#### The Master's Voice

How often do we hear the phrase, "We believe what we want to believe." It's equally true that we refuse to believe what we don't want to believe. In today's reading the Jews are pushing Jesus to state his case. "If you are the Messiah tell us plainly." Jesus replies, "You do not believe, because you do not belong to my sheep." In other words, the questioners are not his followers, they are hostile towards him and therefore they are not open to believing in him even though they have seen the evidence. In some ways Christianity is a chicken and egg kind of scenario. We need to be followers of Jesus, to believe in him, but we need to believe to be followers. Which comes first is up to us, but we have to be open to hearing and recognising Jesus in our twenty first century world.

Hearing, recognising, believing and responding is what 'Good Shepherd Sunday' is all about. Some situations have got 'God' written all over them and some haven't. How do we tell the difference? What are we called to do? How are we called to believe? Some things are obvious, some things aren't. But at the heart of everything, even issues that didn't exist in Jesus' day such as euthanasia, and stem cell research, Jesus' teachings are like 'cat's-eyes' on life's dark country roads. We have to recognise Jesus' voice in everything by asking, how much of today's decisions are based in love, and how much of our decisions are based in our own human agendas.

#### **Taking Care of the Sheep**

Do you know what a shepherd is? Of course you do. A shepherd is one who takes care of sheep. A shepherd uses a shepherd's crook. The crook is very useful to the shepherd in taking care of the sheep. If the sheep tries to go in the wrong direction, the shepherd can reach out with the crook and gently pull it back onto the right path. The shepherd also uses the crook to help protect the sheep from a wolf or some other wild animal that might try to harm them. You see, it is the shepherd's responsibility to care for and protect the sheep.

How many of you know who the priests of the parish are? Go and look at page 2 on this Link up and you will see their photos. Do you know who our bishop is? Yes, Bishop Denis Nulty. Did you know that the word we use for the one who leads our church means the same thing as the word that is used for someone who takes care of sheep? So if Bishop Denis and the priests of the parish are the ones who take care of the sheep, what do you think that makes us? Right! We are the sheep! It is the Bishop Denis and the priest's job to take care of us just as it is the job of a shepherd to care for the sheep.

The priests here in our parish don't use a shepherd's crook. The Bible is the priest's crook. When we stray away and go off on the wrong path, the priests use the teaching of God's Word to reach out and gently pull us back and get us going in the right direction. The priests in our parish also use the Bible to protect us from our enemies. When Satan attacks us and tries to get us to do things that would harm us, the priests use the Bible to teach us what God wants us to do.

Bishop Denis and the priests of the parish have a good guide to follow in knowing how to take care of the sheep. That guide is Jesus. Listen to what Jesus said about himself, "I am the good shepherd. I know my sheep and my sheep know me - just as the Father knows me and I know the Father. I lay down my life for the sheep."

The Bible also says, "The LORD is my shepherd," but God has also called the priests of our parish to help him in caring for his sheep. We are thankful for Jesus, "the Good Shepherd," and we are thankful for Bishop Denis and the priests of the parish too!

My sheep listen to my voice; I know them, and they follow me.



Jesus said that he knows his sheep; they follow him and listen to his voice. They will live for ever and no one will snatch them away, because they are in the care of their Father—God. When you give your heart to Jesus and place you life in His hands, you have His promise that you are safe.



## Time to Think! Let Go.....Let God

It's good to think of prayer, not just as saying prayers, or speaking to God, but as listening to God; not just as words but as silence; not just the head but the heart; not just what we do but what God does in us – if we get out of his way and give him the chance. To listen to God in silence with the heart is an excellent form of prayer. What God asks of us is that we be silent and receptive. Just stay quiet, stop talking and listen. The noise outside us is the easiest to silence; the noise within is the difficult one. What God wants of us, more than anything else in prayer is our love. The best kind of prayer is that in which there is most love.

I believe there are many people whom God calls to contemplative prayer but who never make that step because they lock themselves into a fixed pattern of set prayers. By set prayers I mean those we have learned by heart or which have become part of a fixed daily pattern. That kind of prayer is a bit like a crutch. Sometimes we need it, and then it's a help. Sometimes we don't, and then it's a hindrance. We need to know when to let go of it and when to take it up again.

Being tied to set prayers can be an obstacle to prayer. It can block it. We need to have the trust in ourselves to have the courage to take the step of letting those prayers go and reaching out for prayer in another form - stillness and silence, in which we give God a space in our lives. God wants to lead us forward, he wants to do things for us, he wants to grow in us, but we usually block him because we are tied to our own agenda, our way of doing or seeing things, or habits which we do not want to change. What we are called to do in such situations is to be prepared to let go of our own ways, however familiar or comforting they may have become, to let go and let God come in and give us direction, so that we go where God is leading us and we allow him to set the pace for us. And God's ways are always those of freedom and gentleness. The signs of his presence are joy and peace.

#### The blessedness of little things:

Oh it is the little things. It is the gestures. The smile. The word. The call. The thank you. The hello. The - is there anything I can do? The appreciation. The praise. The touch. The patience of everyone.

I abandon myself into your hands; do with me what you will.


