Thought Word and Deed

Jesus is the 'Good Shepherd' and we are his flock or are we? It's easy to call ourselves Catholics or Christians, but unless we act like it we are only Catholics in name. How can we call Jesus our shepherd or our role model yet not model our behaviour after the most basic of church teachings? How can we be a part of Jesus' flock if we condone violence, ignore poverty or harbour un-Christian attitudes? To be truly part of Jesus' flock we have to be Christians not just in name, but in thought word and deed.

Today Jesus tells us how to live our lives. "My sheep hear my voice; I know them, and they follow me." Hearing Jesus' voice and following him is no easy task. Jesus asks us to follow him in many individual ways. Imagine how sad it would be to meet Jesus on Judgment Day, to hear him say, "Didn't you hear me? I was inviting you to travel the world, open a nursing home, research a new drug, become a campaign leader, make a film, write a book, adopt a child, raise funds for a well in a third world country or become a missionary. Weren't you listening?" How would we reply? "Well.... I thought I was listening... but perhaps I was spending too much time watching TV or following Facebook!"

Deciding to follow Jesus might take some radical thinking and a good deal of courage, but for those who make that decision, Jesus promises "... I give them eternal life, and they shall never perish. No one can take them out of my hand."



Taking Care of the Sheep

Do you know what a shepherd is? Of course you do. A shepherd is one who takes care of sheep. A shepherd uses a shepherd's crook. The crook is very useful to the shepherd in taking care of the sheep. If the sheep tries to go in the wrong direction, the shepherd can reach out with the crook and gently pull it back onto the right path. The shepherd also uses the crook to help protect the sheep from a wolf or some other wild animal that might try to harm them. You see, it is the

shepherd's responsibility to care for and protect the sheep.

How many of you know who the priests of the parish are? We have 5 priests in Portlaoise parish. Fr. John Byrne, Fr. Ciprian Matei, Fr. Adriano Oliveira, Fr. Simon Jin and Fr. Eric Ebot.

In Abbeyleix, Raheen and Ballinakill we have Fr. Paddy Byrne, Fr. Sean Conlon and Fr. Petru Medves. The Parish priest of Portlaoise Parish is Fr. John Byrne and for Abbeyleix, Raheen and Ballinakill is Fr. Paddy Byrne. Did you know that the word we use for the one who leads our church means the same thing as the word that is used for someone who takes care of sheep? So if Fr. John and Fr. Paddy and the priests of the parish are the one who takes care of the sheep, what do you think that makes us? Right! We are the sheep! It is the priest's job to take care of us just as it is the job of a shepherd to care for the sheep.

The priests in our parish doesn't use a shepherd's crook. The Bible is the priest's crook. When we stray away and go off on the wrong path, the priests uses the teaching of God's Word to reach out and gently pull us back and get us going in the right direction. The priests in our parish also uses the Bible to protect us from our enemies. When Satan attacks us and tries to get us to do things that would harm us, the priests uses the Bible to teach us what God wants us to do.

Fr. John, Fr. Paddy and the priests of the parish have a good guide to follow in knowing how to take care of the sheep. That guide is Jesus. Listen to what Jesus said about himself, "I am the good shepherd. I know my sheep and my sheep know me -- just as the Father knows me and I know the Father. I lay down my life for the sheep."

The Bible also says, "The LORD is my shepherd," but God has also called the priests of our parish to help him in caring for his sheep. We are thankful for Jesus, "the Good Shepherd," and we are thankful for Fr. John and Fr. Paddy and the priests of the parish too!

Time to Think! Parkness into Light 2025



As I write this article, the cardinal electors, are currently in conclave. Their task, to select the 267th successor of Peter. I pray that the spirit of discernment and peace, will descend upon them and their choice will reflect the heart of Jesus. This weeks early morning walk celebrating "Darkness into light" has an important message to all our lives. Whilst "Darkness into light" raises significant funding towards those seeking healing regarding mental health, it is also suggests that light brings hope and healing. The Christian story, is a celebration of how our God blesses us with resilience, courage and hope, even in times of challenge. As we move through the month of May, nature responds magnificently to the blessing of light and warmth. The dawn chorus, these days, sings a beautiful hymn, proclaiming that indeed God's light, is brighter than any darkness God's hope, is greater than any despair. These days we celebrate in the liturgical calendar Jesus Resurrection and soon Ascension into heaven. Resurrection and Ascension essentially celebrate returning home, to where all of us, are invited to feel a deep sense of belonging and inclusion.

Recent research shows that levels of mental illness, anxiety, and depression are at an all-time high, especially among younger people. I recently came across these Ten Tips for keeping balance and good Mental Health.

- 1. Life is tough and feelings can be the toughest things of all. Learn to befriend them, understand them and realise that you are much more than your feelings. Everything in life passes savour the good and let go of the bad. Feelings come and go. Learn to watch them like clouds coming into your life, and remember just as you can't hold onto a cloud, your job is to let your feelings go too. A simple meditation on this is: stop, find a quiet place, even pretend to be listening on headphones. Ask yourself how you feel. Notice that there is a small gap between you and your feelings. Stay with that gap. In it, all is quiet and empty full of possibilities. Rest in this gap for a few minutes each day. Train yourself to watch your feelings come and go, like clouds do, no matter how strong they are. This will help you when you hit a crisis and may even save your life.
- 2. Technology is a gift for communication with others but it is a terrible boss; learn to switch off and enjoy off line activities that build you up: hike a hill, learn a skill, take a risk, talk to someone face to face. TV, games, videos and Internet are not the real world, but they pretend to be friends. Use them as the gift they can be and take control of them. Otherwise you are a slave and it's a cruel master.
- 3. "If it feels good do it" can sound great but it can bring you to some dark places. Everyone has hidden strength and the ability to put off immediate pleasures. Find that steel inside yourself that allows you to go outside your comfort zone, build bridges and reach out to others. The irony is that when we reach out to help and include others, we're also taking care of ourselves.
- 4. You have something unique within you. You are a one-off gift to the world. And that gift is for you to give away, not to hide away. The greatest happiness is found in truly being yourself and helping others; it can be challenging at first but there is a slow burn feel-good factor that lasts for a long time.
- 5. You are not responsible for all the ills of the world. Trying to save the world can be overwhelming. Trying to solve all of your own and everyone else's problems all at one go would be equally overwhelming. If you get into that way of being, it's time to stop. Press pause. Get some space and remember that you just have to do your bit. There is some small thing that you can do in almost every situation you face. It is like building a jigsaw. You will have a piece to contribute. It will be uniquely you, and which will help. Build it one piece at a time.

6. Anxiety and fear are not good reasons to do things. In fact, most of the time, decisions made out of anxiety and fear are not good long-term decisions. Anxiety and fear often keep us locked in a narrow room with narrow options that see the worst in others and ourselves. Imagine what it would be like to trust in the world and people, and to act without fear (not without caution though). There is a middle road to be walked that is manageable and achievable.

7. Idealism is a great thing but set the bar too high and nothing or no one can measure up. The perfect is the enemy of the good; work out what the good thing to do is and just do it. A cluttered life doesn't give you a chance to see what's going on. And when we don't see what's going on we can be fooled into thinking that things are terrible, even when they are not.

8. Travel light; have a de-clutter. Start by clearing out your room of things that you don't need. You are a traveller through life and you have to travel light, otherwise you will get weighed down by things and come to be chained to them. Remember that people are not things to be acquired and disposed according to your feelings. Take this de-clutter as a chance to evaluate what is really going in and what is really valuable to you.

9. Accept the things you cannot change and change the things you can (and know the difference). Don't waste your time trying to change things that are given: your family, face, body, friends, locality. There is some rare beauty in them that can only be seen in a certain light. Find it and encourage it. If it won't be encouraged, know that you've done your best and can be content with that.

10. Happiness is an inside job – you know instinctively that having things and comparing yourself to others is empty and futile, and yet we all get caught up in it. Take a moment in the quiet. Go back to that gap you found in the meditation above; that gap between you and your feelings. In the gap, imagine a bright white light. See the light as a good thing, bright and warming. Now realise that this light is the goodness, brightness and warmth you have at the core of you. You are good and bright and warm inside. Dwell in this light for as long as you like. Find happiness in these thoughts
