In Jesus' day, when visitors came to the Temple they were able to purchase animals or doves to offer as sacrifices. Because the Jews considered Roman coinage bearing Caesar's head as idolatrous, the thev were given opportunity to exchange their Roman for Temple coins

coinage. The idea was originally a good one, but the moneylenders were operating an unfair exchange rate for overpriced animals. What had started out as a good idea had turned into an abuse. and this in God's name! Was it any wonder that Jesus was so angry, angry enough to take a whip and drive out the traders!

It might occur to us that this story is a lesson on not bringing money matters into our churches. We might cast an anxious eye at our collections or fund raising lotto and feel some discomfort. But the point of the story isn't really about buildings or money. Jesus is making a connection between purity and worship. How could those in the temple really have worshipped amongst so much corruption? Today we are invited to look at ourselves as temples. Do we need a spiritual spring clean before we can truly connect with God?

Dedication of St. John Lateran

Every dedication of a Church is about Jesus Christ and about worship in spirit and in truth.

If we look at the readings today in terms of Church and the service of the Bishop of Rome, our Pope, we can see in the first reading, from the Prophet Ezekiel, a reflection of what the Church and the service of the Pope are supposed to be: the water of life flowing out from God and giving life to all that it touches. This is the ideal and it is rarely completely reached. Yet we have seen so many holy Popes in



the last one hundred years that we can understand that the role of the Pope and the role of the Church is to give us life. The second reading today, from the First Letter to the Corinthians, reminds us that we are the Church, the temple of God. We are not the Church all by ourselves in some exclusive way. Each of us is the Church and yet together we are the Church. Each of us is a temple of God and together we are God's people.

Finally, in the Gospel today, from Saint John, we understand how the body of Christ points to resurrection, for Him and for us. We are to recognise in all of this the hand of God: Jesus dies for us and we must die for one another. This is the Church and this is why we celebrate the dedication of a Church. The Bishop of Rome, our Pope, can lead us to walk with Christ – but we must be the ones who walk.

Time to Think... Sister Stanislaus Kennedy



A prophet has the ability to read the signs of the times mingling the relevance of the Gospel, in a courageous and faith filled manner. I have no doubt that Ireland's beloved Sr. Stan, fulfilled her prophetic ministry, fuelled with the Spirit of Jesus Christ. A fearless campaigner for those who found themselves on the outside. An inclusive voice that brought tolerance and compassion. A welcoming heart that always embraced the stranger. Her prophetic ministry in an institution often dominated by patriarchy makes it even more inspirational. In her 27 books published, her spirituality of hope and gratitude shared a deep empathy, that made the Gospel message, deeply relevant to the times we live in. Sister Stanislaus Kennedy throughout her more than sixty years as a Religious Sister of Charity, the needs of people living in poverty in Ireland was always her greatest concern. Her faith led her to see, responding to the words of Jesus, 'Truly I tell you, as long as you did it to one of these the least of my brethren, you did it to me' (Mt 25:40), as her lifelong vocation.

Sister Stanislaus Kennedy was, according to Charlie Haughey the most intransigent woman he had ever met. Then, in the late 1970s, Sr Stan was chair of an EU-funded National Committee on Pilot Schemes to Combat Poverty in Ireland. It had taken a radical approach, setting up rural co-operatives while supporting projects for Travellers, the disabled and women. Some of its members had a meeting with Haughey, then Minister for Health. He was not impressed and described what they were doing as "rubbish" and that we should "concentrate on doing meals on wheels and things like that". Sr Stan interrupted him, "with respect, I don't agree with you at all". He then "lambasted us all. He insisted what we were doing would go nowhere and that it was Marxist", and added "as for you Sr Stanislaus, you are the most intransigent woman I've ever met". In 2003, on being presented with yet another honorary doctorate, she was described as "a woman known for her directness, persistence and a cultivated inability to comprehend the answer No".

She tended to accept those views herself. In later life she agreed she could be difficult and stubborn because working for the poor "involves difficult and humiliating tasks such as going from door to door, looking for funds".

Her first experience of real poverty was working in Dublin's Ringsend during the late 1950s while still a novice. It left a deep impression. Soon, she also realised "services weren't enough; you had to have advocacy as well, that's what drove me".

She had a deep impulse to help people in distress or despair whether through poverty or for spiritual reasons. Her advocacy also spurred her to write thousands of articles, give as many talks and to write or edit at least 27 books. Treasa Kennedy was the fourth in a family of five who lived on a small farm at Lispole near Dingle in Co. Kerry, her mother "from the fior Gaeltacht – where Peig Sayers came from; her father came from the breac area. Both spoke beautiful Irish". Locally, that meant being seen as "kind of inferior", she said. There was "little Irish spoken in Dingle then and none spoken in the shops". Speaking Irish was "proof that you were uneducated".

She was "a wild young one, into the dances and that side of life". So, "when people around Dingle heard that one of Tadhg Mhuillean's daughters was going into the convent, they never would have picked me out as the one".

One of her sisters told her about the Irish Sisters of Charity, "a friend of hers was joining the order. They were the people who worked with the poor and the homeless. That was it. I joined the nuns".

In 1958 she entered the novitiate at Milltown in Dublin with 100 others and was given the name Stanislaus. In the mid-1960s her work began in earnest in Kilkenny, where she was sent to assist the innovative bishop of Ossory Peter Birch, then setting up a pioneering community services project. He became her mentor, shaping her views on the marginalised. She believed, as did Birch, that the Catholic Church needed to "identify more with the poor". This proved controversial. "I wrote a paper saying the church had resources and it wasn't using them for the poor. Well, all hell broke loose because it was picked up by the media. People were furious, bishops were furious, I got a letter from Rome, in the end of it I was silenced. But then I rose up again and started speaking out again."

That she did. Later it included challenging mandatory celibacy for priests, supporting equality for women in the church and calling for a Yes vote in the 2015 referendum on same-sex marriage. I'm sure she embraced the radical witness of Pope Francis in his humility and desire to "build a church for the poor".

She founded and directed Kilkenny Social Services and went on to cofound the School of Social Education in Kilkenny, providing the first professional courses for residential childcare workers in Ireland.

When Bishop Birch died suddenly in 1981, she moved to Dublin and studied for a degree in social science at UCD, then went on to take a master's at the University of Manchester. In 1985 the European Commission appointed her co-ordinator of the European Rural Poverty Projects within the EU. In Dublin, also that year, she founded the body with which she is most publicly identified, Focus Ireland, the biggest voluntary housing organisation in the State.

In 1998 she founded the Sanctuary, a holistic spirituality centre in Dublin, and in 2001 established both the Immigrant Council of Ireland, to promote the rights of immigrants, and Social Innovations Ireland Ltd, to help young people respond to the needs of 21st-century Ireland. In 2017 she became ill, but it was 2020 before she could speak of the cancer, admitting she couldn't bring herself to say the word at first. "I never thought I was going to die, I didn't think about that at all. I drew on my faith ... that helped me."

As described in 2003, when being presented with an honorary doctorate at Maynooth University, one of at least 18 awards she was given, Sr Stanislaus Kennedy was "a woman of immense reputation, a servant of the underprivileged people of modern Ireland".

Sr. Stan had a deep awareness of God's presence in her life. She was contemplative and nourished her soul in the silence of God's presence. As we continue through the month of November and live in this winter darkness we come to the Sabbath time of year, when nature rests. A sense of Sabbath, a commitment to taking time and space out of our busy lives and giving it to the sacred, can restore our openness to grace and make us alive to the miracles around us. May we all walk the pathway of kindness and compassion.

On the evening of 24th September, as preparing for bed, I felt very unwell. When I say unwell, I began to feel unusual. It was about 11.00 p.m. and I had been watching "Who wants to be a millionaire", with some of my confreres. I found it very difficult to cope with my left hand and side. Putting on my pyjamas was extremely difficult and I toppled over on my left side and could not get up. My left hand was useless.

I understood I was having a stroke. I tried counting out loud but failed to articulate sound. I managed to crawl across my room and out to the corridor. I reached the adjoining room and hammered on the door. When my confrere appeared, I managed to croak "Stroke".

He managed to act instantly and managed to contact an ambulance. Luckily, we were very near St. Vincent's Hospital and soon I was being competently looked after by two delightful medics, who assured me that I was in the process of a mild stroke and that they had everything under control.

The emergency section of the hospital was extremely crowded and I had to wait many hours to get a bed in the stroke ward. Thus began the healing process by a wonderful team of nurses and doctors, many from

I am deeply grateful for the attention. I am making progress but found it difficult to eat for ten days as I had difficulty swallowing, but all medical staff assure me I am making excellent progress. I can talk and eat practically normally by now.

I want to take this occasion to my community, family and friends and you, people of the parish for prayers and loving concern. As soon as I am able, hopefully very soon, I will make my way to Portlaoise and join you in mass and coffee.

I wish to let you know, too, that my days in Sue Ryder Centre are over.





The Dedication of the Lateran Basilica

A long, long time ago, in the city of Rome, there was a kind emperor named Constantine. He was the first Roman emperor to let Christians pray freely, without being afraid.

Constantine wanted to build a special church for all Christians — a place where they could come together to pray, celebrate Mass, and be close to God. So, he gave some of his own land to build this church.



That church became the Lateran Basilica, the very first basilica (big church) ever built for Christians! It was dedicated to Jesus the Saviour. Later, it was also named after St. John the Baptist and St. John the Evangelist.

The Lateran Basilica is extra special because it's the pope's church — not St. Peter's, as many people think! It's the main church for all Catholics around the world, like the "mother church" of all other churches.

Every year, on November 9th, we celebrate the Dedication of the Lateran Basilica to remember that God's Church isn't just a building — it's made of people who love and follow Jesus.

When we take care of our churches and pray together, we show that we are God's family, just like the people who gathered in that first big church in Rome so many years ago.









Jesus Clears the Temple

It was almost time for the Passover, a special holiday for the Jewish people. Jesus went to the city of Jerusalem to celebrate.

When He went into the temple, God's special house, He saw people selling cows, sheep, and doves. Others were sitting at tables, changing people's money for coins used in the temple.

Jesus was very upset. The temple was supposed to be a place to pray

and worship God, not a marketplace! So He made a small whip out of cords and drove all the animals and sellers out of the temple. He poured out the money and knocked over the tables.

He said, "Take these things out of here! Don't turn my Father's house into a place for selling things!"


The people who saw this asked Jesus, "What gives You the right to do this? Show us a sign that You have this power."

Jesus answered, "Destroy this temple, and in three days I will raise it up again."

They were confused. They said, "It took forty-six years to build this temple! How could You rebuild it in just three days?"

But Jesus wasn't talking about the building. He was talking about His own body. Later, when Jesus rose from the dead, His friends remembered what He had said, and they believed Him. (Sunday's Gospel)






