

St. Oliver Plunkett 1st July

Oliver Plunkett, from an Irish nobility whose family supported King Charles I. Ordained in Rome in 1654 he became a professor of theology from 1654 until appointed Archbishop of Armagh in 1669. He



ministered in Armagh, through forced to work in a convert way during the suppression of priests. He was arrested and tried at Dundalk in 1679 for conspiring against the state. It was seen that Oliver would never be convicted in Ireland, and he was moved to Newgate prison, London. He was found guilty of high treason 'for promoting the Catholic faith', and was condemned to a gruesome death. He was hanged, drawn and quartered on 1July 1681 at Tyburn, in London. He was the last Catholic to die for his faith at Tyburn, and the first of the Irish martyrs to be beatified in 1920. He wad canonised by Pope Paul VI on 12 October 1975. He is buried at Downside Abbey, England; his head is venerated in St. Peter's Church, Drogheda.

There Is Power in a Touch

As you probably know, we have five senses. We use these five senses to give us information about the world around us. For example, if I were to hold up a ball and ask you what it was, you would identify it by using your sense of sight. If I were to ring a bell and ask you what it was, you would identify it was by using your sense of hearing. If I put a flower under your nose and ask you to tell me what it was, you would know what it was by its smell. If I gave you a sip of lemonade, you would know right away what it was because of its taste.



There is one of the five senses that I have not mentioned. Do you know what it is? It is the sense of touch.

The sense of touch is very important, isn't it? We can often tell what an object is by its size, shape, and texture -- all of which can be learned by using our sense of touch. This morning I want to tell you about a woman who experienced the power of Jesus -- just by touching him.

One day Jesus was walking through a large crowd of people. The people were crowding around so that he could hardly move. There was a woman in the crowd who had a very bad sore that had been bleeding for twelve years. She had been to many doctors, but none had been able to help her. She had heard about Jesus and she believed that he could heal her, but there were so many who were people crowded around him that it seemed hopeless.

The woman thought to herself, "If I could just get close enough to touch his robe, I would be healed." So she pushed through the crowd and reached out and touched Jesus' clothes. Her bleeding stopped immediately and her suffering was ended.

The Gospel tells us that as soon as the woman touched him, Jesus felt the power go out of him. He turned to the woman and said, "Your faith has healed you. Go in peace and be free from your suffering."

Won't you reach out to Jesus today? If you will, you too can feel his power in your life today.

There's Power in a Touch



Time to Think! A Fiery Sermon

As we begin the month of July, I pray in the brightness of summer all our families will be blessed with health of body and peace of mind. July traditionally is also a month when many take the opportunity for rest and renewal. I think especially of our school communities taking their well-deserved summer holidays and pray protection and safety on the journeys we may take.

One of the huge challenges in a contemporary culture is how to connect with one another and build our sense of community. In an age of instant social media, it is no substitute for the personal encounter. A recent psychological study on well-being placed huge emphasis on the benefits of gathering together including attending Church services. Since the dreadful COVID pandemic, there has been a noticeable absence of many good people who now have become accustomed to engaging with local Parish via the webcam exclusively. Whilst the webcam in our local Parish is a very useful vehicle to communicate, it is no substitute for the physical connection that is gathering around the table of the Lord. I think of the following story because it is very relevant to our present context.

"A member of a Catholic Parish, who previously had attended daily Mass, suddenly stopped going, not only on weekdays, but on Sundays also. The Parish Priest noticed this and was worried about it. He decided to pay the man a visit but felt unsure about what to do or say. He was conscious of the need to respect the man's freedom, but conscious also that he should be there to help him if he needed it. After a few weeks, on a cold winter's evening, the priest visited him. He found the man alone at home and was welcomed by him into the warmth of the house. The man led him to a comfortable chair near the fireplace, where a blazing coal fire was burning, and waited.

The priest sat down and made himself at home but said nothing about the man's absence from Mass. The two men chatted about ordinary day-to-day affairs, a simple conversation about the news and topics of the day. From time to time, they became silent, their attention drawn to the dance of the flames around the burning coals. After a while, the priest took the tongs, carefully picked a burning coal from the fire and placed it to one side of the hearth all alone. Then he sat back in the chair in silence. His host watched this quietly. As the lone coal flickered and diminished, there was a reduced glow for some time, and then its fire was no more. It had become cold and dead. Not a word had been spoken about the question that was on both men's minds.




After some further conversation, the priest picked up the dead coal and put it back in the middle of the fire. Soon it began to glow once more with the heat of the burning coals around it. It burned brightly, giving light as well as warmth. Then the priest glanced at his watch and said it was time for him to leave. He stood up to go. As he reached the front door of the house, his host, with a smile on his face, said, 'Thanks for your visit, and especially for the fiery sermon. I'll be back at Mass next Sunday'."

We live in a society that is increasingly individualised and atomised. More people live lives that are fragmented and lonely. Some live in "secure" apartment blocks accessible only by cards or codes. They seem like prisons. It's not a healthy way to be. The lone ranger is a poor role model for humanity. We need each other. It takes courage, and sometimes imagination, to break out of the limits, sometimes self-imposed, that keep us in isolation. But it's worth the effort, and necessary if we are to be the human beings that God calls us to be.

"Come Summer With Me" Come summer with me, Lord; Summer deep down in my soul; Restore my faith in summer's time, In rest, in joy, in play, in you... Summer in my heart, Lord, and dwell there As if time would never end, As if all time were children's time, eternal time When school is always out and joy is ever in... 



Presentation Sisters in Portlaoise celebrate 200 years

The Presentation Sisters are in Portlaoise since 1824. On July 3rd of that year, three sisters arrived from Carlow to set up house and school in Maryborough (as was the town's name then). They were sent by Bishop James Doyle (JKL) "to promote religious instruction and provide education for the poor of the town". Sisters Magdalen Breen, Angela Mooney and Chantal Wilmerding were the chosen three.

The Penal Laws prevented Catholics from receiving education or professing their religion. Nano Nagle had set up her Congregation in Cork in 1775 to overcome these problems. Gradually, schools and convents were established by the Presentation Sisters in many towns throughout the country. Carlow was founded in 1811 by the three sisters from Kilkenny. Later, with help from

Portlaoise, Kildare Convent was established in 1829. The Penal Laws were repealed in that year. By August 15th, 1824, there were 216 children in the school. The children were poor and the Sisters were poor. But, the people valued education and many sacrifices were made so that all children would have access to education. The original school-rooms were in a disused building and in coal-cellars of the church. Gradually, with generous donations from friends, families and some funding from the Government, the buildings and work of education progressed rapidly. Skilful management of funds and accounts enabled development through the years. Through famine times and onwards breakfasts were provided for the children. All of these schools were set up after the pattern of Nano Nagle's schools in Cork.

The foundation stone was laid for the new convent in Portlaoise in 1873.

What has happened in 200 years? Sacred Heart School opened in 1932, Scoil Mhuire in 1955 and

Scoil Chriost Rí in 1969. In 2016 Sacred Heart, Scoil Mhuire and St. Paul's amalgamated and are now called Holy Family Schools. All of the schools in the parish are now in State of the art new buildings. Today, we have approximately 5,000 children attending schools in our parish.

Boards of Management now take responsibility for the administration of all the schools. Since the foundation of the convent in Church Street, Sisters have also

lived in Tower Hill, O'Moore Place, Beechfield, Knockmay and in Ashbrook Gardens.

Today, we celebrate the journey of the Presentation Sisters throughout 200 years with the people of Portlaoise and surrounding areas.

Mass of celebration will take place in the Parish Church at 10am on Wednesday (July 3rd). All are welcome.
