Saints Carlo and Pier Pray for us





Calculating the

We hear a lot about calculating the cost of discipleship, but how many people actually sit down and do exactly that calculate the cost.

We certainly do our calculations if we're paying a visit to the bank manager for a loan. We certainly start calculating if we're down to small

change and there are two long weeks left to pay day. Today Jesus tells us that calculating the cost of discipleship should be no different. "For which of you intending to build a tower, does not first sit down and estimate the cost, to see whether he has enough to complete it?"

Discipleship means different things to do different people at different stages in their lives. Discipleship might mean deciding how best to use our gifts to help people at home and in the work place. Discipleship might mean coming up with a plan to transform a local community or some kind of global project. Whatever our vision we will need to sit down and plan it. Inevitably this will involve personal cost and if we don't calculate that cost, we are setting ourselves up to fail before we have begun. Will we be able to accomplish our plans alone or will we need help? How will we make time to achieve our goals and will this involve an element of sacrifice? Do we have enough money to realise our ideas or will we need to fundraise? Do we have the necessary skills or will we have to step out of our comfort zones in order to learn something new? In today's gospel Jesus says, "Whoever does not carry the cross and follow me cannot be my disciple." Discipleship is demanding. Jesus is looking for a full-time commitment. Discipleship is not something that can be slotted easily and comfortable into our existing life styles. Discipleship involves cost, and today's invitation is to sit down and calculate whether that cost is within our means.





Counting the Cost

How many of you would like to play the piano? Before you answer that you would like to play the piano, let's see what it would cost to be able to play the piano and see if you are willing to pay the price.

First of all, you would have to buy a piano. It would be rather silly to say that you wanted to play the piano if you weren't willing to go out and buy a piano, wouldn't it? So the first you would need to do is look for a piano. A second hand piano could cost approx. €700. Hmm....€700, do you still want to play the piano?

Next you need to find a teacher. After all, you can't teach yourself. Not if you really want to play well. For a lesson it could cost around €25 per lesson. Let's see, if you have a lesson every week that's €100 a month, do you still want to play the piano?



What else do we need? Oh yes, we will need some music! I went to the music store and found out that most of the music books cost €10-€15 each. If you want to buy a single copy of sheet music, they usually cost around €5 each. Do you still want to play the piano?

Now that you have a piano, a teacher, and some music you must be willing to practice. Most piano teachers require their students to practice at least one hour every day. That means that there will be times when other children will be out playing while you must stay in and practice. Do you still want to play the piano? If you want to play the piano, you have to count the cost and make sure you are willing to pay the price!

Did you know that Jesus said that same thing to some people who said they wanted to be his disciples? Jesus told them that if they wanted to follow him, they had to count the cost. He said they had to be willing to take up their cross daily and follow him. To follow him, they might have to be willing to give up their family and friends. Jesus also said that people might make fun of them and call them names and that some people might even want to hurt them. They had to count the cost and make sure they were willing to pay the price.

A lot of people today say that they want to follow Jesus. They join the church and for a while you will see them every week, but when they find out how much it is going to cost, they fall away. Being a true follower of Jesus is not always easy, but it is always worth it, if you are willing to pay the price.



The Story of Carlo, the Boy Who Loved God

Once upon a time, in Italy, there lived a boy named Carlo. He loved football, video games, and computers—just like many other kids. But there was something very special about him: Carlo loved Jesus more than anything else. Every day, Carlo went to Mass, prayed, and tried to help people who were sad or lonely. He even used his computer skills to make a big website about miracles, so that everyone could learn how amazing the Eucharist is. When Carlo was 15 years old, he became very sick. Even though he was in pain, he said, "I'm happy, because I know I'm close to God." Not long after, Carlo went to heaven.

People who knew him remembered how kind, joyful, and faithful he was. They started to pray to him for help — and miracles happened!

The Church saw that Carlo's life was full of love and goodness, so they began the steps to make him a saint. Soon, the Pope will say: "Carlo is a saint in heaven, and we can all look up to him!"

And so, Carlo shows us that even ordinary kids can do extraordinary things when they love God with all their hearts.





"Always to be united with Jesus, this is my programme of life".

"Not I, But God".

"Why do people worry so much about the beauty of their own body and not the beauty of their soul?"

"The more we receive the Eucharist, the more we will become like Jesus so that on this Earth we will have a foretaste of Heaven".

"What does it matter if you win a thousand battles if you cannot win over your own corrupt passions?"

"Our Lady is the Only Woman in my Life".

"Everything passes away, what alone will make us truly beautiful in God's eyes is the way that we loved him and our brothers".

"No one escapes the cross. There are others suffering much more than me".

"You too can become a saint. You just have to want it with all your heart"

What's the story on Bl. Carlo Acutis?

"All people are born as originals but many die as photocopies"

Carlo Acutis was born on the 3rd May 1991 in London to parents Antonia and Andrea Acutis. He moved to Italy shortly after his birth and grew up in Milan. His parents were wealthy business people who owned an insurance company. They were not religious.

Carlo was an extremely good natured kid growing up and as a young child, he would often ask his parents deep questions they couldn't answer. He also loved to go into churches to say hello to Jesus and Mary and would often ask his parents to bring him. He started to get his parents to question the meaning behind their lives and slowly he brought them back to their faith again.

Carlo was very ordinary growing up. He loved football, playing music and video games although he would only limit himself to one hour of video games every week because he felt they were so addictive! His friends describe him as a normal guy who wasn't perfect but stood out because of his positive outlook and his good example in everyday life, often helping the bullied, the disabled, the homeless, the migrants.

Carlo had a great love for God and aimed to stay close to Jesus and Mary in his life. He loved to pray and attend mass and he really believed in the power of the Eucharist. Carlo couldn't understand why so many people would attend pop concerts but then never go to churches to see the creator of the universe. Because of this, he made a website documenting Eucharistic miracles around the world.

Carlo always believed he would die young and he tried to live life to the full and not waste it. When he was 15 he fell ill with galloping leukemia and died within the week. Although he was in great pain, he told the doctors "there are others who suffer more than me". After his death, two miracles were approved by the church and contributed to his name.



Pier Giorgio Frassati "The Man of the Beatitudes"

On the same day as Carlo Acutis' canonisation, another young saint will be raised to the altars – Pier Giorgio Frassati (1901–1925).


Born into a prominent Italian family, Pier Giorgio lived a life full of energy, Laughter, and faith. He loved the outdoors - mountain climbing, skiing and hiking - and often signed his letters with the phrase 'Verso l'Alto' ("to the heights"), reminding friends that holiness was the ultimate summit.

Pier giorgio's faith was practical: he joined catholic action, defended the faith publicly, and quietly served the poor of turin, visiting them with food, medicine and encouragement. Even as a university student, he dreamed of working as a mining engineer so he could improve the lives of miners and their families.

He died suddenly at just 24, having contracted polio – most likely from one of the people he cared for his funeral astonished his family: Thousands of the poor he had helped lined the streets to honour him. Pope John Paul II, who beatified him in 1990, called him "the man of the eight beatitudes."

Together with Carlo Acutis, Pier Giorgio Frassati shows us that s ainthood is not remote or impossible - it is a joyful, practical way of life open to every generation.

Time to Think... The Art of Letting Go



September brings a rich feast for our senses. Autumnal colours are very beautiful. In many ways autumn is a season of letting go. Harvest has been gathered; fruit has ripened and leaves now tired fall to the earth. There is something spiritual in God's creation that is very palpable in the month of September.

The Art of Letting Go is about deciding to stop making the same mistakes and choosing to take a different path. It has been said that insanity is doing the same thing over and over and expecting a different result. I totally agree. When we hold onto things that weigh us down, that negativity turns into baggage. The more baggage you have, the more it clouds your view and the more you feel like carrying that baggage around is the only way to live. Your baggage-cluttered perspective becomes the viewpoint from which you see the world.

But how can you have a positive outlook when all you see is negativity? The truth is you can't.

That is precisely why you must learn what to hold onto and what to let go of. When that happens, your momentum increases, you feel lighter and, most of all, you know your worth. In life, we are all going through the growing pains of becoming the person we want to be. For some people, the pain is too much, and they give up. Instead of moving forward, they decide to stay stagnate and hold onto the very things that keep you down. In life we will have to let go of things, people and situations; when we understand and embrace the process, we allow ourselves to be abundant within. And when we are abundant within, the abundance spills into the other parts of our lives, families, relationships, careers and finances.

I know letting go is painful and scary, but if you don't let go, you miss out on the life you always wanted, the life you deserve. This is the process of breaking up with the old in search of the new. You are not doing this out of selfishness, but because you can acknowledge that the old no longer is the right place for you

A psychology professor walked around on a stage while teaching stress management principles to an auditorium filled with students. As she raised a glass of water, everyone expected they'd be asked the typical "glass half empty or glass half full" question. Instead, with a smile on her face, the professor asked, "How heavy is this glass of water I'm holding?" Students shouted out answers ranging from eight ounces to a couple pounds. She replied, "From my perspective, the absolute weight of this glass doesn't matter. It all depends on how long I hold it. If I hold it for a minute or two, it's fairly light. If I hold it for an hour straight, its weight might make my arm ache a little. If I hold it for a day straight, my arm will likely cramp up and feel completely numb and paralyzed, forcing me to drop the glass to the floor. In each case, the weight of the glass doesn't change, but the longer I hold it, the heavier it feels to me."

As the class shook their heads in agreement, she continued, "Your stresses and worries in life are very much like this glass of water. Think about them for a while and nothing happens. Think about them a bit longer and you begin to ache a little. Think about them all day long, and you will feel completely numb and

paralysed – incapable of doing anything else until you drop them." It's important to remember to let go of your stresses and worries. No matter what happens during the day, as early in the evening as you can, put all your burdens down. Don't carry them through the night and into the next day with you.

If you still feel the weight of yesterday's stress, it's a strong sign that it's time to put the glass down.


