

### Seeking the stubborn

Facebook has gone from a start up to a social network with over 2 billion users and Twitter has over 300 million active users. In a short period of time, through social media, people have found a new voice, a new way to con-



nect. In today's Gospel (Matthew 18:15-20), we learn that 2,000 years ago Jesus also told us that there is power in numbers. First he says, 'If two of you agree on earth about anything you ask, it will be done for you by my Father in heaven'. And then he says 'where two or three of you are gathered in my name, I am there among them'. Jesus offers a procedure for helping others to see the error of their ways and turn again to God. What Jesus was saying was: 'If anyone sins against you, spare no effort to make that person admit the fault, and get things right again between you'. If we feel that someone has wronged us, we should put our complaint into words. The worst thing we can do about a wrong is to brood over it - that is fatal. It can poison heart and mind until we can think of nothing else but our sense of personal injury. If we have a difference with someone, there is only one way to settle it, namely face to face. If a private and personal meeting fails in its purpose, we should take other people along with us as witnesses should a charge be sustained. What Jesus said is something like this, 'When you have given wrongdoers every chance and they still remain stubborn, you may think that they are no better than tax collectors and the Gentiles hopeless cases. My experience is that they too have hearts to be touched and there are many of them, like Matthew and Zacchaeus, who are among my special friends. Even if the suborn sinners are like tax-collectors or Gentiles, you may still win them over as I have done'. Jesus regards no one as a hopeless case and neither should we.

### The Exaltation of the Holy Cross



### **Counting the Cost**

How many of you would like to play the piano?

Before you answer that you would like to play the piano, let's see what it would cost to be able to play the piano and see if you are willing to pay the price.

First of all, you would have to buy a piano. It would be rather silly to say that you wanted to play the piano if you weren't willing to go out and buy a piano, wouldn't it? Being a true follower of Jesus is not always easy, but it is always worth it, if you are willing to pay the price.



### Never Give Up...

This month of September, has begun with bright, warm sunshine. We all respond positively to light and warmth, its energy helps us to grow and blossom. I was particularly inspired, by Pope Francis, recent visit to Mongolia. This vast country, sandwiched between Russia and China, is 20 times bigger than our island. It has a tiny Catholic population of almost 2000 people. Pope Francis, in his reaching out to the periphery and those on the margins expressed solidarity and joy to the indigenous people of Mongolia. He encouraged them to trust in their transcendent God and to hold firm to the values of kindness and compassion. He also sent solidarity to the Catholic community in China, often deeply oppressed by a regime that restricts religious practice. The following text is part of an amazing and uplifting wisdom Francis shared with the people of Mongolia.

"You can have flaws, be anxious and even be angry, but just remember that your life is the world's biggest contest. Only you can stop it from failing. You are appreciated, admired, and loved by so many. Remember that happiness is not having a sky without storms, a road without accidents, a job without effort, a relationship without disappointments.

Being happy means finding strength in forgiveness, hope in battles, security in fear, love in discord." It's not only to enjoy the smile, but also to reflect on the sadness. It's not just about celebrating success it's about learning from failure It's not just about feeling happy with applause, it's about being happy anonymously. Being happy is not a fatality of destiny, but an achievement for those who can travel on their own.

Being happy is to stop feeling victimized and become the author of your own destiny." "It is to walk through deserts, but to be able to find an oasis deep in one's soul. It's thanking God every morning for the miracle of life. To be happy is not to be afraid of your feelings and to be able to talk about yourself. Have the courage to hear a "no" and trust the criticism, even when it's unwarranted. It's about hugging your kids, hugging your parents, spending poetic moments with your friends, even when they burt us

To be happy is to let the creature that lives in us live, free, joyful and simple." You are mature enough to say, "I made mistakes". Having the courage to say I'm sorry. It's the sense of saying "I need you". It's having the ability to say, "I love you". May your life become a garden of blissful opportunities that in spring is a lover of joy and in winter a lover of wisdom.

And when you make a mistake, start over." Because only then will you be in love with life. You will find out that being happy isn't about having a perfect life. But use tears to irrigate the tolerance. Use your defeats to train your patience.

Use your mistakes with serenity of the sculptor. Use the pain to connect to pleasure. Use obstacles to open the windows of intelligence. Never give up... Above all, never abandon the people who love you. Never stop being happy because life is an amazing show." ~ POPE FRANCIS
