#### No Pain No Gain

The third servant in today's parable was trying to bury a responsibility that he wished to avoid. The treasure he had been given was an opportunity for him to invest and please his master, but instead of putting

himself out, he buried the treasure where he could forget about it and go about his own affairs. Buried deep, the treasure was no longer an uncomfortable reminder of his master's expectations. Meanwhile, the other two servants, realising that there is no gain without pain, risked everything on their master's account. They invested and multiplied their gifts, and their master was pleased by their efforts.

Like the three servants in this story we too have been given talents and gifts, and with those talents comes a responsibility to use those talents as an opportunity to make the world a better place. Our talents are varied, some great some small but we are all gifted in some way. Some have high profile and very obvious talents ... there are those who are great musicians, surgeons, sports people and scientists. The rest of us might have less obvious talents. We might have a talent for caring, listening, speaking, growing things or solving practical problems. Whatever our particular gift we are urged to step out with it ... stick our neck on the line and invest our gifts in God's cause. God will not be so impressed if we are too afraid, embarrassed or lazy to use our talents. Ever heard the expression 'Use it or lose it.' If we ignore our gifts long enough, there will come a time when we can no longer rely upon them. This is what happened to the third servant.

One of the excuses that the third servant made for not investing his gift was that he was fearful of losing it. But the message today is not to be fearful. God never asks us to do something we are not capable of doing, and he is not judging us by our levels of productivity. The master in the story did not judge the third servant for producing nothing from his gift, but rather for being lazy and for his bitter indifference to his master's generosity. The master would not have judged him harshly, if he had tried his best but failed.

Today we are invited to look again at what gifts we have been given and how we are using them for the benefit of all. We are asked to examine what gifts we might be ignoring because we are too embarrassed or afraid, and we are asked to live a little dangerously and invest more of ourselves in God's cause.

Seventh World Day of the Poor
Sunday 19 November 2023 is the
seventh World Day of the Poor, with the

seventh World Day of the Poor, with the theme of not turning away. Pope Francis takes his inspiration from the elderly Tobit, who says to his son,



""Do not turn your face away from anyone who is poor" (Tobit 4:7).

Pope Francis tells us that, "Whenever we turn away from those who are poor, we turn away from Jesus himself, who is forever associated with the most vulnerable in society (Matthew 25: 31-46)". Pope Francis goes on to celebrate the next door neighbours, "Ordinary people who quietly make themselves poor among the poor. They do more than give alms: they listen, they engage, they try to understand and deal with difficult situations and their causes."

The focus of today is not fundraising, though fundraising is essential, but encounter, accompaniment and change. We can sometimes 'subcontract' our charity by giving money to an organisation in the knowledge that they will do good. They will no doubt do good, but that approach may leave our hearts untouched by the lived experience of poverty. We are called to go 'beyond fundraising' on a journey of accompaniment with people in poverty, being converted ourselves in the encounter.



#### **Don't Bury Your Talents**

This morning, the gospel is a familiar story that Jesus told. It is called the Parable of the Talents. In the Parable of the Talents, a very wealthy man was going to go on a trip. He called his three servants together and told them that he would be gone for a long time and that he was leaving them in charge of all of his wealth. He divided up his wealth and gave it to the three servants.

To the first servant, he gave five talents. Now, that might not

sound like much to you, but in Jesus' day, that was a lot of money. To the second servant, he gave two talents. Not as much as the first servant received, but still a large sum of money. To the third servant, he gave one talent. Even one talent was worth quite a lot!

The first servant took the five talents his master had given him and put it to work and earned five more talents. The second also invested his two talents wisely and earned two more talents. The third servant took his one talent and buried it in the ground for safe keeping.

When the master returned, he was very pleased when the first two servants told him that they had doubled his money. "Well done," he said. "Because you had been faithful with what I have given you, I will give you much more."

"How about you?" he asked the third servant. "What did you do with the money that I left with you?"

The third servant said to the master, "I knew that you were a hard man and I was afraid, so I went out and hid your treasure in the ground so that it would be safe. See, here it is."

The master was angry. "You are a wicked and lazy servant. You could have at least put my money in the bank where it would earn more." He then took the one talent from the lazy servant and gave it to the one who had ten talents.

In this Parable of the Talents, God is the Master and you and I are his servants. The talents that the master gave to his servants in this story was a form of money. But God has given us talents too, hasn't he? God created each of us with special gifts and he expects us to use those gifts for the purpose for which he gave them to us.

Sometimes you and I may look at the talents that God has given to others and think that God hasn't given us very much talent. We might even be tempted to hide our talent.

But when we use our God-given talent to be all that God intended for us to be.

Everyone has great talents - Use them!




Dear Father, help us to use the talents that you have given us to be what you intended for us to be.

"God grant me the serenity to accept the things I cannot change. Courage to change the things I can, and the wisdom to know the difference". Why not pray this version? God, grant me the serenity to accept the people and situations I cannot change. Courage, to change the one that I can. And, the wisdom to know that it's ME.

There's a story about a farmer who grew award-winning wheat. Each year he entered his crop in a competition where it won a blue ribbon. On one such occasion, a newspaper reporter interviewed him and learned something about how he grew it. The reporter discovered that the farmer shared his wheat seed with his neighbours. He asked, 'Why do you share your best seed with your neighbours each year when you are in competition with them?' The farmer said, 'The wind picks up pollen from the ripening wheat, and swirls it from field to field. If my neighbours grow low-grade wheat, cross pollination will degrade the quality of mine. If I'm to grow good wheat, I must help my neighbours do the same'.

Clearly, the farmer was aware of the connectedness of life. He knew that his wheat couldn't improve unless his neighbours' did also. Everything is connected to everything else; nothing and nobody exists in isolation. In short, we all need each other, not just human beings, but everything else as well. Life can be a win-win situation for all.

Jesus on one occasion summarised his moral teaching as love of God and love of neighbour. The two commandments were one, he said, like two sides of a coin. Love isn't selective; it embraces all.



To close our heart to one person is, in a true sense, to close it to all. That is why a willingness to forgive is a necessary condition for love.

Love is an invitation, not a command. It is a call to be human. The only authentically human way to live is in self-giving affection. There is only one thing which can create unity in our lives and action, and that is love. It heals the divided self, and calms the civil wars that rage within us. To allow ourselves to be loved is the first step to personhood, because love is the fundamental calling of every human being. It leads a person from isolation and loneliness to community.

Love is one of God's practical jokes. God says, in effect, 'Forget about yourself; think of the other person. If you do, the first person to benefit will be yourself. By forgetting about yourself, you won't be the loser; you'll be the winner'. That turns logic upside down, but the experience of life shows it to be true. There is only one way of getting love, and that is to give it. If you want to have a friend, be a friend. Where there is no love, pour love in, and we will draw love out.

For those in a hurry; from Toyohiko Kagawa, Japanese Christian trade unionist, 1888-1960:

'Love is God's Holy of Holies.

Love alone is salvation.

Only in the Temple of Love do we worship God. Love alone introduces God to us.




