

How Not to Impress God!

It's easy to be fooled. Mr and Mrs Devout are always in church, always to be seen praying, always lighting votives, always to

be found kneeling in their favourite pew. Are Mr and Mrs Devout good people? Well very possibly, but outward appearances can be deceptive. Perhaps Mr and Mrs Devout are the salt of the earth, but not necessarily. Despite their Sunday best, perhaps Mr and Mrs Devout spend the rest of the week, complaining about the refugees next door, gossiping about other parishioners and ignoring the plight of the beggar sitting on the church doorstop. Outward appearances are no indication of what lies beneath.

Today the Pharisees complain to Jesus, that his disciples do not wash their hands before eating. Their complaint does not stem from food hygiene. The Pharisees had very many rituals intended to keep themselves pure and undefiled, and one of these rituals was washing before eating. The ritual in itself is not so very wrong. We ourselves have a ritual of saying 'grace before meals', but where Jesus finds fault is in their flawed grasp of what is important. Jesus uses their complaint to teach a lesson, and the lesson isn't really anything to do with washing.

What do we think pleases God? The Pharisees were not bad people, but they had strayed a long way from pleasing God. To the Pharisees, religion was all about abiding by hundreds of rules and regulations. Many of these rules were about keeping themselves segregated from anything in the world that would make them unclean. They had become so obsessed by this that they no longer engaged well with the world and all its suffering. They lived by lofty and judgmental ideals that Jesus totally rejected. Jesus didn't deliberately set out to disregard tradition, but at the same time, he had come to engage with the world and its needs. Jesus' main concern was for the poor the sick and the marginalised, and he went out of his way to associate himself with them. He saw the Pharisees placing barriers between man and God, and he wasn't having it!

We do not become unacceptable to God by failing to follow a set of outward rules. We become unacceptable to God when our hearts become cold. God is not impressed when we turn up for Mass in our Sunday best. God is best pleased when we show the world a loving and sincere heart.

Clean Hands — Clean Heart

I remember times when I was a child that my mother would call out, "Dinner is ready!" and we would all gather at the dinner table. Many times I had been outside playing and my hands were quite dirty. As I sat down at my place at the dinner table, my mother would almost always ask, "Did you wash your hands?" I must confess that sometimes I would answer,



"Yes" when the truth of the matter was that I had come straight to the dinner table without washing my hands.

Do you always wash your hands before you eat? Clean hands are one of the most important ways to help us stay healthy. Even when our hands look clean, they have germs on them that can make us sick. It is a good idea to use soap or a hand sanitizer to make sure we get rid of those germs you can't see. It is important to have clean hands before we eat, isn't it?

One day a group of Pharisees noticed that some of Jesus's disciples were eating without first washing their hands. They asked Jesus, "Why don't your disciples follow our tradition? They eat without first following our hand-washing ceremony." Jesus responded to the people who questioned him, but his answer was not what they wanted to hear.

Jesus knew the hearts of the people who were complaining about his disciples' unwashed hands. He answered them by saying, "You hypocrites! You are the people the prophet Isaiah wrote about when he said, 'You ignore God's law and substitute your own tradition.'"

Jesus wasn't saying that washing our hands is not important. He was saying that the Pharisees thought that clean hands were more important than a clean heart. They were more concerned with following the traditions of men than they were with following the Word of God.

Jesus called the crowd to gather around and listen to what he had to say. "All of you listen. It's not what goes into your body that makes you unclean, it is the bad words that come out of your mouth. Out of your hearts come evil thoughts, greed, cheating, and envy. This is what makes you unclean."





RELIC OF CARLO ACUTIS TO VISIT OUR PARISH CHURCH

Who is Carlo Acutis? Born in London on 3rd May 1991. He died in Monza, near Milan on October 12th 2006. Only years of age. But he is soon to be the first Millenium Saint. What could so easily be a sad, incomprehensible depressing story of a good young man taken from his family and friends at such a young age has become a story of hope for so many around the World. Carlo said 'I am happy to die because I have lived my life without wasting even a minute of it doing things that wouldn't have pleased God. He also said that 'our aim has to be the infinite and not the finite'

Carlo was the son of Italian parents, Andrea Acutis and Antonio Salzano, living in London at the time of his birth. They moved back to near Milan while Carlo was an infant. During his lifetime Carlo remained an only child. Precisely 4 years to the day after his death, his mother, then aged 44, gave birth to twins, Michele and Francesca. She attributes this event to her son's intercession. Carlo's parents weren't particularly religious. Both had been baptised and confirmed and were married in the Church but did not regularly practice. Carlo's interest in the faith and his constant questions but also his witness to an extraordinary relationship with Jesus and his devotion to Mary brought both his parents to a new awakening of faith themselves.

From a young age Carlo had an extraordinary devotion to Our Lady and the Eucharist. A gifted student with a particular talent around computers and computer programming. He developed a website which catalogued Eucharistic miracles and was the genesis of *The Eucharistic Miracles of the World*, an international exhibition which highlights such occurrences. On 1st October 2006 this pious young man developed an inflammation of the throat by Sunday 8th October he was too weak to get out of bed and was diagnosed with a very aggressive Leukemia. He died on 12th October.

The relic of Carlo which comes to our parish church on Wednesday 11th September will be accompanied by three Friars from Assisi where Carlo's body lies. We look forward to a programme of events in association with the visit which will involve young and old in prayer and contemplation of this extraordinary soon to be Saint.


