Tomorrow and Tomorrow and Tomorrow

We 'know not the day nor the hour', and when death finally catches us out, we can all too often be filled with regrets and 'if-onlys'.

"If only," we say after the death of a loved one. If only we'd spared our ageing parents more time. If only we'd made up that old family rift. If only we'd told our children that we loved them. And what of the deceased themselves? Every day people die unexpectedly. Every day people die in road accidents, as the result of violent crime, sudden illness or as the result of natural disaster. Thousands of people wake up every morning not suspecting that this day might be their last. Death is the final curtain by which time we must be prepared to meet our maker. It's a message we've heard over and over so why don't we heed it?

Life is full of deadlines. We have deadlines by which we must finish essays, complete projects, submit job applications, apply for loans or make payments. Life is always demanding that we make preparations. We make preparations for work, for exams, for holidays, for visitors, for weddings, birthdays and a hundred and one other occasions. But for the greatest test of all, that of meeting our maker we are curiously unprepared. Deep down we all know that we could be better Christians. Deep down we know there are things that we should be getting round to, but somehow we never do. Those great deeds we are planning can always wait until tomorrow, after all, unexpected death is only something that happens to other people isn't it? Tomorrow and tomorrow and tomorrow!

The five foolish virgins in today's gospel were caught wanting. When the bridegroom they were awaiting arrived unexcitedly in the middle of the night, they were caught unprepared. Their lamps were empty. In a panic they tried to borrow oil from the five wise virgins, but the five wise virgins were unable to help. The message here is that we cannot borrow our way into heaven; we can only enter the kingdom by our own merits. Today's gospel promotes urgency. We must not put off until tomorrow what we can do today. Do we make the most of opportunities to do good deeds as and when they arise? Do we make the right choices conscientiously on a daily basis? Do we live every day as though it were our last? If we are doing all of these things, we have no need to fear the unexpected.

Seperate Brochure

This edition of the *Link Up* includes a two page brochure which is also available separately as a stand alone publication. It outlines the various ways you can contribute to the parish in the absence of the traditional passing 'the baskets' at Masses for the Offertory and Development fund collections. Apart from the great benefit of not interrupting the Liturgy we feel this is a more adult way of dealing with each other in the matter of supporting the Parish. As St. Paul tells us 'each of you should give what you have decided in your heart to give, not reluctantly or under compulsion, for God loves a cheerful giver' (2Cor.9:7). It respects everyone's support for the parish is his or her own decision. We are grateful to those who support us and encourage everyone to play their part. How the money is spent is outlined in our annual account for 2022 and in the brochure. The sharp rise in the cost of energy stands out.

Payments to priests:

Collections for the support of the priests are separate from payments made to Parish Funds. There are 4 collections for the support of the Priests taken up during the year. Christmas, Lent, Easter, and October. They are lodged to the Parish Clergy Fund from which the priests are paid an agreed salary. If there is a surplus in the Clergy Fund at the end of the year (which invariably there is) it goes to the Diocesan Retired Priest Fund. The priests thank you for your continued generous support.

Parish Centre:

The pandemic and its aftermath hit the Parish Centre hard. It is only now in the later stages of 2023 that it has begun to recover with a good demand for meeting rooms, coffee shop, Link Up advertising etc returning to something like pre-pandemic times. There is no doubt that the Centre is at the heart of the Parish and its services are vital to a vibrant parish. While running at a deficit for the past 3 years we hope it will return to paying for itself in the current and subsequent years.

Parish Lotto:

The Parish Lotto, our regular weekly fund raiser, continues to be a very important contributor to the financial wellbeing of the Parish. Our thanks to all who support it and a special 'thank you' to our promoters. It has a very attractive prize fund. Yearly and half yearly membership gift cards are available at the Parish Centre. An ideal gift for Christmas, birthdays etc. You may also participate on-line via our website.

Parish Development:



Maximise your contribution by giving in a recordable way

Parishioners are encouraged to help us avail of the Charitable Donation Scheme, adding an additional 31% of the tax payer's gross income earned.

For example, an annual contribution of €300 (€25 per month) grows to €435 at no extra cost to you:

Analysis Of Our Recent Accounts

Our recently published accounts for 2022 show a sharp drop in our direct income since 2021 - about 21%. This is in part explained by some very generous contributions in 2021 however our ordinary expenses were greatly increased by the steep rise in energy costs - light and heat (€79,151) but we think it is important to keep our Churches well heated and comfortable. To cover our outgoings we need a weekly income of

In 2022, our weekly collection averaged £4,000. The gap was bridged by other contributions, mainly our Parish Lotto. Ideally our income should cover our expenses leaving our fundraising for Parish Development. We thank the many who support us on a regular basis and encourage all parishioners to be part of the work and mission of our Parish.

Once there was a big wedding. The wedding was so big that there were 10 bridesmaids. The bridesmaids all helped the bride get ready for the

wedding. Weddings back then started at night. Everyone knew that sometimes during the night the groom would come to the bride's house and call out for her. The bridesmaids would hold up their oil lamps so that the bride and groom could see each other. The groom would be so happy to see his beautiful bride!



Everyone would keep holding up their lamps so that everyone could walk down the streets all the way to the groom's house. Then there would be dancing and eating and lots of fun celebration of the wedding.

In Jesus' parable he told what happened when the 10 bridesmaids helped the bride get ready for the wedding. Five of the bridesmaids were wise. They knew that sometimes the groom would wait a long time before he came to get the bride. So the wise bridesmaids brought extra oil for their lamps. They wanted to be ready even if the groom came very late in the night.

The five other bridesmaids were foolish. They did not think about bringing extra oil.

After the bridesmaids got the bride ready they waited and waited for the groom to come. They kept their lamps lit so they would be ready when he came. As time went by the bride and all of the bridesmaids got sleepy and fell asleep.

Then someone shouted "Here's the bridegroom, come outside and meet him!"

The bride and all of the bridesmaids woke up. They fixed their lamps to make them nice and bright. The five foolish girls noticed that their lamps had run out of oil and had burned out. They asked the wise girls for oil but there was enough for them to have some too.

The foolish girls had to go and try to find more oil for the lamps. They did not get to go out with the bride to meet the bridegroom. They did not get to walk down the streets to the wedding feast with all of their friends. They were too busy trying to find oil.

When the wise bridesmaids and everyone else arrived at the groom's house they went inside and began the celebrations. The groom shut the door and locked it so no strangers could get inside. When the foolish bridesmaids came to the door they were not allowed in. The groom didn't even know who they were!

This parable explains how it will be when Jesus comes again. We do not know the day or the time when Jesus will come back. We should always love God and obey him so we will be ready whenever he comes. We want to be ready to go with Jesus to heaven. Are you ready?

Dear Jesus,

we know one day we'll get to meet you face to face.

Help us get ready for that wonderful day.

Time to Think!

The Gift of Kindness

There is story in the Gospel about a leper coming to Jesus on his knees and pleading with him, saying, 'If you want to, you can cure me'. It was a pitiful statement, suggesting despair. The leper had reason to, in the tradition of the time, leprosy was seen as a punishment by God for sin, and led to social and religious rejection. Maybe the man had lost hope and didn't expect much. But he was desperate, so he came on his knees; desperate people are not worried about losing their decorum. Or it could be that he simply didn't have feet he could walk with; leprosy destroys toes and you can't walk without them.

The first thing Jesus did was to look at the man; he didn't turn away in disgust. Then he listened to him; he didn't lecture him. He felt sorry for him; he didn't feel scorn for him. Then he touched him; he did not keep him at arm's length, or out of smelling range; he touched the untouchable. Jesus seemed stung by the man's 'If you want to', and replied, 'Of course I want to!' And he healed him. Jesus looked, listened, felt sorry, touched and healed. That was how he treated the leper, the outcast. An outcast is anyone I close myself off against, anyone I give a cold shoulder to, anyone the mention of whose name gives me a jolt. Those are my outcasts, my lepers. Isn't there a lesson there for us towards anyone who is an outcast to us?

I love this story from Katharine Hepburn's childhood; it's beautiful, in her own words....

"Once when I was a teenager, my father and I were standing in line to buy tickets for the circus. Finally, there was only one other family between us and the ticket counter. This family made a big impression on me. There were eight children, all probably under the age of 12. The way they were dressed, you could tell they didn't have a lot of money, but their clothes were neat and clean. The children were well-behaved all of them standing in line, two-by-two behind their parents, holding hands. They were excitedly jabbering about the clowns, animals, and all the acts they would be seeing that night. By their excitement you could sense they had never been to the circus before. It would be a highlight of their lives. The father and mother were at the head of the pack standing proud as could be. The mother was holding her husband's hand, looking up at him as if to say, "You're my knight in shining armour." He was smiling and enjoying seeing his family happy. The ticket lady asked the man how many tickets he wanted. He proudly responded, "I'd like to buy eight children's tickets and two adult tickets, so I can take my family to the circus." The ticket lady stated the price.



The man's wife let go of his hand, her head dropped, the man's lip began to quiver. Then he leaned a little closer and asked, "How much did you say?" The ticket lady again stated the price. The man didn't have enough money. How was he supposed to turn and tell his eight kids that he didn't have enough money to take them to the circus? Seeing what was going on, my dad reached into his pocket, pulled out a €20 note, and then dropped it on the ground. (We were not wealthy in any sense of the word!) My father bent down, picked up the €20 note, tapped the man on the shoulder and said, "Excuse me, sir, this fell out of your pocket."

The man understood what was going on. He wasn't begging for a handout but certainly appreciated the help in a desperate, heart-breaking, embarrassing situation. He looked straight into my dad's eyes, took my dad's hand in both of his, squeezed tightly onto the €20 note, and with his lip quivering and a tear streaming down his cheek, he replied; "Thank you, thank you, sir. This really means a lot to me and my family." My father and I went back to our car and drove home. The €20 that my dad gave away is what we were going to buy our own tickets with. Although we didn't get to see the circus that night, we both felt a joy inside us that was far greater than seeing the circus could ever provide. That day I learnt the value to Give.

The Giver is bigger than the Receiver. If you want to be large, larger than life, learn to give. Love has nothing to do with what you are expecting to get - only with what you are expecting to give - which is everything. The importance of giving, blessing others can never be over emphasised because there's always joy in giving. Learn to make someone happy by acts of giving." ~ Katharine Hepburn




