## Found

When we are young the future is bright. When we are young we know what we want and are optimistic about achieving it. When we are young the difference between right and wrong is clear-cut.



When we are young we are confident that there are people who love us and hold us in high esteem. Then life begins to throw spanners in the works .... very large ones! Suddenly we're not quite so sure what we want after all, and trying to achieve anything worthwhile is like running at an immovable brick wall. Life begins to test our principles. Lapses of courage tempt us to tell lies; poverty encourages us to take what doesn't belong to us; fear of failure encourages us to cheat; depression encourages us to drink or eat too much; desperation encourages us to take drugs or gamble. The path that leads away from God is an out of control downwards spiral. Worse, once we lose our self-esteem, it is very difficult to turn back to God. Once we have spiralled to an all time low, it is difficult to think of ourselves as worthwhile. Once we have hit rock bottom, it is hard to imagine that anybody might care enough to help us, or that anyone could still love us.

Jesus tells three parables that demonstrate God's mercy and compassion. 'The Lost Sheep', 'The Lost Coin' and the 'Lost Son'. As we soldier on through life feeling worthless and insignificant, these three parables tell us that we do not have to accept our sorry lot in life. Jesus reminds us that no one is worthless or insignificant in God's eyes ... not one single person. It doesn't matter how far we have travelled away from God, God is looking to bring us back.

Today's parables are about wholeness and inclusion in a society seemingly intent on division and exclusion. In all of us there is a need to be found and carried, and in all of us there is the ability to seek out and help others. Most of all, today's parables are about forgetting the human instinct to judge others and to feel the joy of God the Father's reconciling love.

## THE LOST SHEEP

I have a very nice collection of stuffed teddies. They come in all shapes and sizes. When I was younger I used to sleep with one of my stuffed teddies, my favourite teddy was called Tenby, the reason why I called him Tenby is because my sister bought this teddy for me when we were on our holidays in Wales, we were in a place called Tenby. One day I lost Tenby and I was so upset, but found him hiding under the bed!! Even though I have a very large collection, every one of them is very important to me and I would be very upset if one of them was lost.



That reminds me of a lesson that Jesus taught to a group of religious leaders one day. The religious leaders were very upset that Jesus was often seen associating with sinners. He was even sometimes seen eating with them. The religious leaders didn't like that at all and were very critical of Jesus. Jesus told them a story to help them to understand.

"Suppose one of you had a hundred sheep and you lost one of them," Jesus said. "Wouldn't you leave the ninety-nine who were safe, and go and search for the lost sheep? And when you found the lost sheep, wouldn't you joyfully put it on your shoulders and carry it back home? Wouldn't you be so happy that you would tell all of your friends about finding the lost sheep?" I imagine that all of the religious leaders had to agree that they would do just as Jesus had suggested. Then Jesus said to them, "In the same way, there is more rejoicing in heaven over one sinner who repents than over ninety-nine righteous persons who do not need to repent."

The Gospel teaches us that we are like sheep and sometimes stray away from God. That makes God very sad, but he never gives up on us. He keeps searching for us and calling to us. He wants to draw us back into his arms. He even sent Jesus, his Son, to save those who are lost. Aren't you glad that God doesn't give up on his lost sheep? 

# Time to Think! LIVING IN THE PRESENT MOMENT

One day a man walked past a camp of elephants. Looking closer, he was surprised to see that these mighty animals weren't held in cages or kept in chains. The only thing stopping them from escaping? A thin rope tied from one of their legs to a simple pole in the ground. Confused, as to why they didn't use their strength to break the rope, he asked the trainer why they weren't attempting to run away. To this the trainer replied, "As baby elephants, we use the same system. But, at that age, the rope is strong enough to stop them from escaping. They grow up like this, believing they can never break the rope, so even as adults they stay put." In other words, these powerful, magnificent and intelligent elephants didn't believe they could free themselves, so they never tried.

Our personal beliefs are powerful beyond measure and often dictate our outcomes. They can work for or against us. Identify your limiting beliefs so you can push against them.



# ELEPHANT ROPE

As we journey in life, often of our greatest struggle, is to find ourselves in the present moment. How many of us are burdened and carry too much heavy baggage, because of past events and unresolved issues. How many of us may be overwhelmed and full of worry or anxiety, regarding what may happen down the road. In fact, very few are blessed with the freedom and contentment to live in the present moment. When I am present in the now, I am not consumed by what happened yesterday or fearful regarding what may occur tomorrow.

The great St. Padre Pio, had a powerful spirituality regarding living in the present moment. Towards the end of his life, a life, that contained a huge amount of personal suffering, he made a profound prayer of serenity, rejoicing in his liberation, for being blessed just to live in the present moment. His prayer is a gift for all of us as we walk our daily pathway. The best pathway, proven by the wisdom of the elders, is one that takes one step, one moment at a time. Saint Padre Pio said, "My past life I give to your mercy, O Lord, whatever may happen tomorrow, I hand into your providence, Today, let me live in your love".



I've been reading a biography of St. John Henry Cardinal Newman recently. I offer one significant moment of his life to ponder this week. In 1833, several years before his reception into the Catholic Church, he travelled to Rome. Then, on his return voyage, he became seriously ill and, at the same time, the ship was becalmed in the Mediterranean. That is, the winds ceased and the ship was more or less stalled, drifting, until the winds came back. Newman's life coincided almost exactly with the 19th century - he lived from 1801 to 1890. It was a time of great advances in scientific knowledge, in mechanisation and industry. Political upheaval was widespread as well; old dynasties fell and experiments in new forms of government began. In all these fields, persons seemed to grasp a greater mastery of their own fates. And yet, even with all humanity's new knowledge and power, one could still be "becalmed." Nature could still do something that simply made you stop.

On this occasion, while at sea, Newman wrote the poem "The Pillar of the Cloud," better known by the informal title, "Lead, Kindly Light." It has been set to many tunes, and has become a well-beloved hymn. There isn't room for the whole text, but here's an excerpt:

Lead, Kindly Light, amid the encircling gloom Lead Thou me on!

The night is dark, and I am far from home — Lead Thou me on!

Keep Thou my feet; I do not ask to see The distant scene — one step enough for me.

It's a great expression of trust, and of patience: he doesn't ask to see "the distant scene" - the end of this road, wherever it goes. "One step enough," sufficient grace for the present, is all he asks. Both afflicted with illness, and unable to go anywhere, Newman put his faith in a Light, a Light he knew was kindly disposed to him, and was leading him to safe harbour.

May the light of hope and peace bring us all great serenity and acceptance...

# **WORLD SUICIDE PREVENTION DAY 2022**

Creating Hope Through Action'

The theme for World Suicide Prevention Day for 2022 is 'Creating Hope Through Action'. It is a time when we can spread a message of hope to others. Even though suicide is a very complex issue, we can always look out for those who might be experiencing suicidal thoughts and provide support.

In this way, we can all contribute and play our part in creating a caring society in which those who may need support, feel comfortable in seeking help.

The following are some actions that we can all do to create hope in our society:

### Increase your awareness

If someone tells you that they are having thoughts of suicide, stay calm and don't be afraid. There are training programmes that can help prepare you so that you feel confident in having a conversation. Free suicide awareness and prevention programmes are available from the HSE - LivingWorks Start (90 mins online programme) or safeTALK (a half-day face to face programme). These can help you recognise people who might be at risk of suicide, give you the language to ask them about their suicidal thoughts and assist you in connecting them with helpful supports and services. Reach in to someone you know who might be having difficulties. Find a comfortable space and time to sit and be present with them. Use open questions and tell them you care about them. You don't need to have all the answers. If they share things with you, listen - stay calm, be patient and kind. Remember that bringing up the topic of suicide with someone will not make suicide more likely. It can be really helpful for a person to have a safe space to open up in, to know that they are being heard and that they are not alone at a difficult time.

### Reach out

If you are feeling particularly low, sad or hopeless, always remember that sharing things with someone else will help. Reaching out to talk with someone - someone close



or even a support organisation might initially feel frightening. Even if you can't find the right words, when you take that first step and start to share and talk about what's going on for you, things can become clearer and you will start to feel more hopeful. ### Be The Light for others and your community

Connect with a support or community organisation. Volunteer, help spread their messages and become involved in activities that promote positive mental health and wellbeing or suicide prevention in your community. Always be mindful of what people might be going through when talking about suicide - be sensitive. Be compassionate and respectful of the lives that have been lost and of those within your community who have been bereaved. Remember that people can and do get through times of crisis and that a positive message of recovery, can be protective and hopeful for others to hear.

### Know where to turn

Get to know what mental health supports and services are available both locally and nationally and tell



people about them. Tell your family, your friends, your colleagues - you never know when someone might need support. Many are open 24/7 and contact can be made in different ways, on the telephone, by text message, online or face to face. See below for a list of all the available supports and services - emergency 24 hour services and ongoing supports.

Remember if there are immediate concerns, your local GP should be contacted, or the GP Out of Hours Service. The local Hospital Emergency Depts, are also there to provide support, assessments and whatever assistance is required.
