nations still raise weaponry against others. How often do we read about knives being raised in violence and guns in vengeance and lives - young lives being ruined? I am horrified to see in our world of progress and enlightenment that men and women and children are driven in their hundreds of thousands from their homes through wars as in Syria. Like you, I am greatly worried by the rising tide of xenophobia and racism in our country. Christians in our society must find the ways to speak up and stand up as witnesses to the God of peace and loving care. A God whose very birth took place on the periphery as there was no room for him in the Inn.

Advent then is a moment in which we should interrupt our daily lives and think about what is essential. All too often, we live preoccupied by the hecticness of our daily lives, asleep to the wider consequences of our way of life. Following Jesus Christ is a calling to a robust engagement with the challenges of our society. The Christian life is never self-focussed but focussed on self-giving as Jesus gave his life to save us. Christians must learn the ability not just to adapt to the realities of the day but to challenge the realities and the thought-patterns of the day. The Christian must be one who stands out and has the courage to rise above conformity, even when that is not easy. Advent is not strictly a time of penance and fasting as is Lent. It is marked more rather by a growing sense of joyfulness for the fact that Jesus is coming and that His coming is near. We pray that when He comes He will find us not closed in the comfortable and the familiar, but out there doing God's work and confidently bringing His message of love and hope into the world around us.

As we celebrate this season of Advent, may we grow in hopefulness and gratitude.

May the light of Christ, brighter than this winter darkness inspire us to act with kindness and compassion.

#### The Prayer of Advent: Come, Lord Jesus

The traditional prayer of Advent 'Come, Lord Jesus' brings us straight to the heart of what this season is about. The word 'Advent' stems from the Latin 'Adventus,' meaning 'coming' or 'arrival'. It speaks to our yearning for the presence of Jesus in our lives and to a deep down recognition for the need of this presence above all things.

At the beginning of a new Church year, over the Four Sundays of the Advent season we ready ourselves for the joy of Christmas when we remember and commemorate the birth of Christ. But Advent is also about preparing ourselves for His second coming. We are reminded of this second coming in many phrases that we hear or say at Mass, for example 'as we look forward to his second coming', 'when he comes again in glory', 'as we await the blessed hope and the coming of our Saviour'. This second coming is a central theme from the beginning of Advent right up to the 17<sup>th</sup> December. At that point, our attention and preparation shifts more to the commemoration of His first coming on the feast of the Nativity.

And yet as we prepare to remember his coming at Christmas and to anticipate his Second Coming, we also recognise that the risen Christ is always coming to us. In these Advent days, Jesus, 'God with us', the Lord who is HOPE, PEACE, JOY & LOVE, reaches out to us and walks with us. As we journey through these days are we ready to welcome him again and again into our life? Are we ready to pray *Maranatha! Come*, *Lord Jesus!* 

POPE FRANCIS - "Advent is a continuous call to hope. It reminds us that God is present in history to lead it to its ultimate goal and to its fullness, which is the Lord Jesus Christ. God is present in the history of humanity, He is the 'Godwith-us', He walks beside us to support us.'

#### A Suggestion for the Home

Why not create a prayer space in your home for Advent? You might like to make your own **Advent wreath** or have a special Advent candle to use in the prayer space, including perhaps purple coloured cloth/ribbons and evergreens. You'll find a short video on creating an Advent prayer space on kandle.ie.

#### An Advent Tradition for Church and Home:



#### THE ADVENT WREATH

The advent wreath has a rich meaning. The circle of the wreath, with no beginning or end, symbolises the eternity of God. The evergreen reminds us of the everlasting life we have in Christ while any pine cones or pods in the wreath represent new life and resurrection.

The four candles represent the four Sundays of Advent. Purple is traditionally a colour of penance and prayer while the rose pink candle that is lit on the Third Sunday (Gaudete/Rejoice Sunday) marks our joy as we move ever closer to Christmas.

As you light a candle on your Advent wreath for the first time, pray this prayer of blessing and take a moment to talk to God about how you will journey through Advent this year, alone or as a household. Finish your time of prayer with the Advent prayer: Come, Lord Jesus!

#### A Blessing Prayer

Loving God,

let your blessing come upon us as we light this wreath.

May it be a sign of hope for us as we prepare for your coming and may it turn our hearts to you in the days ahead.

Give us your peace and love as we wait in joyful hope.

We ask this through Christ our Lord.
Amen. Come, Lord Jesus!

So let us enter Advent in hope, even hope against hope. Let us see visions of love and peace and justice. Let us affirm with humility, with joy, with faith, with courage: Jesus Christ -- the Life of the world. [Daniel Berrigan SJ]


