Does Prayer Work?

Have you ever prayed really really hard for something and not had that prayer granted? Have you ever looked back in life at a prayer you once made and thought thank goodness God didn't grant it? This week's gospel reading is a lesson in prayer, but more importantly, it's a



lesson in having faith that God is a parent who will not let us down.

Let's face it, we pray hardest to God when we want something. We pray hardest when something seems beyond our human means and we need some kind of miracle, this often leads us to make inappropriate prayers. How many of us pray that the love of our life will notice us in the launderette? How many of us pray to win the lottery and make secret deals with God that we will donate half the winning to charity in return? How many of us pray to God for our football team to score a winning goal in the closing minutes of a match? Worse... we lose faith when such prayers aren't answered! We find it difficult to believe that unanswered prayers might mean that God knows better, or has a different purpose for us.

Perhaps Jesus' disciples shared some of our frustration when they say, "Lord teach us to pray." In response Jesus gives us a model by which to pray. It's important to recognise it as a model and not a prayer as such. Reciting a prayer is not the same as praying. The model prayer Jesus gives us, 'The Lord's prayer', invites us to pray to God as our Father, acknowledging his holiness and praying with the shared commitment to have his will done on earth. We are invited to pray for our 'daily bread', in other words, for the things we genuinely need. Pray for forgiveness, and promise to forgive others. Pray with persistence. Payer is about building a relationship with God, speaking to him often throughout the day. Lastly, and most importantly we should approach God with the faith we approach a loving parent. "What father," reasons Jesus, "would hand his son a snake when he asks for a fish?" or hand him a scorpion when he asks for an egg?" Even parents with very average parenting skills know how to give children what they need. "How much more," says Jesus, "will the Father in heaven give the Holy Spirit to those who ask him?"

TEACH US TO PRAY

I'm sure you've heard of a "Knock, Knock" joke. I have some to tell you today. Are you ready?

Knock, knock. (Who's there?) Tank. (Tank who?) You're welcome! Knock, knock.
(Who's there?)
Canoe.
(Canoe who?)
Canoe come out and play?

Knock, Knock.
(Who's there?)
Orange.
(Orange Who?)
Orange you glad this is my last knock, knock joke?

The Gospel tells us about a time Jesus was talking about knock, knock, knocking. One day, Jesus was teaching His friends, the disciples, how to pray. He said, "Let's say you went to a friend's house late at night..." "You said to your friend, 'I need to borrow some bread. I have a friend visiting and I have nothing to feed him.'"

"What if the friend answers, 'I can't help you right now. It's late and we're already in bed.' But what if you keep knocking on the door? Jesus said, "If you knock so long that you wake everyone in the neighbourhood, your friend will get up and give you some bread."

Jesus used this story to tell His friends and us to knock on God's door by asking for what you need. He says, "Everyone who asks will get what he asks for. Everyone who looks will find what he is looking for. Everyone who knocks will have the door opened to him."

Jesus said prayer is a way to ask, seek, and knock. Jesus even taught His disciples a way to pray. We call this prayer the Lord's prayer. Why don't you say this prayer now.

"Our Father who art in heaven, Hallowed be thy name. Thy kingdom come. Thy will be done, on earth as it is in heaven. Give us day our daily bread. And forgive us our trespasses; as we forgive those who trespass against us. And lead us not into temptation; but deliver us from evil."

"Our Father ..."

That is a beautiful prayer, isn't it? It isn't a very long prayer, but there are three things in this short prayer that every prayer should include. First of all, it praises God, our heavenly Father. Second, it asks God to provide for what we need for each day. Finally, it asks for God's forgiveness for the times that we fall short of what he expects of us.

After 2000 years, we still pray the way that Jesus taught us.



Fr. Nick celebrates his Diamond Jubilee

On the morning of the 21st July, I962, Nicholas Harnan was ordained as a Missionary of the Sacred Heart. His classmates had been ordained the year previously but Nicholas was too young and now needed a dispensation for age. Because of this Nicholas was sent to Cork University and missed out on going directly to the missions with his classmates. Nicholas was allowed to study Applied Psychology and also one teaching subject which



happened to be French. He eventually acquired an honours B,A. and an M.A. in Applied Psychology. He was sent to England to teach in a secondary boarding school. This allowed him to get to know young people at a deep level and their hard working parents. On the weekends he with the other young Irish priests heard many confessions and said Masses in the various surrounding parishes. This was a very busy life and lasted until the early seventies. Then he was allowed to enter into the field of helping adults who had emotional and psychological problems. But before he could take on this demanding work he had to acquire further qualifications. He was sent to the USA to do a two-year internship in Psychotherapy. He was then sent back to England to practice Psychotherapy on a regular basis. Because there were so few priests qualified in this field severe demands were made on Nicholas's time. Many of these requests came from overseas such as from Africa and South America. This involved much international travel. To be able to genuinely help those individuals and groups which needed help, Nicholas had to spend long periods of time with these people. This meant that now Nicholas was a foreign missioner in a new way. He spent many years in Africa, the Far East and South America. He worked for many international catholic organisations such as Lumkoo Institute, The House of Affirmation and his own orders International Centre of Spirituality which was called Cor Novum. Then Nicholas was asked to start a new ministry which tried to prevent many of these troublesome problems and teach people to live more wholesome and spiritually healthy lives in giving conferences and directing retreats. This brought him into contact with many different people around the world, Nicholas reckons that he lived and worked in most countries except China.

Then in 2017 Nicholas came back to Ireland and worked with the students in Dublin. Finally his sister Sheila asked him to retire to Portlaoise and get to know his nieces, nephews and grandnieces and grandnephews. This has been a most enjoyable period of his life and he helps out in the Parish of St. Peter and Paul in little ways. He finds the people of Portlaoise to be delightful. So after 60 years of priesthood dealing with people in all their struggles and difficulties he has never regretted one day in the ministry. He hopes and prays that many young people will take the risk and join the priesthood and religious life. They will not regret it.
