## What a different world 1965 was.

No mobile phones, no internet, no James Fintan Lalor Avenue—and certainly no sign of a motorway! Every vehicle heading from the south or southwest of Ireland to Dublin had to pass through Portlaoise's Main Street. And from 1965, they encountered a striking new sight at its end: the Parish Church of St. Peter & Paul.

"We will build you a splendid and beautiful Church," the architects promised Fr. Tom Browne. That promise was shared by a dedicated parish community who had been fundraising and preparing for over two decades. The Church was designed to be more than impressive—it was to be expressive: a sacred space shaped by its site, structure, and materials. A true *teach an phobail*—a house of the people.

Sixty years on, the world has changed, but the Church still stands—strong in body, spirit, and community. It has been a place of prayer and celebration, of sacraments and solace. More than a building, it is a beacon of faith.

We remember with gratitude those who made it possible. Many have gone to their eternal reward—may they rest in peace. Others are still with us, still praying in the Church they helped to build in 1965 and renew in 2008. It was opened without debt—a remarkable achievement made possible by local generosity.

Week by week, thousands come through its doors—for Mass, for quiet prayer, to light a candle, or to join in Adoration. Many more connect via radio, webcam, or Shalom World TV. It remains a vibrant place of worship, faithful to its founding purpose.

As we celebrate this Diamond Jubilee, we offer heartfelt thanks for the support we receive in parish life. Over 500 parishioners are actively involved in ministry, service, and leadership—a true sign of a living Church. We are especially grateful to our staff, sacristans, and Parish Centre team for their daily dedication.

Through the prayers of Saints Peter and Paul, may our parish continue to grow in faith, love, and community.

## **Harvest Time**



## Time to Think... Enjoy Your Coffee...



It was disappointing to read that tourists visiting our beautiful island has greatly reduced in recent times. Ireland has benefited hugely from tourism, especially many of the service industries. Ireland is now deemed the second most expensive country to live in Europe. The cost of living no doubt is prohibiting people from visiting our country. These July days are an opportunity to take rest and enjoy despite the many challenges. The following story reminds me of hope!

A group of alumni, highly established in their careers, got together to visit their old university professor. Conversation soon turned into complaints about stress in work and life. Offering his guests coffee, the professor went to the kitchen and returned with a large pot of coffee and an assortment of cups - porcelain, plastic, glass, crystal, some plain looking, some expensive, some exquisite -- telling them to help themselves to the coffee.

When all the students had a cup of coffee in hand, the professor said: "If you noticed, all the nice-looking expensive cups were taken up, leaving behind the plain and cheap ones. While it is normal for you to want only the best for yourselves, that is the source of your problems and stress. Be assured that the cup itself adds no quality to the coffee. In most cases it is just more expensive and, in some cases, even hides what we drink. What all of you really wanted was coffee, not the cup, but you consciously went for the best cups... And then you began eyeing each other's cups."

"Now consider this," he continued... "Life is the coffee. The jobs, money and position in society are the cups. They are just tools to hold and contain life, and the type of cup we have does not define, nor change the quality of life we live. Sometimes, by concentrating only on the cup, we fail to enjoy the coffee God has provided us."

God brews the coffee, not the cups... Enjoy your coffee!

George Carlin was a brilliant comedian and wordsmith. He was fully present as he observed the human condition. His commentary on life is both honest and deeply reflective. A spirituality that brings light and pragmatism to where experience has become stale and cynical. The flowing is part of an observation of contemporary culture that remains very appropriate for us all to reflect upon.

#### A Message by George Carlin:

The paradox of our time in history is that we have taller buildings but shorter tempers, wider freeways, but narrower viewpoints. We spend more, but have less, we buy more but enjoy less. We have bigger houses and smaller families, more conveniences, but less time. We have more degrees but less sense, more knowledge, but less judgment, more experts, yet more problems, more medicine, but less wellness.

We drink too much, smoke too much, spend too recklessly, laugh too little, drive too fast, get too angry, stay up too late, get up too tired, read too little, watch TV too much, and pray too seldom. We have multiplied our possessions but reduced our values. We talk too much, love too seldom, and hate too often.

We've learned how to make a living, but not a life. We've added years to life not life to years. We've been all the way to the moon and back but have trouble crossing the street to meet a new neighbour. We conquered outer space but not inner space. We've done larger things, but not better things.

We've cleaned up the air but polluted the soul. We've conquered the atom, but not our prejudice. We write more but learn less. We plan more but accomplish less. We've learned to rush, but not to wait. We build more computers to hold more information, to produce more copies than ever, but we communicate less and less.

These are the times of fast foods and slow digestion, big men and small character, steep profits and shallow relationships. These are the days of two incomes but more divorce, fancier houses, but broken homes. These are days of quick trips, disposable diapers, throwaway morality, one-night stands, overweight bodies, and pills that do everything from cheer, to quiet, to kill. It is a time when there is much in the showroom window and nothing in the stockroom. A time when technology can bring this letter to you, and a time when you can choose either to share this insight, or to just hit delete...

Remember; spend some time with your loved ones, because they are not going to be around forever.

Remember, say a kind word to someone who looks up to you in awe, because that little person soon will grow up and leave your side.


Remember, to give a warm hug to the one next to you, because that is the only treasure you can give with your heart, and it doesn't cost a cent.

Remember, to say, "I love you" to your partner and your loved ones, but most of all mean it. A kiss and an embrace will mend hurt when it comes from deep inside of you.


