Three Things To Do For Lent

Fasting and Abstinence:-

Keep your meals small and simple during Lent. This is not a slimming exercise. The thinking behind fasting and abstinence is that we strengthen our spiritual life by weakening physical pleasures. Fasting means reducing the amount of food that we would normally eat. Abstinence means not eating a particular food (meat). Ash Wednesday and Good Friday are to be observed as special days of Fasting and Abstinence.

Almsgiving:-

We are bombarded with requests for money from a huge number of charities. Identify a charity that means something to you ... find out what they do and make a contribution. If you can't afford to give money, give your time.

Prayer:-

Our lives are so hectic that we often forget to set aside a few quiet moments in which to talk to God. During Lent, postpone breakfast television for a few moments and make a short prayer. In the evening encourage your children to say a night time prayer before bed.

Turn the Other Cheek

Imagine this scene on the playground at school. Children are playing at recess when one child pushes another. That child pushes back. Then the first child retaliates by hitting the another child who then hits him back. Soon, the two are involved in a knock-down, drag-out fight.

The teacher soon arrives and asks,

"What's going on here?"

"He pushed me!" one child responds.

"Well, he pushed me first!" replies the other.

"He hit me!"

"He hit me back!"

I'm sure you have seen something like this happen on the playground at school. What do you think? If someone pushes you, isn't it OK to push them back? If someone hits you, isn't it fair for you to hit back?

I think it would be a good idea to see what Jesus has to say about this in today's Gospel. In the Sermon on the Mount, Jesus told his followers, "You have heard it said, 'An eye for an eye, and a tooth for a tooth.' But I say, do not resist an evil person! If someone slaps you on the right cheek, offer the other cheek also." That doesn't sound fair, does it?

But Jesus went even further! "You have heard the law that says, 'Love your neighbour and hate your enemy.' But I say, love your enemies! In that way, you will be acting as true children of your Father in heaven. If you love only those who love you, what reward is there for that? If you are only kind to your friends, how are you different from anyone else?

So, that is what Jesus said and that is what he expects of us. We can only do that if we ask God to help us.



OUR PRAYER

Father, sometimes we want to strike back when someone hurts us. Give us the strength and courage to do as Jesus taught us and "Turn the other cheek."

In Jesus' name we pray. Amen.

Almsgiving: Giving to those who have very little or sharing what you have with someone who needs it.






Facts about Lent:

Ash Wednesday is the First Day of Lent. On Ash Wednesday people are asked to fast. On Ash Wednesday the priest blesses the ashes and uses them to make the sign of the cross on our foreheads. The priest or minister says 'turn away form sin and be faithful to the Gospel', or similar words. Wearing ashes is a sign that a person is going to make an extra special effort during Lent to use his/her gifts for the good of others.

We remember in our thoughts and prayers for all the people in Syria and Turkey at this sad time. Maybe during Lent, you can say this prayer every day with your family.

Time to Think!

Ash Wednesday marks the beginning of Lent

Feb 22nd, Ash Wednesday marks the beginning of Lent. This is a season of reflection that leads us towards the three days of the Triduum, with Easter Sunday falling on Sunday, April 9th. It is a time to ask questions, a pause time on a journey, a time when we might re-examine the baggage we carry from month to month, maybe a time to lighten the load. The third verse of a hymn from the late Sixties, 'God's spirit is in my heart' has these words. "Don't carry a load in your pack, you don't need two shirts on your back, a workman can earn his own keep, can earn his own keep". That just about sums up the story of our journey. So the signing of the cross on our foreheads, using ash from last year's burnt palms is a reminder of where we have come from and where we are headed and the ever-present need to take stock.

Lent is a time of return, when that which was lost is found again and a new beginning sought. The 'lost sheep' is a recurring symbol of our experience. A few years ago I came across a solitary sheep cropping the roadside verge. It gave rise to these few lines.

"It had strayed beyond the barbed fence, head down, to graze the grass verge by the roadside.

Careless of traffic, a single sheep, carrying a rust-red stain of identity, had walked away from the field flock. Slowly it cropped the road edge, unhurried, waiting to be found".

The mark of our baptism identifies us with our flock. With Ash Wednesday and the start of the Season we call Lent, there is a call to spiritual awareness, an opportunity to strip lives down to the bare essentials and see what really matters. T.S. Eliot in his poem *Ash Wednesday*, published in 1930 writes of the Christian pilgrimage.

"...and pray to God to have mercy on us and pray that I may forget these matters that with myself I too much discuss, too much explain, because I do not hope to turn again, let these words answer for what is done, not to be done again, may the judgement not be too heavy on us"

Too often we are quick with our answers on matters of faith and morality when really we should look more at the options that are open and the context of our choice. We easily forget that black and white are separated by many uneven shades of grey. Maybe that is what Lent gives us, a pause time to ask the difficult questions, not of others but of ourselves. And if the answers are not immediate, then we should not worry. Not all questions have answers that are clear cut and obvious, but the asking of the question at least means that we have considered an issue important enough to question. Waiting patiently is the story of our search for faith. A question posed doesn't always have a gift wrapped answer waiting to be opened.



Two years ago, the reflections of Francis on the recent Synod were published under the title 'Beloved Amazon'. In his words he addressed many of the social issues facing the poor of South American countries and the need for those in government to treat their people with fairness and care. His Franciscan tradition was much in evidence. However the headlines in the media focused their response to his statement on what was not said. There was no word on a pressing issue, addressed by the Synod, that there should be due consideration of the relaxation of the celibacy discipline in order to meet the chronic shortage of priests in so many communities. It was a matter of great disappointment to those who had hoped for encouragement to follow this path.

But neither did he reject the option of change which makes it imperative that the discussion continues with even greater urgency. It is a question that we cannot sidestep time and again, for the needs of the people must not be ignored. In our own country, the age profile of priests ministering in our parishes is a matter of increasing concern. If we ignore the road signs on our journey, we are in danger of finding ourselves in a cul de sac. So maybe there is a good question that we could all address this Lent, how might the Church meet the needs of the community without resorting to worn platitudes? Early morning brightness lights the sky once dawn breaks and the night time hours fade. We should encourage each other to face reality and trust that we might follow God's Spirit as it moves in our hearts.

"So do not fear, for I am with you; Do not be dismayed, for I am your God. I will strengthen you and help you; I will uphold you with my righteous right hand". Isaiah 41:10

Best wishes to our Confirmation Candidates, who will receive the Sacrament of Confirmation next weekend.

We have four ceremonies next Friday and Saturday at 12noon and 2pm. We have over 340 boys and girls enrolled this year. We pray that the Holy Spirit with his gifts will enrich the Confirmation Candidates and through them enrich the life of their families, their schools and our Parish. Our thanks to their teachers and all who have been involved in their preparation programme. Please God we will have a good weather and all will have an enjoyable and great confirmation day.





St. Mary's Sports hall has served the town of Portlaoise and the wider community for over 40 years providing much used and appreciated facilities for indoor sport. We owe a debt of gratitude to those whose vision and voluntary efforts and contributions provided such a facility in a very different town and indeed a very different time. Portlaoise Parish holds the Sports Hall in trust for the community. It has been managed and run by a voluntary committee for all those years who have worked hard to keep the hall upgraded and available to the many groups and sports clubs that use it.

Covid intervened to frustrate plans for a major project of refurbishment and improvement scheduled to begin in January 2021. Over $\[mathebox{\ensuremath{\varepsilon}}50,000$ was spent on plans and preparatory work on this project in the past 2 years including gaining planning permission. A tender price of $\[mathebox{\ensuremath{\varepsilon}}400,000$ had escalated to over $\[mathebox{\ensuremath{\varepsilon}}600,000$. The escalation in price caused the committee to pause and to consider the future of the Hall and how it can best serve the much expanded and growing community of Portlaoise both now and into the future.

In considering all the options for the future of the Sports Hall discussions were opened with Laois County Council. The Council were very receptive to explore how they might play a significant part in ensuring that this very important facility is utilised and developed in the best possible way. It is accepted that it is no longer appropriate or feasible that a parish would continue to bear this responsibility. The Council will have access to grants and funds that a parish committee cannot access. Portlaoise parish, with the consent of the Diocese, were prepared to transfer the effective ownership, management and development of the Hall to Laois County Council by way of a long term lease at no cost. And so a long term lease has been signed recently with Laois Co. Council.

I wish to take this opportunity to thank and congratulate all those associated with St. Mary's Sports Hall over the years. It was a remarkable achievement for a parish to provide such a facility and the amount of maintenance, expansion, development and upgrading that took place is great credit to the voluntary committee that oversaw the Hall on behalf of the Parish. All who have enjoyed the facilities of the hall and the community in general owe them a debt of gratitude. I express my sincere thanks.

Our very best wishes to Laois Co. Council and those who take over the task of running the Hall as a community sports facility. We look forward to the developments that will inevitably take place.
