Sunday (Today) 6th August

Professional life mentors could give us a few clues when it comes to staying motivated. The first and single most important factor in

On this feast day, we see him recognise that Peter James and John were downhearted and in need of some kind of emotional boost. He took them up a high mountain and treated them to a vision. The vision showed a transfigured Jesus, as dazzling as the sun speaking with Elijah and Moses. The vision showed the disciples a glimpse of the glory that they would one day share. Mountain top religious experiences are few and far between, but that shouldn't stop us sharing Christ's vision, and it shouldn't stop us getting on with God's work with a passion.

and ruler of the Poor Clares. She led an austere life, abounding in works of piety and charity. Patron of television.

St Teresa Benedicta of the Cross (Edith Stein) 9th August

Edith was born at Breslaw

(now Wroclaw, Poland), the youngest of seven children of a Jewish family. A brilliant student, she gained her doctorate in philosophy at twenty -five. She became a Catholic in 1922 and a Carmelite nun. Both Jewish and Catholic, she fled to Holland when the Nazis came to power but she was captured and sent to Auschwitz where she died in a gas chamber on 9 August 1942.














Sunshine Mountain

When I was a child, one of my favourite songs was "Climb Sunshine Mountain." Some of you may have heard it. Perhaps some of you have even sung it. It goes like this:



Climb, climb up sunshine mountain
Heavenly breezes blow
Climb, climb up sunshine mountain
Faces all aglow
Turn, turn from sin and sorrow
Look to God on high
Climb, climb up sunshine mountain
You and I



Isn't that a great song? It reminds me of a day when Jesus and some of his disciples decided to climb a mountain. The Bible tells us that Jesus took Peter, James, and John and led them up on a high mountain. When they were alone on the mountain, Jesus' appearance began to change and his clothes became dazzling white and shone as bright as the sun. Then Elijah and Moses appeared and began talking to Jesus.

The disciples became very excited, but as you can imagine, they were also a little bit afraid. As usual, Peter was the first to speak. He told Jesus that they should stay up there on the mountain and build three tabernacles. One for Jesus, one for Moses, and one for Elijah. All of a sudden, a cloud appeared and the voice of God came from the cloud saying, "This is my Son, whom I love. Listen to him!" Then Moses and Elijah disappeared and the disciples were alone again with Jesus.

You and I may never have an experience on the mountain top like the one that Peter, James, and John had, but we can "Climb Sunshine Mountain" if we will stay close to Jesus and walk with him each and every day.


Dear Father, we want to walk with Jesus and let his light shine on us. In Jesus' name we pray. Amen

When will the Sun come out to shine...

As I write this article, I look out and wonder when the sun will come out. July has been the wettest month ever recorded on this island. Unfortunately, so far this August has been wet and grey. I think of holiday makers who must be very disappointed despite the fact that Ireland perhaps has never looked as green. Light affects our mood, that's why the sun is so important, not just for vitamin D, but as a positive stimulus to our mental health. I suggest reading the following may well indulge us with necessary positivity. Believe that anything can happen and that we can reach out beyond the confines of our present thinking and celebrate with a new heart.

A motivational speaker walked confidently around the room holding a glass of water while leading a seminar on stress management. Dear parishioners of Portlaoise Parish, please allow me to introduce myself to you. I am Fr. Adriano Oliveira, a diocesan priest from the State of Minas Gerais in Brazil. I was born in 1976. I am the second-youngest son in a family of eight children. My dad passed away almost two decades ago, and my mother just celebrated her 80th birthday. Her name is Aidee. She is in good health and doing very well. My brothers and sisters are married and have kids and even grandkids. And most of them live less than 10 miles away from my mother's house. I have a nephew working and studying in Portugal, and we are the only members of our family living abroad.



I joined the diocesan seminary of Divinopolis in 1995. After eight years of philosophical and theological studies, I was ordained a deacon and a priest in 2003. Throughout my years of priesthood, I have served as a curate and administrator in different parishes and worked in our seminary and in education. I must admit that my early contact with "Irish culture" was through music. I grew up listening to U2 songs. I was 14 years old when the live version of I still haven't found what I am looking for became a hit on our pop radio stations. As far as I remember, most of the time I was trying to sing along the lyrics without knowing the meaning of the words.

In 2009, I had the opportunity to travel to Ireland to visit the country and learn English. I keep in my heart very fond recollections of those days. The insecurity of driving on the *other side* of the road. The enormous variety of green. The enjoyment of having the four seasons in a single day The peculiar layout and architecture of the towns. The different accents and the unpronounceable Irish words. The immediate yes to a cup of tea for any occasion. Fresh scones with butter and jam, and a cup of coffee... The warm welcome from people. These are living memories in my soul.

Last year, the Diocese of Kildare and Leighlin received me for a pastoral experience. The first assignment was as a curate in Kilcock, north Kildare. And recently, Bishop Denis Nulty appointed me as a curate here in Portlaoise. It is an honour and pleasure for me to serve this community under the guidance of Msgr. John Byrne and work along with fellow priests, deacon and the parish team. Keep me in your prayers. And if you see me around, don't hesitate to say hello or olá, as we do in Portuguese. My best wishes to Fr. David Vard in his new mission.


