


Confining War to the Dusty History Books

Love your enemies and do good to those who hate you? Surely that's a recipe for becoming a doormat, yet this is what Jesus is asking us to do in today's gospel. The six o'clock news fuels our anger. We want to fight back at the aggressors. We want to hit



back at the terrorists who hurt us. We want to see consequences for those who kill or maim or take away from us. Jesus' advice doesn't make any sense. How can we love those we don't even like! How can we forgive when punishment feels more human? But in the words of Martin Luther King Jr "When you live by the rule 'an eye for an eye and a tooth for a tooth, you end up with a nation of blind and toothless people".

These are tremendous words, because they tell us that when we respond to those who hate us with love instead of recrimination, we defeat evil. So how do we make it work? Firstly we have to know that love isn't a warm fuzzy emotion that leaps out of a Valentine's card. Love is a decision. Love is not a feeling it's a choice. We have to make decision to do good and then do it. We know we are loved by the way we are treated, and in the same way we have to show others that we love them by the way we treat them. Next come the rules. Do not judge and you will not be judged. Do not condemn and you will not be condemned. Give and it will be given to you. In short we have to treat everyone the way we would like to be treated ourselves whether we like them or not. If everyone could live their lives by Jesus' teaching conflict and war would be confined to dusty history books.








Time to Think!

... The Starfish ...

In the Bible, the Virgin Mary was named Sella Maris, which means star of the sea. The Virgin Mary is a symbol of guidance and protection for people in difficulty such as sailors who sought her for their safe journeys. The star and the starfish are considered important celestial symbols in the bible representing infinite divine love. The following spiritual story, invites us to be hopeful and enthusiastic, important attributes in all our lives.

Once upon a time, a long, long time ago, an elderly man was taking a walk along the beach. He was relaxed and content. The sun shone brightly in the sky, the birds wheeled and sang, the waves washed ashore, the sand was firm underfoot, and a gentle breeze tempered the heat. Some distance in front of him, the man saw the figure of a young man who was behaving strangely. He bent down from time to time, went over to the sea, bent down, and then back to the strand again as he walked along. 'What's he doing?' thought the old man, 'Maybe he's just happy, celebrating life with this strange dance of his. I'll ask him'.

A few moments later they met and greeted each other, 'Good morning'. 'A beautiful day'. 'Isn't it lovely by the sea?' And so on. Then the elderly man said, 'As I was walking along I saw you bending down, and then going over to the sea and back again. Do you mind if I ask what you were doing? 'Not at all', replied the young man. 'Do you see all those starfish that have been washed up on the shore? The whole length of beach is lined with them. They're exposed to the wind and sun, and they're drying up. A drying starfish is a dying starfish, so I'm putting as many of them as I can back into the water. Those that survive will produce the next generation of starfish, and life will go on'. 'How many have you put back in? asked the old man. The young man replied, 'I don't know; maybe fifty or sixty'. 'So what's the point?' said the old man. That's such a tiny number among the thousands that line the shore. What difference does it make?' The young man didn't reply. He bent down, picked up a starfish, and carried it back to the water. Almost immediately, it took on a healthy, natural appearance as if happy to be back in its own environment. 'It made a difference to that one', he said.

The old man said nothing, but quietly thanked the young man, and began his journey home. As he walked along he thought to himself, 'I've learned something good today. You can't do everything, but you can do something.



It's better to do something, even if it's only a small thing, than to do nothing because of being unable to do everything. No one can do everything, but everyone can do something'. He continued on his way. Then he stopped, bent down, picked up a starfish, and put it in the water. A few steps later, he did the same again, thinking, 'If one person does a small thing, it remains a small thing. If many people do a small thing, it becomes a big thing. Today has been a good day'.

For those in a hurry: '

Those who are faithful in small things, will be faithful also in big things'. (Jesus, in Luke 16.10)




