

Choose A New Direction

We embark on a diet and the days of lettuce and low calorie drinks loom gloomily. We embark on a fitness regime and our subconscious whispers, "Fifteen more minutes



under a warm duvet versus a jog round a freezing park ... I know what I'd choose!" In today's gospel, John the Baptist preaches "Repent for the Kingdom of Heaven is at hand." The idea of 'repentance' fills us with about as much excitement as a cold shower on a winter's morning, but it doesn't have to be like that. Diets, fitness regimes and repentance all have one thing in common we emerge as new people as a result of choosing a new direction. Repentance doesn't mean throwing ourselves round in fits of Catholic guilt, it simply means having a change of heart, and becoming new and better individuals as a result. There are areas in all our lives that can be improved or turned around. The idea of repentance is actually quite exciting.

John's Advent call for a change of heart is for each and every one of us. We might think we are good enough as we are, but that's probably how the Pharisees and Sadducees in today's reading also felt. True enough they turned up for John's baptism, but had they really turned up in a spirit of repentance? John is clearly suspicious of their motivation, and challenges them to prove their commitment. Declaring our intention to change is all well and good, but our commitment must also 'bear fruit' ... show results.

At this time of year, every year, we are asked to change our lives. For the less optimistic amongst us, the idea reminds us of new year resolutions; easily made, easily broken and all a little bit pointless. John's message is a tough one. Changing our lives is far from easy. One of the problems of course is that when we try to change we usually rely solely on our own will power, which is notorious for letting us down. John the Baptist reminds us that when we are baptised in the name of Jesus we will receive the Holy Spirit, a divine power that will help us towards God when our will power fails. All we have to do is ask and keep on asking.

Change is not beyond any of us however much you think it probably is. John might have given the Pharisees and Sadducees a hard time but in truth the message is clear. "There is none so lost, they cannot be found, none so helpless that their life cannot be changed."





Wow! There are only sixteen days until Christmas! Are you ready for Christmas? That is a question we hear quite often these days, isn't it? What do people mean when they ask if you are ready for Christmas? Well, they usually mean things like...

- Do you have all of your shopping done?
- Have you finished wrapping all your gifts?
- Have you put up your Christmas tree and all the decorations?
- Have you sent your Christmas cards?
- Have you finished baking all of the Christmas goodies?
- Is your house clean and ready for visitors?

Are you ready for Christmas? What things do you need to do before you will be ready? There is another question that is much more important than "Are you ready for Christmas?" That question is, "Are you ready for Christ?"





In the Gospel today, we hear the voice of John the Baptist crying out to the people, "Prepare the way for the Lord. Fill in the valleys and level off all the mountains. Make the crooked roads straight and the rough places smooth." Did John the Baptist really want the people to work on the roads? No, what John wanted was for the people to get ready for the coming of the Messiah. What he really meant was that the people needed to get their hearts right and return to God. You see, no matter how good people may think they are, there are always some crooked ways and rough places in their lives. There are things such as dishonesty, selfishness, pride, jealousy, and many more.

John wanted the people to make those crooked ways straight and rough places smooth so that Jesus could come and walk among them.

During this special season of the year, you and I need to make sure that we are ready for the coming of the Christ

of Christmas. We need to look into our hearts and ask God to make our crooked ways straight and smooth out the rough places so that we can walk with Jesus each day of our life. Let's ask him to do that right now.

CHRISTMAS 2022 - A TIME TO PRIORITISE

In the northern hemisphere, Christmas comes in an extraordinary time of the year. In our most vulnerable and darkest days, we are invited to indulge in a light that is brighter than any darkness, in a hope that is greater than any fear, in a bigger picture, that reminds us "God so loved the world, that he simply and majestically, became one of us".

The infant child, depicted in the crib, often has his arms outstretched, reaching out with empathy and deep love, into the depths of our humanity. The Christ-child's presence is warm, intimate and full of affection. Jesus is indeed the reason for the season. Yes, we all know we live in very challenging times, the list of burdens can be endless, but this time of year it's also important to prioritise and hold a sense of gratitude, for the gifts perhaps we can't purchase, but deeply value. Our family, our friendships, our health, our hopes and our joys. I think of so many this Christmas who would love to be healthy, to be reunited with a loved one whom has departed.

Often in life it's not till what we take for granted is threatened, we discover what ultimately is important. This is the gift of Christmas. Spending time with loved ones, nourishing the meaning and purpose of life, finding hope and consolation in the bright star that says even in the depth of winter, soon the green shoots of spring will once again awaken hope and new beginning.

In a Christmas message, the late Queen Elizabeth stated: At Christmas, our attention is drawn to the birth of a baby some two thousand years ago. It was the humblest of beginnings, and his parents, Joseph and Mary, did not think they were important. Jesus Christ lived obscurely for most of his life, and never travelled far. He was maligned and rejected by many, though he had done no wrong. And yet, billions of people now follow his teaching and find in him the guiding light for their lives. I am one of them ...

With all that's changing, we need to focus on important values that we would never want to lose. Our Christian faith calls us to be a welcoming people and to reach out to the vulnerable. This faith challenges us to be fair and just in our sharing of the world's resources. The frailty of our planet also cries out for shared action to hand on our "common home" to future generations. Each time of crisis provides an opportunity which must be seized. These challenging times, bring us to the heart of the Gospel message: what we agree to do as a community is more authentic and lasting than our individual concerns. This is a time for unity and for shared concern for one another.

We need a radical new way of relating and living that brings harmony and sustainability to all of life. We humans are part of the interconnected cosmic web of creation, and we need to live a new paradigm of



communion with all that is. Long ago, Francis of Assisi grasped this fundamental reality. He intuitively understood the importance of living not as a self-centred individual but as part of the larger whole. He championed the art of living in deep harmony and communion. Inspired by his namesake, Pope Francis says the awareness of God incarnate in the world that can "motivate us to a more passionate concern for the protection of our world" and an "ecological conversion". We must learn that 'less is more'. We must learn to envision a new economy that shifts away from consumption and exploitation to one that celebrates radical interdependence and reciprocity within diverse webs of life. Only by taking less from the earth can we move to an alternative model of living in radical harmony and deep connection with the planet.

The pandemic has highlighted how vulnerable and interconnected everyone is. If we do not take care of one another, starting with the least, with those who are most impacted, including creation, we cannot heal the world. Let us follow the footsteps of Jesus as we listen and respond to the cry of the earth and the cry of the poor.

At Christmas, we pray that through Christ, we will all be united in shared goals: to look out for and care for one another more; to reach out to those who have less; to support those who grieve or carry heavy burdens, and to be eternally grateful for the many blessings we have, today and always.

May the Lord of light shine on you and on your loved ones this Christmas and in the New Year.

I pray, as we prepare to celebrate the Christmas season, you will be filled with peace, joy and hope.

CAPITAL EXPENDITURE AND INCOME

The final cost of the renovation work to the Church of the Assumption, the Heath, came in at €574,500. The work has been much admired and the building is secured for decades to come. Work will begin on Holy Cross Church, Ratheniska, in January 2023. We look forward to a similar result. During 2021 the sale of the Old Parochial and grounds was completed, €450,000 was the sale price.

THE PARISH CENTRE

Thank God the Parish Centre is returning to something like its pre-pandemic activities. The past few years have been difficult for the Centre and it has run at a loss during this period. There is good news in that we had 'business interruption insurance' and we are in negotiation with our Insurers and are optimistic that we can recover our losses.

PARISH LOTTO

As you can see from the accounts there is an increase in the profit from the Lotto in 2021 v 2020. It is accounted for mostly by the 'luck of the draw'! Thank you to all who support it and in particular our promoters. Half yearly and yearly membership gift tokens are available from the Parish Centre and many have used these at Christmas, Birthdays and other occasions. It is also possible to play Parish Lotto on-line from our website www.portlaoiseparish.ie. Many have taken the opportunity, maybe you would like to participate? It is a fun way to support Parish Development and at the same time give yourself a chance to share in the €1,000 weekly match 3 prize fund or to scoop the attractive Jackpots on offer each week of between €10,000 and €20,000. Again many thanks to all who support it and in particular to our promoters.




