Finding the Meaning

Were the other disciples really so very different from Doubting Thomas? When they saw Jesus in their midst, they

took some convincing that it really was Jesus and not a ghost that had come to visit them. The gospel outlines four pieces of proof that Jesus uses to convince them that he really has risen from the dead. They can look at the marks on his hands and feet, they can touch him to check that he is really flesh and bone, and they can watch him eat a meal that they have prepared. The fourth proof is when Jesus opens their minds so that they can understand the prophecies that were made in the Old Testament, and which he has fulfilled by rising from the dead.

We are not as lucky as the first disciples. Two thousand years down the line we do not have the benefit of their first-hand experience. We cannot look at Jesus, we cannot touch him, or share a meal. The fourth proof though, the prophecies in the Old Testament are still there for us to read. The only trouble is, the Bible isn't always an easy book to read. We read a passage and fail to understand it. Sometimes we think we understand the literal meaning but the words fail to offer any significance. It would be good if Jesus could open our minds up as he did for those first disciples when they had trouble understanding the meaning of his death and resurrection.

One thing is for sure, understanding the Bible isn't going to happen magically, just as it didn't happen overnight for the disciples. We know that everything worthwhile takes effort. Playing a musical instrument takes years of practice. Being good at a sport takes considerable training. Learning a language demands a concerted amount of study and hard work. So too, we have to apply ourselves to understanding what we read in the Bible. We have to consider each passage for some time before we can really grasp it ... sometimes a single verse or phrase. Often we can derive great satisfaction from knowing that those parts we struggled with the longest hold the greatest meaning. The Bible yields up its greatest treasures to those who persevere.







Is it Jesus, or a Ghost?

I remember times when I was a youngster when I went on camping trips. One of the favourite activities on those trips was sitting around a campfire at night and telling ghost stories. Even though I kept telling myself, "There is no such thing as a ghost," that didn't keep some of those stories from scaring the daylights out of me, and they often made it difficult for me to go to sleep that night.



Even in Bible times, some people believed in ghosts and were afraid of them. Today's Bible lesson is one example of that.

The story begins after two men had walked along a road to a place called Emmaus. They were discussing the crucifixion of Jesus and all of the events that had taken place in the past few days. They wondered what it all meant. As they walked, they were joined by a man on their walk. They did not recognize that the man was Jesus. There is much more to that part of the story, but it is enough for now that we know that Jesus revealed himself to them. Finally, they recognised that the man was Jesus. They were so excited to see that Jesus was alive that they jumped up and walked all the way back to Jerusalem.

The two men found Jesus' disciples and began telling them what they had seen. The Bible tells us that as they said these things, Jesus himself stood among them and said to them, "Peace be to you." Do you think the disciples felt peace? No! The Bible says that they were terrified and filled with fear, thinking that they had seen a ghost!

Once again Jesus spoke to his disciples. "Why are you troubled, and why do doubts arise in your hearts? Look at my hands. Look at my feet. You can see that it's really me. Touch me and make sure that I am not a ghost, because ghosts don't have bodies, as you see that I do."

Still the disciples stood in disbelief, so Jesus asked them, "Do you have anything here to eat?" They gave him a piece of fish, and he ate it as they watched. That was even further proof that they were not seeing a ghost. A ghost doesn't need food.

The disciples had seen Jesus die. They had seen him placed in a tomb. But now they saw Jesus alive. Not just this day, but for more than 40 days, they saw him and talked with him. They even watched him eat food. They were not seeing a ghost! Those same disciples went all over the world, telling the story of Jesus' crucifixion, his death, and his resurrection. They never stopped telling the story during their whole lives.

You and I have been called to tell the story just like those disciples. We must be a witness for Jesus, too. We must tell the world that Jesus is alive.

Time to Think! Seeing Jesus in others....

It is hard to go through a day without feeling negative towards someone who crosses our path. It could be a flippant remark passed in our direction, that we may personalise and then own, or someone walking a dog without a lead, or, if you drive, a motorist who changes lane in front of you without warning. Or it could be someone you don't actually see, such as a commentator on the radio. The trouble is that the negative feelings can stay with us and spoil our day.

Our Christian faith offers us a way that lessens the sense of offence we feel. The Bible gives us a story of two travellers walking away from Jerusalem after the crucifixion of Jesus. They get talking to a man on the road who talks to them inspiringly about the Holy Scriptures. In fact, the man is Jesus, someone they had known well, who is now risen from the dead. The Bible says "their eyes were held so that they did not know it was Jesus". But elsewhere the Bible goes further than that and tells us that, without knowing it, we encounter Jesus in every person we meet. We are all "members of Christ's body". In the story of the King in Matthew's Gospel, Jesus passes judgement on the way we have treated other people in this life and ends by saying, "As long as you did it to one of the least of my brothers you did it to me". The Bible is sprinkled with similar sentiments: "Whoever receives you, receives me", "Whoever is generous to the poor, lends to the Lord".

Jesus had the gift of loving everyone he met, even those who were implicated in his trial, and execution on the cross. "Father, forgive them", he said as he was dying, "for they do not know what they are doing!" Elsewhere we find Jesus befriending many members of the "out groups" of the time, - lepers and others regarded as 'unclean' by the Jews; officials who collected taxes for the Roman occupiers; prostitutes and so on. Jesus wants to pass on to us this gift, of loving everyone we meet. This requires a change of perspective. We all know the kind of optical illusions, found easily on the internet, where an image can look like a duck or of a rabbit, depending on how you change your way of looking at the image. It can take a bit of effort. In some countries, the wearing of a headscarf by a woman can trigger a feeling of resentment or even fear, or an assumption that she is a fanatic. The next day the same woman may decide not to wear a headscarf, perhaps because she is going for an



interview, and people see her as a completely different person, maybe simply as kind-looking and attractive, because their perspective has undergone a change.

Mother Teresa said, "I see Jesus in every human being. I say to myself, this is hungry Jesus, I must feed him. This is sick Jesus. This one has leprosy or gangrene. I must wash him and tend to him. I serve because I love Jesus". It requires a mental effort of this kind to look for the positive in people rather than the negative. We could start by giving people the benefit of the doubt. We could see the cross woman in the shop as "the tired and fed-up Jesus", perhaps trapped in a loveless marriage to a weak person who gambles most of the household income. Or on coming across an aggressive driver, "this is the angry Jesus" maybe because her boss has just promoted a charming but very lazy subordinate over her head. Crucially, in respect of all those who inspire negative feelings in us, we should think, "there but for the grace of God go I". Jesus constantly told us not to count ourselves better than anyone else. Feelings are neither right nor wrong, it's how we act them out brings consequences.

Lightening the Load

The first thing we have to do is to notice that we've loaded down this camel with so much baggage






