


Good Shepherd Sunday & Vocations Sunday

The Good Shepherd

Today's gospel is for anyone who has ever felt unloved or insignificant. Today's gospel is for anyone who feels his or her life doesn't count for much.

At some time or another that probably means most of us.

In biblical days shepherding was

a highly dangerous business. Herds might consist of thousands of sheep, and shepherds had to be highly skilled in tending for the sheep and protecting them from wolves and robbers. The shepherd's care and courage were legendary. A good shepherd would not think twice about his own life in protecting his sheep. This is the image that Jesus chose for himself in today's gospel. He is the good shepherd. His leadership is a mixture of tenderness, strength and self sacrifice. Jesus loves us so much that he would lay down his life. That's a powerful belief to take out into the world!

But what if we don't quite believe it? Surely there are too many of us to love and look after individually. People fall by the wayside all the time. We hear tragic stories of elderly people who die alone and are not discovered for days because no one cares enough to visit. We see down and outs sleeping in subways because their family and friends have given up on them. Can God really be looking out for each and every one of us? Surely there are too many of us to look after - to love individually. Not so! Jesus we're told would not let even one of his sheep stray without coming to the rescue. He knows each and every one of us by name. If we are one of his, then he will recognise us and take care of us. That's another powerful belief to wake up with. The next time you are feeling lost and forgotten, try looking for the Good Shepherd's love in your life. God's help is always there when we look to him.


concisely. This is the



BULLAUN STONE KILLONE

Laois County Council to move to Church of the Assumption, the Heath.

Bullaun Stones were associated with early Christian Church sites within Ireland. Several theories for the function of Bullaun Stones included the following: holy water fonts, baptismal fonts, for crushing herbs for medicinal purposes, crushing grain, crushing furze for animal foodstuffs, or crushing metal for smelting. The natural rainwater that accumulates within the basins are believed to have several curative properties, which is often how they are used today.

The bullaun stone in Killone is currently located on a verge along the roadside approx. $1\frac{1}{2}$ km from the Church of the Assumption on the Heath. It is listed as a National Monument, which is legally protected. Recently representatives from the National Monuments Service and the National Museum visited the stone and have advised that it should be moved to the Church of the Assumption on the Heath.

Reasons for moving the bullaun stone:

- Its current location is certainly not its primary location as bullaun stones were associated with ecclesiastical sites and no ecclesiastical site is recorded in its current location. This means it was moved previously.
- . In its current exposed location it is at risk from being damaged by passing traffic.
- Moving the stone to a Church site is a more appropriate location for the bullaun stone and will allow safe access for all to the stone.



Taking Care of the Sheep

Do you know what a shepherd is? Of course you do. A shepherd is one who takes care of sheep. A shepherd uses a shepherd's crook. The crook is very useful to the shepherd in taking care of the sheep. Did you know that the word we use for the one who leads our church means the same thing as the word that is used for someone who takes care of sheep? So if Fr. John and Fr. Paddy and the priests of the parish are the one who takes care of the sheep, what do you think that makes us? Right! We are the sheep! It is the priest's job to take care of us just as it is the job of a shepherd to care for the sheep.

The priests in our parish doesn't use a shepherd's crook. The Bible is the priest's crook. When we stray away and go off on the wrong path, the priests uses the teaching of God's Word to reach out and gently pull us back and get us going in the right direction. The priests in our parish also uses the Bible to protect us from our enemies. When Satan attacks us and tries to get us to do things that would harm us, the priests uses the Bible to teach us what God wants us to do.

Fr. John, Fr. Paddy and the priests of the parish have a good guide to follow in knowing how to take care of the sheep. That guide is Jesus. Listen to what Jesus said about himself, "I am the good shepherd. I know my sheep and my sheep know me -- just as the Father knows me and I know the Father. I lay down my life for the sheep."



"I am the good shepherd. The good shepherd lays down his life for the sheep. I know my sheep and my sheep know me. I lay down my life for the sheep".





Time to Think! Finding God

We have become accustomed to bad news. Images on our screens of immense burden placed on vulnerable people. The horrendous conflict in the middle-East. Recent flooding in many parts of Asia, destroyed the crop harvest and left millions of farmers and families penniless. Did God cause the war in the Holy Land, famine or the flooding? Of course not. No one, still less God, would wish to inflict such suffering on people. If God did not cause them, did God perhaps permit them? Of course not. We live on a planet where physical, chemical and biological processes determine what happens. Nature, not God, produces some wonderful and awesome events, and some terrible tragedies. No one could, or should, believe in a God who would be responsible for, or even permit, such tragedies.

Some years ago, during a TV interview with the late Gay Byrne on RTÉ's "The Meaning of Life", Stephen Fry, a renowned atheist was asked what he would say to God on arrival at the pearly gates. He replied, 'I'll say, "Bone cancer in children? What's that about?" How dare you? How dare you create a world in which there is such misery that is not our fault? It's not right. It's utterly, utterly evil. Why should I respect a capricious, mean-minded, stupid God who creates a world which is so full of injustice and pain? That's what I'd say.' There are many people, like Stephen Fry, who lose their faith in God because of a mistaken understanding of God. Many believe that God is a person, though admittedly a super, super person - who thinks like us, makes decisions like us and is controlling everything that happens in our world. They pray for healing for a loved one who is dying of cancer, but they don't get healed, and wonder why God would allow the person to die if God could have saved them, or they conclude that God just doesn't care.

It is not God, but our false images of God that we need to get rid of. God is not a puppeteer who is pulling the strings on everything that happens in our world. God is three persons in one being. John's Gospel tells us that God is love, three persons madly in love with each other, and that their love has been shared with us human beings. Jesus prayed to the Father that 'the love, with which you loved me, may be in them, so that I may be in them' (Jn 17:26). And that divine love has been given to us so that we can share it with others and so witness to the presence of God in our world today. So where is God in the midst of war, violence and human suffering? God is not the cause of such devastation, but God is the response to the Challenges often by heroic resilient and courageous people. God is present in the love, kindness and caring of people for those who have suffered. Jesus, after the Resurrection, sent the Holy Spirit to his disciples. The Holy Spirit is now. Jesus, in his life, witnessed to the love of God by healing the sick, feeding the poor and eating with those who were rejected by his society.



Today, we, through the Holy Spirit acting in us, are called to witness to the love of God in the world. God's presence and action in our world, and in our hearts, inspiring us to love, to care and to share, and disturbing our conscience when we fail to do so. Jesus, in his life, witnessed to the love of God by healing the sick, feeding the poor and eating with those who were rejected by his society. Today, we, through the Holy Spirit acting in us, are called to witness to the love of God in the world. 'When the Paraclete (the Holy Spirit) comes, whom I shall send to you from the Father, he will be my witness' (Jn 15:26).

As the beautiful poem, attributed to St. Teresa of Avila, says: 'Christ has no body now but yours, no hands, no feet on earth but yours, yours are the eyes with which he looks compassion on this world. Yours are the hands, yours are the feet, yours are the eyes, you are his body.' What is the 'Good News to the poor' (Lk 4:18) that Jesus announced? It is you and I. And if we are not the good news to the poor today, then today the poor have no good news.

Pope Francis Prayer for Peace

Lord, God of Abraham, God of the Prophets, God of Love, you created us and you call us to live as brothers and sisters. Give us the strength daily to be instruments of peace; enable us to see everyone who crosses our path as our brother or sister. Make us sensitive to the plea of our citizens who entreat us to turn our weapons of war into implements of peace, our trepidation into confident trust, and our quarrelling into forgiveness. Keep alive within us the flame of hope, so that with patience and perseverance we may opt for dialogue and reconciliation. In this way may peace triumph at last, and may the words "division", "hatred" and "war" be banished from the heart of every man and woman. Lord, defuse the violence of our tongues and our hands. Renew our hearts and minds, so that the word which always brings us together will be "brother", and our way of life will always be that of: Shalom, Peace, Salaam! Amen.


