The Key

Who do you think Jesus is? As small children we are told that Jesus is the Son of God, and

we accept it readily. When we are children God is a kindly father figure who lives in Heaven and listens to our night prayers. When we are small, Jesus is the baby we see in the Christmas Nativity scene. When we are a little older, Jesus is the teller of all those intriguing parables. Once we are young adults we see Jesus as a great teacher, a healer, a worker of miracles and a revolutionary. For some of us, doubts creep in. Is Jesus really the Son of God or simply a good man and a great prophet?

In today's gospel Jesus asks his disciples "Who do you say I am?" "You are the Christ," replies Peter promptly, "the Son of the living God." But this wasn't Peter's opinion from the start. Peter and the other disciples first met Jesus as a fellow human being. By working with Jesus and following his ministry daily, Peter and the other disciples gradually came to the extraordinary conviction that God was working through Jesus; speaking, healing, working miracles and offering eternal salvation.

Today we listen again to Jesus' question. "Who do you say I am?" It seems that the question is stretching over the centuries. It seems that the question is aimed not just at the disciples but at us. Jesus doesn't want us to give the answer we've been taught to give ... our answer has to be from the heart. Our answer might be, "I don't know!" Our answer might be, "I'm not very sure right now." Or our answer might be a resounding, "You are Christ, the Son of the living God." Jesus knows that faith is a journey and our answer reflects at exactly what stage of that journey we have reached.

It may be that we think of Jesus as little more than a good man and a great prophet. If this is what we believe, the Bible becomes little more than a book filled with good stories and sound philosophy. If like the disciples we are convinced that Jesus is the Son of God, all at once we are opening ourselves to great possibilities.... all at once we have found the key to life's greatest adventure.

The Beheading of John the Baptist 29th August

The death of St. John the Baptist is reported in varying amounts of detail

throughout the synoptic Gospels and Mark and Matthew report the event with the most detail. In Mark's Gospel, John was arrested and imprisoned because of King Herod's fear of him. But although Herod feared John, he would not kill him because he knew John was a righteous and holy man, and he liked hearing John speak. Herodias, Herod's wife, did not share his respect for John and looked for any chance to have him killed. Herodias' chance came when her daughter Salome's dancing so pleased the smitten Herod that he promised her anything she desired. Herodias prompted her daughter to ask for the death of John the Baptist. Herod granted her wish and John was killed.





(Peter's Confession)

It's back to school time again! Some of you are probably feeling excited. Some of you may be a little sad that summer is over. You may feel nervous or a little scared about going back to school because of all the new things that you will have to face. On the first day of school, the teacher will probably ask some questions to see how much you already know. When the teacher asks a question to which you know the answer, you might wave your hand excitedly in the air and say, "I know! I know!" It is a great feeling when you know the answer, isn't it? In the gospel today, the disciples are going "back to school." Can you guess who their teacher is? Right! Jesus is their teacher. "Who do men say that I am?" Jesus asked.

Time to Think!

Building Solid Foundations

This was a major week, for over 60,000 students who received their leaving certificate results. Sincere best wishes to all students, who soon begin a new journey. I suggest that as students of life, time is the greatest teacher of all. What makes us tick? Where do we find our foundations in life...

One key biblical image is that of building solid foundations, making a dramatic distinction between building on rock as opposed to on sand (Matthew 7: 24-27). The point of foundations is that they have to be done in advance, this largely hidden, deep digging, has an enormous impact on the stability of the building. The importance of the foundations are only realised when the storm comes and tests the structure. These days are an opportunity to do this crucial excavation work, to deepen our foundations and give us something to hang onto during the personal and social storms that threatens us. These are ten principles based on the wisdom of St. Ignatius of Loyola, suggestions for how you might concretely build up a good structure and hopefully help weather the many storms

1. Know yourself. The ancient Greek wisdom highlights the importance of the journey into oneself, the acquiring of crucial self knowledge that allows a person to be creative, responsible and free. Generally, we are given a gift or talent in one area, which also comes with a shadow side. Some kind of journaling or diary writing can help as a way of reflecting on life experience and seeing the meaning in it. Ask for divine help to process difficult experiences. It can take a lifetime, maybe that's why we live so long in general.

2. Accept your humanity. We are all a complex mix of body, mind and soul, with great gifts but also a great capacity to deceive ourselves. We are often driven by desires that unexamined will ruin us, but conversely will complete is. The best thing is that we have the tools to make great things of ourselves with humility and God's help. There are two basic movements within us, towards God and life and the opposite; we can learn how to differentiate these feelings or moods. This skill of discernment has to be learned and practiced, the challenge is accepting the mix of good and evil in us.

3. Tackle your demons. Many of us labour under the effects of the past, wounds or secrets that can severely limit our peace and happiness. It takes real courage to face into these, to ask for help (e.g. a counsellor or a close and trusted friend) and to take the necessary steps to move on.

4. Make amends. Inevitably we will have made mistakes along the way, we have a duty to try to right the wrongs that we have done insofar as that is possible. There is something concrete and real about actions as opposed to just words. The word 'sorry' goes a long way.

5. Put the supports in place. No one is a completely self sufficient 'island', rather we are who we are through relationships and particular individuals or institutions. Accepting that you can't do it alone means figuring out what supports or people you need to help you. The self sufficient ego doesn't like this so you have to actively go against it to put supports in place. Have a regular prayer/meditation practice. This is the most challenging thing as it demands accepting limits, the need for a higher power and the need to ask for help. A bit like charging a battery,



there is no shortcut for being plugged into the source for a certain time and frequency. It becomes easier with practice; the Spirit prays within us. God needs the access and time to make great instruments of us.

6. Fix a bad habit. Things tend not to get better by themselves so it's better to set out to conquer a bad habit intentionally and applying our resources to it, recognising that we need God's help especially in really tough challenges (pray as if everything depends on you but act as if everything depends on God). Apparently it takes around 7 weeks to fix a habit; start now. Bring God's grace to bear on the very root of the problem, clear all other debris.

7. Thank those who have made you what you are. A really useful exercise is to look back and realise all the people and kind actions that brought you to where you are. Remember what power you have to influence others for good in the same way. Break the cycle of negativity and regret though, it goes nowhere. Cultivate an 'attitude of gratitude

8. Reflect on your life and to what extent you are living your life's purpose and finding meaning. This is challenging, to examine the choices and compromises made in your 'big' decisions. Realise that you always have choices and pray for the insight to know what to do now, whether to live with it or make changes. Inevitably life is messy but God is there somewhere and we always have choices, even if it is to find meaning in less that ideal circumstances. It is in aligning ourselves to a sense of mission that we really come alive.

9. Reflect on your death – it's going to happen anyway! How would you like to have looked back on your life, what would you like to be remembered for, what can you do about it now? This is not a morbid speculation but rather an invitation to life fully the time that you have as a gift. We know from following Jesus that death is nothing to fear. The Cross of Christ is the centre of our lives.

BLESSED BRIGIDA MORELLO Foundress of the Ursulines of Mary Immaculate

The Congregation of the Ursulines of Mary Immaculate (UMI) was founded by Blessed Brigida Morello on 17th February 1649in Piacenza, Italy. During this era, education for the girl children was a far-fetched dream and was very difficult to find a platform for the ladies to come up in life. Blessed Brigida recognizing this need of the time responded prophetically, started her mission of educating young girls instilling in them the Christian values, who in turn would be the future mothers, the home maker to hand over the faith to the coming generations. Centuries later Five Zealous Italian Missionaries landed in Kerala, BLESSED BRIGIDA MORELLO India on 12th November in 1934. The Ursulines gradually extended their services to different parts of India and other continents as well.

Responding to the call of the LORD, according to the special needs of the people the mission is spread out in 103 convents at present in 5 different Provinces, engaged in various apostolate, such as education, healing Ministry Social apostolate and Pastoral Ministry. Besides Italy and India, the mission has expanded to Brazil, Africa, U.K and Ireland.

Spirituality of Blessed Brigida

Blessed Brigida's passionate love for the Crucified Lord developed from her very tender age, gradually culminated in an ardent desire to suffer for his greater glory. Twenty four long years of her cheerful suffering reflects this passion in her. Deep interior union with her beloved in profound contemplation made it possible to lead and guide the congregation with zeal and enthusiasm. Conformity to God's holy will in total abnegation and genuine unfeigned humility are ways of soaring the heights of holiness, according to Blessed Brigida. She was so well adorned with modesty, humility and deep interior and exterior serenity. She exhorts the importance of embracing adversities with patience, and heroic mortifications as powerful aid to genuine progress in sanctity.



Venerable Sr. Maria Celine Kannanaikkal

Venerable Maria Celine Kannanaikkal, an epitome of Blessed Brigida Morello, our Foundress, had an ardent devotion to the Crucified Lord from her early childhood. She was born into an ordinary devout Christian family on 13th February 1931 in Kerala, India. After her training and few years of teaching, she decided to dedicate her life and thus joined the Congregation in 1954. During her Novitiate she led a very virtuous life, and was blessed with visions and ecstasies. She also had to undergo various unpleasant experiences from the evil one, which she endured bravely for the love of the Crucified Lord and offered it for the salvation of souls.

After a lot of apprehensions she was professed on 20th June 1957. On the day of her Profession, Jesus appeared and requested her to surrender her health she is enjoying. Thus after 35 days of her life as a Professed sister, she was called for her eternal reward at an younger age of 26. Several people testify that they receive innumerable favours through her intercession. She has promised "I will come with my beloved

Jesus to console those who are in great difficulties." She was raised as the Servant of God on 29th July, and Pope Francis elevated her to Venerable on 5th August 2022.

The 10am Mass on Thursday 31st August in St. Peter & Paul's Church, Portlaoise will be celebrated as a Mass of Blessed Brigida Morello.




